AFFIDAVIT

I, Lakkireddy Rama Krishna Reddy, S/o. Sanjeeva Konda Reddy, Aged about 60 years, Cultivation, R/o. D.No: 2/1, N. Kottalapalle Village, Peddamudium Mandal, YSR Kadapa District, having temporarily come down to Amaravathi, do hereby solemnly and sincerely state on oath as follows:

1. I submit that I am the deponent herein and the 1st Petitioner in Interlocutory Application mentioned above and main Writ Petition, as such, I am well acquainted with the facts of the case and I am deposing on behalf of the 2nd Petitioner also.
2. I submit that I had filed the main Writ Petition to declare the proceedings of the Commissioner of Endowments, Department as illegal, arbitrary and against to the reports of other respondents and to consequently direct the Respondents to delete the lands of the Petitioners from Section 43 Register and for such other order or orders in the interest of justice.
3. I further submit that originally I had placed an application for deletion of my land from Section 43 Register in the year 2018 and that the other Respondents in the Writ Petition had submitted their reports to the Commissioner of Endowments Department recommending for the deletion of the property from the Section 43 Register but the Commissioner had rejected my application and I had again placed another

● application which was also rejected on 01-05-2024 and aggrieved by the same, I had filed the present Writ Petition along with an IA to stop all further proceedings such as going for auction of property, alienating the property in any way of lease, mortgage, creating charge on the property and interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the property of the cultivable lands in respect to our land.

4. I further submit that at the time of admission, the Hon'ble Vacation Court was not pleased to pass any interim orders and that as there was no interim order, the 1st Respondent herein along with the 2nd Respondent had conducted an auction with regard to the property of the Petitioners on 23-09-2024 and a third party stood as highest bidder and he had deposited the entire amount on the same day but the auction was not confirmed as it should be confirmed by the 1st Respondent herein and only after the confirmation of auction, the possession of the property would be handed over to the highest bidder.

5. I further submit that at that stage on 01-10-2024, our Writ Petition got listed and this Hon'ble Court had passed an interim order in I.A.No. 1 of 2024 in W.P.No. 12214 of 2024 in favour of the Petitioners which is in force till today as follows:

"On hearing the submissions of both the learned counsel, the respondents are directed not to take any coercive steps against the Petitioners with regard to the property in Sy.No. 489/1 to an extent of Ac.. 10.40 cents situated at Peddapasapula Village, Peddamudium Mandal, Y.S.R.Kadapa District.

Further, the Respondents are also directed not to confirm the auction proceedings, if any conducted by the respondents concerned."

6. I further submit that as the auction was already conducted this Hon'ble Court had directed the Respondents concerned i.e the present Respondents herein not to confirm the auction and not to take any coercive steps against the Petitioners herein but on 14-06-2025, the Respondents herein had issued an auction advertisement with regard lease rights to the property of the Petitioner fixing the date of auction as 26-06-2025 and conducted the auction on 26-06-2025, inspite of the interim orders of this Hon'ble Court in I.A.No. 1 of 2024 as the auction was conducted even before the matter was taken up, this Hon'ble Court has directed not to confirm the auction but the Respondents herein had left the auction at that stage and without any further proceedings of the auction that was stayed by this Hon'ble Court, the Respondents herein had issued another public notice for auction.

7. I further submit that inspite of the interim orders of this Hon'ble Court in I.A.No. 1 of 2024 in W.P.No. 12214 of 2024, the Respondents herein had issued public notice for auction for lease rights of the property of the Petitioners on 14-06-2025 and conducted the auction on 26-06-2025 which is in violation of the interim orders passed by this Hon'ble Court.

8. I further submit that in the earlier reports submitted by the Inspector, Endowments Department, Assistant Commissioner of Endowments Department and the Special Deputy Collector, Land Protection Cell, MZ-II, Tirupathi they had clearly stated that the property was wrongly included in the Section 43 Register without proper verification of the records and without any documentary evidence and inspite of the reports, the 2nd Respondent herein claiming that the said property belongs to them and also he had been continuously interfering with the Petitioners possession by calling them and directing them not to cultivate the said land but the

Petitioners have stated that there is an interim order in the favour of the Petitioners but the 2nd Respondent used to pay a dumb ear and would continuously call the Petitioners to stop them to cultivate the land and as the Petitioners did not want to get the relation with authorities into bad terms did not file any contempt then but the Petitioners had no other option now except filing this contempt petition.

9. I further submit that the interim order was passed on 01-10-2024 and in the said order was mentioned earlier it was specifically averred in the order that the respondents are directed not to take any coercive steps against the Petitioners with regard to the property in S.No. 489/1 in an extent of Ac. 10.40 cents and it was further mentioned not to confirm the auction proceedings if any conducted by the respondents concerned but against the interim orders of this Hon'ble Court, the 3rd Respondent herein in consultation and in communication with the 1st and 2nd Respondents published a pamphlet and in the said pamphlet was also misleading i.e the name of the Choultry was mentioned as Vankadara Subbaiah Satram but as per the Section 43 Register, the name of the Choultry is Vankadara Guravappa Dharma Satram and the pamphlet was published on 14-06-2025 inspite of the orders of this Hon'ble Court and it clearly shows the wilful and deliberate violation of the orders of this Hon'ble Court.

