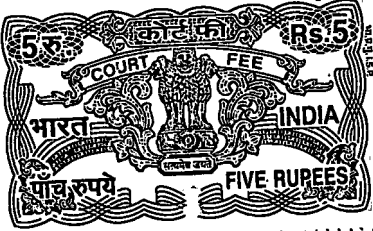

AFFIDAVIT

I, GUNDEPALLI SRINIVASA RAO S/c Anjaneyulu aged about 54 years R/o D.no. 81820/2 Sai Apartments Opp Chinta Vari Veedhi Balajiraopeta Tenali Nelapadu Guntur, AP now temporarily came down to Amaravati, do hereby solemnly affirm and state as follows:

1. I am the petitioner herein, as such I am well acquainted with the facts of the case and do hereby swear to the contents of this affidavit.
2. I submit that the present contempt petition is filed by the petitioners against the contemnors for deliberate violation and wilful disobedience of the orders of this Hon'ble court date 06.05.2024, in W.P.No. 10728 of 2024 passed by this Hon'ble court and praying this Hon'ble court to punish the contemnors and further to direct the authorities to consider the order dt.06.05.2024 as directed by this Hon'ble court.
3. It is submitted that the petitioner herein had filed WP No. 10728 of 2024 before this Hon'ble Court for praying this Hon'ble court to issue a Writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of mandamus declaring the inaction of the respondents in causing appropriate enquiry and issuing suitable directions to take over the administration of the temple i.e. Sri Venkateswara Swamy Devalayam situated in UDA Colony Chenchupet Tenali Guntur District by the Endowments Department as illegal arbitrary violation of Article 25 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the 2nd respondent to take over the administration of the said temple by appointing an Executive Officer and consequently direct the Respondents to furnish the records of the accounts of the temple and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case and to pass

4. That this Hon'ble court vide orders dated 06-05-2024 was pleased to consider the case of the petitioner and the submissions made by the Government pleaders and was pleased to pass Interim orders observing:

Order Date- 05-06-2024

"This application is filed seeking to direct the respondents to produce the entire record of the Accounts of respondent No.6. Having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, I.A.No.1 of 2024 is allowed, and the respondents are directed to produce the record of the Accounts of respondent No.6 before this Court on the next date of adjournment.

Rule Nisi.

Call for records.

Post 'for final hearing'."

5. It is submitted that after the orders were passed by this Hon'ble court the same was communicated to the offices of respondents, but no action was taken. That despite the communication of the order to the respondents they have failed to take any action in conducting Survey. That is when the orders of Hon'ble court are in clear terms and the respondents who are public authorities, who has bounden duty to implement the orders of this Hon'ble court in letter and spirit. The petitioners had time and again approached the offices of the respondents, requesting them to act, but for the reasons best known have resorted to flout the orders of this Hon'ble court.

6. It is submitted that the above facts and circumstances would show that the respondents have intentionally and deliberately violated the orders of this Hon'ble court and have resorted to violate the order. That the actions of the Contemnors would show that scant respect for the orders of the Hon'ble court and have committed wilful disobedience and deliberately violation of the orders of this Hon'ble court dated 06-05-2024 in WP.No.10728 of 2024. The action of the Respondents is grossly in violation of the orders of this Hon'ble

Court and the same amounts to Contempt of the orders of the Hon'ble High Court and are liable for the punishment under Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act.

For the reasons stated above, it is therefore prayed that the Hon'ble Court may be pleased to hold the contemnors guilty of the contempt of the orders of the Hon'ble Court under sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act and punish the contemnors No. 1 for gross violation of the orders of the Hon'ble Court dated 05-06-2024 in W.P.No. 10728 of 2024 and pass such other order or orders as the Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

Pending disposal of the above contempt case, it is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble court may be pleased to direct The Respondents to Submit entire record of the Accounts of respondent No.6..i.e Sri Venkateswara Swamy Devalaya Nirmana Committee And pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

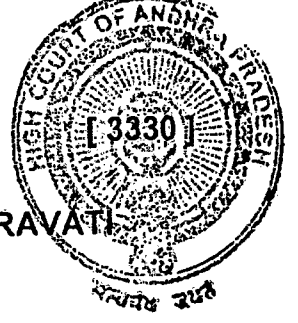

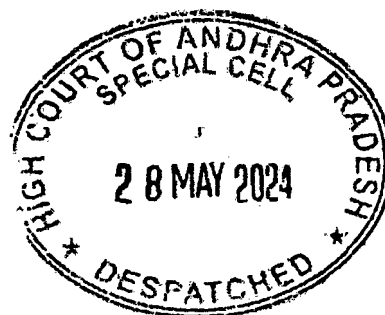

AFFIDAVIT FILED OF THE PETITIONER

I, Gundepalli Srinivasa Rao, S/o Anjineyulu, aged about 54 years, R/o D.No.8-18-20/2, Sai Apartments, Opp. Chinta Vari Veedhi, Balajiraopeta, Tenali, Nelapadu, Guntur, AP, having temporarily come down to Amaravati, do hereby solemnly affirm and sincerely state as follows:

