District, having temporarily come down to Guntur, do hereby  
solemnly affirm and state as follows.

01. I respectfully submit that I am the petitioner herein and as  
such well acquainted with the facts of the case.

02. I respectfully submit that I filed the above W.P.No.8549 of  
2021 before this Hon'ble Court to declare the proceedings of the  
respondent No.4 (R3 herein) in Rc.No.B2/14447/2019, dated

17.09.2019 through which my promotion as Senior Assistant was kept in abeyance as illegal, void and further directing the respondents particularly the respondents 2 to 4 in W.P to give a posting to me as Senior Assistant in original place in the department of Endowments as the same is illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional. The respondents herein are Respondents No. 1 to 5 in the W.P.

3. I respectfully submit that, when the matter came up for hearing on 29-11-2024, this Hon'ble Court was pleased to hear both the sides and allow the writ petition with the following order and direction:

**" In view of the foregoing discussion, the impugned proceedings of the 4th respondent dated 17.09.2019 is declared as illegal and same is hereby set aside, while directing the official respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Senior Assistant in Department of Endowments or in the Department of Education as per seniority fixed vide order dated 12.09.2019 issued by the Endowments Department and issue appropriate orders in favour of the petitioner in accordance with law, within a period of two (02) months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs."**

4. I respectfully submit that as per the above direction, the respondents herein have to consider me for promotion to the post of Senior Assist either in Endowments department or Education department and issue appropriate orders in 2 months from the

date of receipt of copy of order. The order copy was made available on 26-12-2024 and immediately on receipt of copy of the above Order dt. 29-11-2024, I submitted representations dated 03-01-2025 to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent on 09-01-2025, requesting them to implement the order of the Hon'ble Court. I submitted representations dated 03-01-2025 to the 3 to 5 respondents on 04-01-2025 and requested them to implement the order of the Hon'ble court. I also enclosed copy of the order along with all the representations. As there was no action within the stipulate time frame, I sent representations dated 17-04-2025 through RPAD on the same day to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> respondents. I submitted representations on 06-03-2025, and 17-04-2025 to the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent, representations on 06-03-2025, 21-03-2025, and 17-04-2025 to the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent and representations on 19-03-2025 and 17-04-2025 to the 5<sup>th</sup> respondents, requesting them to comply the order.

5. I respectfully submit that meanwhile on 13-02-2025, the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent addressed a letter to the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent herein stating about the order of the Hon'ble court and requested the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent to take necessary action in pursuance of the order of the Hon'ble Court. But the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent sent a reply to 4<sup>th</sup> respondent on 06-03-2025 that she was not competent to take action and requested the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent to take necessary action. In this way they are shifting liability on each other and evading implementation of the order. The time period of two months is over in February itself and the respondents have not yet given me appointment order as senior assistant by complying the order of

the Hon'ble Court, despite several representations mentioned above.

6. I respectfully submit that the respondents herein wilfully disobeyed the Order of this Hon'ble court. The respondents deliberately stalled the implementation of the order of this Hon'ble Court and hence they are liable to be punished under the contempt of courts Act. The respondents have no respect for orders of this Hon'ble Court. Unless I am considered for promotion to the post of Senior Assistant, I irreparable loss and hardship, Hence the present contempt Petition.

Hence it is prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to punish the Respondents herein under Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for wilful disobedience of order of this Hon'ble Court passed in **WP.No. 8549 of 2021, dt. 29-11-2024** and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deems fit and proper in the circumstances of the case in the interest of justice.

**ORDER:-**

This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India,  
seeking the following relief:

*".....to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus to declare the proceedings of the respondent No.4 in Rc.No.B2/14447/2019, dated 17.09.2019 through which petitioner's promotion as Senior Assistant was kept in abeyance as illegal, void and further directing the respondents particularly the Commissioner, Department of Endowments, the Deputy Commissioner Department of Endowments and the District Collector, Guntur, the respondents 2 to 4 to give a posting to the*

*petitioner as Senior Assistant in original place in the department of Endowments and pass such other orders...."*

2. Heard Mr. Y. Koteswara Rao, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader, Endowments and Services-II for the respondents.