10. I further submit that this Hon'ble Court had already stayed the earlier auction conducted on 23-09-2024 vide the present interim order and directed not to confirm the auction if any conducted and when the earlier auction itself was stayed by the orders of this Hon'ble Court, the Respondents herein conducting a fresh auction without confirming or cancelling the earlier auction is nothing but deliberate violation of the orders of this Hon'ble Court.

11. I further submit that as per the orders of this Hon'ble Court, dt. 01-10-2024, this Court directed the respondents concerned not to confirm the auction if any conducted but the 2nd Respondent herein issued proceedings dt. 04-10-2024 and confirmed the auction proceedings in violation of the orders of this Hon'ble Court and the said proceedings came to our notice only when the Petitioners filed second writ petition for cancellation of the 2nd auction that was conducted and the copy of the said proceedings, dt. 04-10-2024 issued by the 2nd Respondent herein was annexed as material paper to the Counter Affidavit.
12. I further submit that as per the orders of this Hon'ble Court, dt. 01-10-2024, this Hon'ble Court directed the respondents not to take any coercive steps against the Petitioners in S.No. 489/1 of Peddapasupula Village, Peddamudium Mandal, YSR Kadapa District in an extent of Ac. 10.40 cents but the 3rd Respondent herein in consultation with the 1st and 2nd Respondents had addressed a letter to the Mandal Revenue Officer, Jammalamadugu for cancellation of the pattadar passbooks issued by the Revenue Department which amounts to coercive action against the Petitioners with regard to the subject property and the said action of addressing a letter for cancellation is nothing but wilful and deliberate violation of the orders of this Hon'ble Court.
13. I further submit that I had again filed a Writ Petition before this Hon'ble Court vide W.P.No. 15287/2025 with a direction not to conduct the auction inspite of the interim orders in favour of the Petitioners and this Hon'ble Court had also opined the same that there were interim orders in favour of the Petitioners in the main Writ Petition but as the auction was already conducted by the time the matter came for hearing on 26-06-2025, this Hon'ble Court was pleased to pass an interim order in favour of the

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Petitioners as follows: "***In the meanwhile, the respondents are directed not to deliver the physical possession of the subject property in favour of successful bidder.***"

14. I submit that the 3rd Respondent in consultation with the 1st and 2nd Respondents herein had conducted the auction on 26-06-2025 and the Respondents had totally ignored and violated the orders passed by this Hon'ble Court in I.A.No. 1 of 2024 in W.P.No. 12214 of 2024, dated 01-10-2024, and had issued public auction notice on 14-06-2025 with regard to the property of the Petitioners and had conducted the auction on 26-06-2025. The said action is violation of the orders passed by this Hon'ble Court. The public notice of auction advertisement and the conduction of auction, the confirmation of the auction proceedings and the letter addressed to the MRO, Jammalamadugu and the steps taken by the Respondents 1 to 3 in consultation with each other amounts to wilful negligence and deliberate violation of the orders of this Hon'ble Court not once but thrice, which amounts to Contempt of the Court under section 10 to 12 of the Contempt of the Courts Acts, 1971. Hence without any alternative remedy I am filing the present Contempt case.

It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to punish the Respondents 1 to 3 for wilful disobedience and violation of the orders, dated 01-10-2024, passed by this Hon'ble Court in I.A.No. 1 of 2024 in W.P.No. 12214 of 2024 and pass such other order or orders as the Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the interest of the Justice.

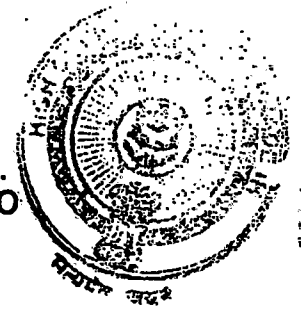

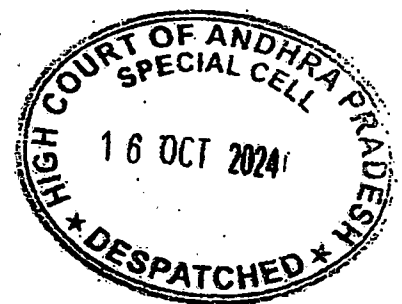

2) I submit that I filed the above writ petition against the respondents to:

a) Declare the Proceedings of the 5th respondent - The Executive Officer, Group Temples, Jammalamadugu, in his letter dated 15-05-2024 addressed to the 1st petitioner stating that the petitioners are having no right on the property in Survey No. 489/1 up to an extent of A.C. 10-40 cents of Peddapasupula Village, Peddamudium Mandal, Y.S.R. Kadapa District and of the 2nd respondent - The Commissioner, Endowments Department, Andhra Pradesh, rejecting orders in his proceedings No. M2/COE-19024 (35)/6/2024, Dt: 29-04-2024, by rejecting the request for deletion of the land in Sy.No.489/1 with an extent of A.C.10-40 cents situated at Peddapasapula Village, Pedamudium Mandal from the list of Prohibited Properties U/Sec. 22 (A) (1) (C) of the Registration Act, 1908, as null and void, inoperative as having no authority and Jurisdiction to enquire into the matter.