1. I am the petitioner herein and well acquainted with the facts of the case.

2. I submit that the present petition is filed questioning the inaction of respondent no.2 in initiating any enquiry or proceeding in the issue of brazen Misue and gross mismanagement of funds at Sri Venkateswara Swamy Devalayam, situated in UDA Colony, Chenchupet, Tenali, Guntur District by unelected Association Members of Sri Venkateswara Swamy Devalaya Nirmana Committee in T.S.No.3/3 & ¾ (P) Block No.1, Ward No.1, IDST Scheme, UDA Colony, Chenchupet, Tenali-522202 Vizianagaram District inspite of bringing the acts of mismanagement to respondent no.2, vide numerous representations, the latest being dated 25.1.2024 as illegal and abdication of powers under AP Endowments Act.

3 I am a devout member of Respondent No.6 temple and I find solace and spiritual connection in the serene ambiance of the

temple situate at Chenchupet, Tenali. For years, I had faithfully attended various services performed there at the temple and I also contributed fiscally and physically also by volunteering to do seva there. However, my unwavering dedication started meeting with disillusionment when I, observed mismanagement of funds in the temple administration. I could not ignore the blatant disregard for the sacred trust bestowed upon the temple by its patrons. Driven by a sense of duty and justice, I resolved to confront the issue head-on and so with determination, I embarked on a journey to shed light and to thwart the ongoing corruption within the temple management, aiming to restore integrity to the place of worship. Recognizing the fiduciary duty owed to the temple's congregation, I am compelled by a sense of legal obligation to rectify the situation. In adherence to the principles of justice and transparency, I had resolved to initiate appropriate legal measures to address the misappropriation of funds within the temple's management structure.

4. I submit that it is relevant to mention here a brief background which is essential. I submit that Respondent No.3 acquired 91 acres land at Chenchupet, Tenali and prepared a layout plan for development. As per the approved plan, 10 sites were earmarked for parks. These included an area of 75 cents comprised in Town Survey No.2/3, Block No.1, Ward No.1,

Chenchupet and the Master Plan was approved by the State Government vide G.O.Ms.No.689 dated 30.12.2006 and the land used was divided into following 9 (main) categories: "1. Residential use Zone, Mixed Residential use Zone, Commercial use Zone, Industrial use Zone, Public and Semi-public use Zone, Recreational use Zone, Transportation and Communication use Zone (Roads, Railways, Airports, Bus Depots, and Truck Terminals), Agricultural use Zone, Water Bodies."

5. I submit that UDA Colony Welfare Association, an elected body responsible for the overall welfare of our colony, does not hold any authority over the day-to-day functioning or supervision of the temple's financial affairs due to anti-social elements within the colony involved in the handling of temple funds without any accountability or oversight. The current situation is alarming. The president and Secretary of the existing temple association have shown a lack of responsibility towards maintaining the temple premises, neglecting their duty to ensure cleanliness and upkeep and accountability. I further submit that the temple's financial resources, which primarily rely on donations totaling approximately Rs.5000/- per day, are being misused by unelected members of an association unrelated to the temple's operations. I further submit that the misuse of temple funds by unauthorized individuals not only violates the sanctity of the temple but also

raises serious concerns about financial mismanagement and potential exploitation of the donations received from devotees.

6. I submit that, in March 2009, a society, Respondent No.6, was registered under the Andhra Pradesh Societies Registration Act, 2001. In May 2009, Respondent No.6 applied to construct a temple on land earmarked for a park. Despite public objections, Respondent No.1 granted permission in 2010, sparking legal action. A WP No.12766 of 2010 was filed, challenging the decision to allow temple construction on recreational land. The High Court, in its judgement dated September 13, 2010, ruled that unless the State Government relaxed land use regulations, Respondent No.1 couldn't permit the temple construction. The legal battle continued in the Supreme Court, which in 19.9.2011, quashed the temple construction permits due to irregularities and lack of ownership proof by Respondent No.6.

7. I submit that as per AP Gazette Extraordinary notification No.619 dated 17.1.2017 (G.948), Change of land use from Recreational (Park) use to Public & Semi-Public Use was affected in T.S.No.3/3(P) & 3/4 (P) Block No.1, Ward No.1, IDSMT Scheme of Chenchupet(V), Tenali(M), Guntur District to an extent of 0.15 cents.