3. During hearing learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that he was temporarily promoted to the cadre of Senior Assistant and transferred to the office of the Assistant Commissioner, Endowments Depart, Nellore vide proceedings 12.09.2019 issued by the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent and the petitioner reported for duty on 16.09.2019. Subsequently, the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent issued proceedings dated 17.09.2019 keeping the issue of petitioner's promotion as Senior Assistant in Abeyance. The petitioner made a representation dated 30.09.2019 to the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent requesting for inter departmental transfer along with her promotion, but no reply is received. Pursuant to the direction of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent dated 25.10.2019, the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent surrendered the petitioner to the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent and reported for duty on 01.11.2019. The 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent issued proceedings dated 17.12.2019 stating that she was appointed as Typist in the category of BC-B(W) (Roaster point No.9631/A2/2019, dated 20.12.2019 directing the petitioner to joint the duty within 30 days. Pursuant to the said proceedings, the petitioner joined as Typist on the same day i.e on 20.12.2019. Again the petitioner made a representation dated 24.01.2020 urging the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent that the waiting period before posting in the other department i.e 01.11.2019 to 19.12.2019 to

kindly be condoned by issuing necessary orders so as to enable him for drawing salaries from the concerned department. The 5<sup>th</sup> respondent issued proceedings dated 26.02.2020 forwarding the representation to the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent, but no action has been initiated till yet.

4. It is further contended that from the date of joining as typist by the petitioner in the Department of Education, Guntur, she has not been paid due salary from the month of November-2019 till May-2020 for which the petitioner is entitled to. Further the promotion which was given to the petitioner and was illegally kept in abeyance, ought to have been provided to the petitioner long back. But till date she was not promoted to the higher post as a Senior Assistant in spite of his eligibility. The petitioner illegally kept as only typist instead of the Senior Assistant. Hence, inaction of the respondents is questioned in this writ petition and requested to allow the same.

5. The 4<sup>th</sup> respondent filed counter affidavit denying all material allegations made in the writ affidavit and mainly contended that the petitioner was appointed as Typist on compassionate grounds and allotted to the Endowments Department by the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent vide proceedings dated 29.08.2007. As per Rule 3 (Method of appointment) of A.P.Ministerial Service Rules 1998, (in short 'the Rules'), appointment to be made only from among persons professing Hindu Religion for all categories of posts in Endowments Department. There arose several allegations through print and electronic media that in certain instances of the officers and staff working in Endowments Department are professing other than Hindu Religion. In view of



the said rule position and allegations, the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent issued Circular Instructions dated 14.09.2019 to obtain self declarations from all the employees working in Endowments Department to the effect that they are professing Hindu Religion only. But the petitioner refused to give self declaration in prescribed affidavit furnished by the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent and she represented that she is visiting Church on every Sunday from the date of her marriage, she converted into Christianity and following Religious traditions of Christianity only. In the meanwhile, before issuing the said instructions, some Senior Assistant vacancies arose in the Department and the petitioner, who is the senior most person among the Junior Assistants and Typist, and hence the name of the petitioner was considered for promotion and order was issued on 12.09.2019. In view of the said circumstances the order issued by the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent promoting the petitioner are kept in abeyance. A detailed report was submitted to the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent while appraising the facts that the petitioner has refused to give self declaration affidavit. Hence action has been taken against her vide proceedings dated 21.09.2019.

6. It is further contended that the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent has issued proceedings dated 17.12.2019, re-allotted the petitioner to the District Educational Officer, Guntur for being posted as Typist, since the appointment to the service in Endowments Department shall be made only from among persons professing the Hindu Religion. Accordingly the petitioner was relieved from the Department and paid the salary emoluments till the date of her relief and sent the LPC to the District Educational Officer, Guntur as per rules. Thus, the

petitioner has no locus standi to claim seniority in Endowments Department and hence proposals were submitted to the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent to re-allot the petitioner to any other department as per directions of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent. The District Educational Officer, Guntur has addressed a letter to the Commissioner of School Education vide letter dated 04.07.2023 requesting to keep the period from 01.11.2019 to 19.12.2019 ( i.e the date of relieving at Endowments Department till she has joined as Typist in Education Department) as compulsory waiting period and action is to be pursued by the Education Department. If any salary emoluments are pending during gap period i.e 01.11.2019 to 19.12.2019, action will taken by the appropriate authority for regularization of waiting period as per Rules in vogue. Therefore, requested to dismiss the writ petition.

7. The 5<sup>th</sup> respondent filed counter-affidavit and mainly contended that the petitioner worked as Typist in the Department of Endowments, Guntur since 12.09.2007 till 12.09.2019 i.e for 12 years continuously and re-allotted to 5<sup>th</sup> respondent and she was joined to duty on 20.12.2019 as Typist. The salary was claimed to the petitioner for a period from 20.12.2019 to 31.05.2020 and the same was credited into bank account of the petitioner on 03.08.2020. But the 5<sup>th</sup> respondent addressed to the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent for treating the period from 01.11.2019 to 19.12.2019 as compulsory wait. But the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent has stated that as per FR 108 (A) they were not competent for sanction of waiting period vide letter dated 04.07.2023 of the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent. Therefore, requested to dismiss the writ petition.