8. I further submit the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of AP in W.P.No.12766 of 2010 reads as follows:

"Once the land was earmarked for the parks/recreational use in the notification of the Master Plan of Tenali Town as approved in G.O.Ms.No.689, dated 30.12.2006, unless the Government relaxes the use of the land of any other purpose than the one notified, the first respondent [VGTM UDA (presently APCRDA)] cannot grant permission for construction of temple if it is prohibited under G.O.Ms.No.689, dated 30.12.2006. Mere allotment of the land for construction of temple will not give rise to any cause of action unless permission for construction of temple is accorded by the first respondent on submitting the plans. As and when the plans are submitted with specific proposal for construction of the temple, the first respondent is under obligation to consider the prohibition contained under the modified Master Plan issued in G.O.Ms.No.689, dated 30.12.2006. It is under obligation to invite the objections from the residents of the locality including the petitioners and consider the said objections before granting permission. If such construction of the temple is prohibited, it is also open for the third respondent (Respondents 6 & 7 in the present W.P.) to move the Government by filing an application seeking relaxation of the land use and if any relaxation is granted by the Government, it can make its application to the first respondent (4th Respondent in the present writ petition)

9. I submit that as per the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of AP in W.P.No.12766 of 2010 dated 13.9.2010, the 6th Respondent

committee has to make an application to the Respondent (4), VGTM UDA/APCRDA, seeking permission to construct the Temple and to approve the building plan submitted.

10. I submit that the said committee, Respondent No.6 has disobeyed the orders of the Hon'ble High Court and removed the fencing of the said site and completed the construction of the temple without a single permission like Building plan approval, No objection certificate from the District Collector, since it is the public vacant site Amidst the residential houses. The said committee collected huge amounts of Donations from the public as if they are the owners of the said site. Moreover, neither the APCRDA nor Tenali Municipality has given any permission to any committee to construct the temple. The said site was neither allotted nor sold to the committee. Prior approval was not obtained by the said committee for the construction of the temple either from APCRDA or Tenali Municipality. The said committee is a street committee having a membership of 9 persons and it is started functioning from 13.3.2017 onwards, it may not be advisable to cause any hindrance to its functioning due to the sentimental feelings of a cross section of the residents of the colony but a neat and clean supervision is needed for better functioning of the day-to-day procedures and formalities of the temple and its funds.

11. I further submit that I have filed W.P.No.8666 of 2024 before this Hon'ble Court questioning the inaction of the respondents. When, I arrayed the respondents incorrectly, this Hon'ble Court was pleased to dismiss the writ petition on 24.4.2024 granting liberty to me to file a fresh petition by making an appropriate or correct members or bodies as parties to the petition. Hence the Writ Petition.

12. I submit that I have no other alternative and efficacious remedy except to invoke the extraordinary jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court invoking Article 226 Constitution of India. I have not filed any writ, proceedings or suits before any other Court or authority seeking the relief as sought for hereunder, except as stated above.

13. In the circumstances stated above, it is prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue a Writ or direction or order one more particularly in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the inaction of the respondents in causing appropriate enquiry and issuing suitable directions to take over the administration of the temple i.e., Sri Venkateswara Swamy Devalayam, situated in UDA Colony, Chenchupet, Tenali, Guntur District by the Endowments Department as illegal, arbitrary, violation of Article 25 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the 2nd

respondent to take over the administration of the said temple by appointing an Executive Officer and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

14. It is further prayed that the Hon'ble Court may be pleased to direct to call for the entire record of the Accounts of the Respondent No.6 pending disposal of the writ petition and pass such other order or orders to meet the ends of justice.

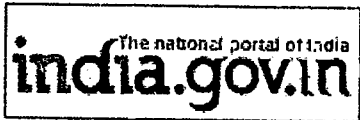

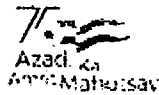

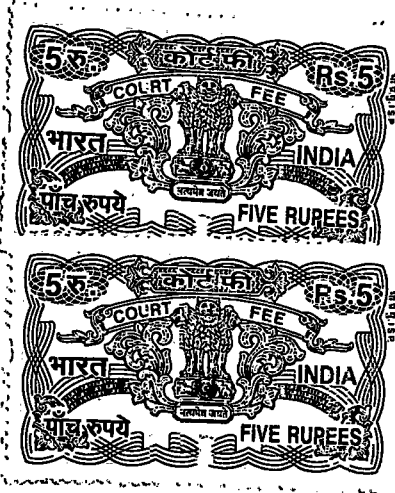