8. Perused the record.

9. Learned counsel for the petitioner vehemently argued that the promotion of the petitioner to the post of Senior Assistant from that of Typist was based upon her seniority in the job and also the proper and required standards of service that she rendered as Typist in the Department of Endowment. The religion followed by any employee has not been a condition either for appointment in a post in the department or for promotion to a Higher Post. There was no such condition required or demanded from the petitioner at the time of her appointment as Typist on 12.09.2007. As per Article 16 of the Constitution of India provides as "*1. There shall be equality of opportunity for all citizens in matters relating to employment or appointment to any officer under the State. 2) No citizen shall, on grounds only of religion, race, caste, sex, descent, place of birth, residence or any of them, be ineligible for, or discriminated against in respect of, any employment or office under the State*". Further the Rule 3 applies only for the appointments in the department, but not for the promotions to a higher cadre. Thus, the Rule 3 is not applicable to her. The 3 was there in the vogue, even on the date of her appointment as a typist in the year 2007. Therefore, the petitioner is entitled to claim relief as prayed for.

10. The 5<sup>th</sup> respondent has furnished details of the petitioner along with counter-affidavit, which shows that the 5<sup>th</sup> respondent has paid the salaries to the petitioner for the period from 20.12.2019 to 31.12.2019 and January-2020 to June-2020. Further, the 5<sup>th</sup> respondent forwarded the proposal for sanction

of waiting period from 01.11.2019 to 19.12.2019 as compulsory as per the F.R.108(A) for consideration vide letter dated 04.07.2023 to the Commissioner of School Education, Guntur, which is pending therein.

11. In the instant case, there is no dispute with regard to salary of the petitioner as per copy of the statement furnished by the 5<sup>th</sup> respondent. It is only point involved in this matter is that whether the promotion of the petitioner to the post of Senior Assistant kept in abeyance is illegal or not? The petitioner seeking relief in this writ petition to direct the respondents to give posting to the petitioner as Senior Assistant in original place in the Department of Endowments. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent drawn the attention of this Court with regard to Rule 3 of 'the Rules' and the seniority also shall not be taken into consideration in the Department, since the appointment to be made only from among persons professing Hindu Religion for all categories of posts in Endowments Department. Therefore, proposals were submitted to the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent for reallocate the petitioner to any other Department as per directions of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent. Accordingly, the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent allotted the petitioner to the 5<sup>th</sup> respondent department and posted her as Typist therein.

12. Learned counsel for the petitioner vehemently argued that as per Article 14 of the Constitution of India deals with equality before law. The State shall not deny to any person equality before the law or the equal protection of the laws within the territory of India. Therefore, the law is applicable to one and all equally. Further, the appointment of the petitioner is on compassionate

grounds and further she is having 12 years of service i.e. 12.09.2007 till 12.09.2019 as Typist in Department of Endowments, Guntur. Whereas the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent has issued Circular instructions dated 14.09.2019 to obtain self declaration from all the employees working in Endowments Department to the effect that they are professing Hindu Religion only just two days before transfer of the petitioner. Therefore, how the said rule is applicable to the petitioner is the question and same is disputed by the petitioner. Further, the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent has not explained proper reasons why they have not obtained self declaration at the time of her appointment, which is silent in the counter-affidavit. Further at the time of joining into duty by the petitioner, no such condition has been imposed and she worked till 12 years.

13. The 4<sup>th</sup> respondent pleaded that the petitioner has not been submitted the self declaration as per Circular dated 14.09.2019 issued by the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent at this juncture does not arise. The District Educational Officer, Guntur has addressed a letter to the Commissioner of School Education vide letter dated 04.07.2023 requesting to keep the period from 01.11.2019 to 19.12.2019 ( i.e the date of relieving at Endowments Department till she has joined as Typist in Education Department) as compulsory waiting period and action is to be pursued by the Education Department. If any salary emoluments are pending during gap period i.e 01.11.2019 to 19.12.2019, action will taken by the appropriate authority for regularization of waiting period as per Rules in vogue is the contention of the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent.

14. As per proceedings dated 12.09.2019 issued by the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent it is informed the petitioner that if she fails to join in the new post within 15 days, she shall forfeit all of her right in both for the present and future post as per G.O.Ms.No.193 (G-A/Sers) Department, dated 26.04.1999. Further there is a condition that her promotion is purely temporary and she shall be reverted to her original cadre without assigning any reasons at any time without any notice.

15. However, the promotion given to the petitioner is only temporary in the Department of Endowments, but she transferred to 5<sup>th</sup> respondent department and posted as Typist. No doubt, the rule 3 applies to only for the appointments in the department, but not the promotions to a higher cadre, as contended by learned counsel for the petitioner. In view of the Constitutional mandates the Circular dated 14.09.2019 is not applicable to the case of the petitioner herein.

16. Therefore, the seniority will be counted on par with other employees in the Endowments department as per seniority. Admittedly, before issuing the circular instructions, some Senior Assistant vacancies arose and the petitioner is the senior most employees among the Junior Assistants and Typist and hence her name was considered for promotion and orders were issued on 12.09.2019. But the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent on the ground of not giving self declaration, kept the order in abeyance, which is highly illegal and arbitrary. The petitioner deserves for promotion as Senior Assistant in the Endowments Department and the rule is applicable to one and all as per Article 14 and 16

of Constitution of India. Therefore, inaction of the respondents is declared as illegal and arbitrary.

17. In view of the foregoing discussion, the impugned proceedings of the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent dated 17.09.2019 is declared as illegal and same is hereby set aside, while directing the official respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Senior Assistant in Department of Endowments or in the Department of Education as per seniority fixed vide order dated 12.09.2019 issued by the Endowments Department and issue appropriate orders in favour of the petitioner in accordance with law, within a period of two (02) months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.

18. With the above direction, the Writ Petition is allowed. There shall be no order as to costs.

The miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall also stand closed.

I submit that in this connection, the main prayer of the writ petitioner filed by Smt.M.Venkateswaramma, former Typist of this office is that

I submit that Smt M.Venkateswaramma was initially appointed as typist as per the allotment orders issued by the Collector & District Magistrate, Guntur vide Proceedings in Rc.No.3404/2007/B5/ dt:29.08.2007 and appointment orders were got issued by this office on 12.09.2007. She had promoted to the cadre of Senior Assistant on 12.09.2019. The Commissioner, Endowments Department, A.P., Vijayawada vide Memo in Rc.No.,E3/COE/15021/158/2019, dt:25.10.2019 have been pleased to issue orders to surrender her services to the Collector & Dist., Magistrate, Guntur so that the individual will be immediately accommodate in another place and avoid any hardship. I submit that the Hon'ble High Court have been pleased to issue orders on 29-11-2024 in I.A.No.1 of 2021 in W.P.No.8549/2021, which was received by this office on 30-12-2024 that

***"the seniority will be counted on par with other employees in the Endowments Department as per seniority. Admittedly, before issuing the Circular instructions, some Senior Assistant vacancies arose and the petitioner is the senior most employees among the Junior Assistants and Typist and hence her name was considered for promotion and orders were issued on 12.09.2019. But the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent on the ground of not giving self declaration, kept the order in abeyance, which is highly illegal and arbitrary. The petitioner deserves for promotion as Senior Assistant in the Endowments Department and the rule is applicable to one and all as per Article 14 and 16 of Constitution of India. Therefore, inaction of the respondents is declared as illegal and arbitrary.***

***In view of the foregoing discussion, the impugned proceedings of the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent dated: 17.09.2019 is declared as illegal and same is hereby set aside, while directing the official respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Senior Assistant in Department of Endowments or in the Department of Education as per seniority fixed vide order dated:12.09.2019 issued by the Endowments Department and issue appropriate orders in favour of the petitioner in accordance with law, within a period of two (2) months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs".***

In this connection, I submit that in pursuance of the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of A.P. the seniority of the employees be given to her, but her services as a person who is having belief in other Religion not be continued in Hindu Religious Endowments Department, basing on that ground only her services were got surrendered to the Collector & District Magistrate, Guntur earlier. Attention is invited to the reference cited, wherein a report has been submitted by the Deputy Commissioner, Endowments Department, Guntur, stating that Writ Petition No. 8549/2021 was filed before the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh by Smt. Murala Venkateswaramma, W/o Late Venkata Subba Rao praying to transfer her services as Senior Assistant for which she was already promoted instead of Typist in the education department and to regularize the mean period i.e., surrender her service from Endowments department till she was reappointed in Education department.

He further stated that, the petitioner was initially appointed as a Typist in their department based on the allotment orders issued by the Collector & District Magistrate, Guntur, via Proceedings in Rc. No. 3404/2007/B5, dated 29.08.2007. Consequently, the appointment orders were issued by their office on 12.09.2007. She was later promoted to the cadre of Senior Assistant on 12.09.2019. At that time, the Commissioner, Endowments Department, A.P., Vijayawada, through Circular No. E2/COE/15021/131/2019, dated 14.09.2019, issued instructions to obtain a self-declaration from employees working in the department affirming that they follow and profess the Hindu religion. The circular was received by their office on 16.09.2019, and affidavits were collected from all employees,

except Smt. M. Venkateswaramma, who had been promoted only four days before the issuance of the circular. When she was asked to submit the affidavit, she declined to do so and did not provide any representation in this regard. Consequently, it was presumed that she did not profess the Hindu faith, leading to her promotion being placed in abeyance. A detailed report on the matter was subsequently submitted to the Commissioner, Endowments Department, A.P., Vijayawada, on 21.09.2019. Following this, the Commissioner, Endowments Department, A.P., Vijayawada, issued orders via Memo No. E3/COE/15021/158/2019, dated 25.10.2019, directing that her services be surrendered to the Collector & District Magistrate, Guntur, to facilitate her immediate accommodation elsewhere and to avoid any hardship. Accordingly, her services were surrendered to the Collector & District Magistrate, Guntur, who then re-allotted her to the Education Department as a Typist. She has since been serving as a Typist in the Education Department from 20.12.2019 onwards.

Further stated that, a counter affidavit was filed before Hon'ble High Court of A.P., and Hon'ble High Court vide its order dated 29.11.2024 in I.A.No.1 of 2021 in W.P. No.8549/2021 has directed that

"the seniority will be counted on par with other employees in the Endowments Department as per seniority. Admittedly, before issuing the Circular instructions, some Senior Assistant vacancies arose and the petitioner is the senior most employees among the Junior Assistants and Typist and hence her name was considered for promotion and orders were issued on 12.09.2019. But the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent on the ground of not giving self declaration, kept the order in abeyance, which is highly illegal and arbitrary. The petitioner deserves for promotion as Senior Assistant in the Endowments Department and the rule is applicable to one and all as per Article 14 and 16 of Constitution of India. Therefore, inaction of the respondents is declared as illegal and arbitrary.

In view of the foregoing discussion, the impugned proceedings of the 4th respondent dated: 17.09.2019 is declared as illegal and same is hereby set aside, while directing the official respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Senior Assistant in Department of Endowments or in the Department of Education as per seniority fixed vide order dated: 12.09.2019 issued by the Endowments Department and issue appropriate orders in favour of the petitioner in

accordance with law, within a period of two (2) months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs".

He further stated that, as an individual who professes a religion other than Hinduism cannot continue in the Hindu Religious Endowments Department, her services were surrendered to the Collector & District Magistrate, Guntur, on this ground. Consequently, the orders issued in their office proceedings Rc.No. B2/1667/2019-2, dated 12.09.2019, promoting the incumbent to the cadre of Senior Assistant which had been kept in abeyance under office Rc.No.B2/1447/2019, dated 17.09.2019 are hereby vacated. Her services shall be recognized in the cadre of Senior Assistant from the date of her submission of the joining report as Senior Assistant on 16.09.2019. Further, her tenure as a Senior Assistant in the Endowments Department shall be considered from 16.09.2019 to 01.11.2019, i.e., from the date of her relief and surrender of services to the Collector & District Magistrate, Guntur. He has therefore requested the Collector & District Magistrate, Guntur, who is the third respondent in Writ Petition No. 8549 of 2021, to take further necessary action in the matter in compliance with the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of A.P. and to issue suitable directions to the District Educational Officer, Guntur.

In this connection, it is informed that, the District Collectors serve as the Nodal Authority for providing compassionate appointments to various departments within the district. Seeking directions or submitting proposals for clarifications, exemptions, or relaxations does not fall under the purview of the Nodal Officer. Therefore, Unit Officers and District Officers must first seek clarifications or relaxations from their respective Administrative Heads of Departments and act accordingly.

In view of the above, it is informed to take necessary action as per the above directions in order to avoid further legal complications .

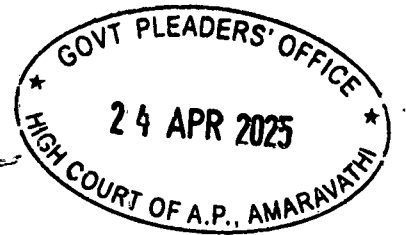