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b) Declare the proceedings of the 3rd respondent - The Assistant Commissioner, Endowments Department by sending the proceedings in R.C.No. A4/2629/2018 dt: 27-02-2019 to the 2nd respondent - Commissioner of Endowments, who is having no power to decide the matter, to take necessary action to issue NOC to the lands in Sy.No.489/1 up to an extent of A.c 10.40 Cents situated at Peddapasupula (V), Peddamudium Mandal, Y.S.R kadapa District, by way of not performing his duties enshrined in Sec.45 (2) of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987., as null and void, inoperative as having no authority and Jurisdiction.

Kadapa District. The same may be marked as Ex.P1 on my behalf. I also filing the original copy of the proceedings No. M2/COE-19024 (35)/6/2024, Dt: 29-04-2024, by of the 2nd respondent-Commissioner of Endowments Department, Andhra Pradesh, rejecting the request for deletion of the land in Sy.No.489/1 with an extent of A.C.10-40 cents situated at Peddapasapula Village, Pedamudium Mandal from the list of Prohibited Properties U/Sec. 22(A) (1) (C) of the Registration Act,1908. The same may be marked as Ex.P2 on my behalf.

4) I submit that I and the 2nd petitioner are the absolute owners of the properties in Sy.No.489/1 up to an extent of A.c 10.40 Cents situated at Peddapasupula (V), Peddamudium Mandal, Y.S.R kadapa District. I and one V.Rama Siva Reddy of of Jammalamadugu Town purchased Jointly, at the share of. 50% equalant to A.c. 2-60 cents each , the immovable property of cultivable land in Sy.No.489/1 up to an extent of A.c 5.20 Cents situated at Peddapasupula (V),

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Peddarnudium Mandal, Y.S.R kadapa District, on 27 06 2027 from one Buseti Muni Subramanyam of Jammalamadugu Town of Y.S.R Kadapa District for a valuable consideration of Rs. 1,35,500/-, through the registered sale deed in Document No.2428 of 2007 on the office of the Sub-Registrar office, Jammalamadugu. I am filing the Photostat Copy of the original sale deed in the Document No. 2428 of 2007 along with the translated copy. The same may be marked as Ex. P3 on my behalf.

5) Subsequently I purchased the another 50% of the share equalling to A.c. 2-60 cents of my partner – V.Rama Siva Reddy as he offered to sell his share for a valuable consideration of Rs. 1,30,000/- through the sale deed in document No. 2085 of 2011 on the office of the Sub-Registrar, Jammalamadugu, on the file of the Sub-Registrar office, Jammalamadugu. The same may be marked as Ex.P4. I have been in peaceful possession and enjoyment of the property from the date of purchase till today.

6) I also purchased an immovable property of cultivable land in Sy.No.489/1 up to an extent of A.c 5.20 Cents situated at Peddapasupula (V), Peddamudium Mandal, Y.S.R kadapa District, on 19-05-2007 from one Perugu Govindu of

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Ramireddypalle Village of Jammala Madugu Mandal, Y.S.R Kadapa District, in the name of my wife-the 2nd petitioner, for a valuable consideration of Rs.1,25,000/-, through the registered sale deed in Document No. 1812 of 2007 in the office of the Sub-Registrar office, Jammalamadugu. I am submitting the Photo Copy of the original sale deed in the Document No.1812 of 2007 in the office of the Sub-Registrar office, Jammalamadugu. The same may be marked as Ex. P5 on my behalf. I have been in peaceful possession and enjoyment of the property and looking after the property on her behalf from the date of purchase till today. I and my wife are having a property in Sy.No.489/1 of A.C.10-40 Cents in total, situated at Peddapasupula (V), Peddamudium Mandal, Y.S.R kadapa District. We also got pattadar Pass Books in our favour. We have been paying the required taxes to the Government.

- 7) I submit that, I came to know that our property of A.C.10-40 Cents in total land in Sy.No.489/1 situated at Peddapasupula (V), Peddamudium Mandal, Y.S.R kadapa District is kept in the list of Prohibited Properties U/Sec. 22(A) (1) (C) of the Registration Act, 1908, in the office of the Sub-Registrar,

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Jammalamadugu, at the request of the then 3rd respondent- The Assistant Commissioner of Endowments, kadapa, when I went to the Sub-Registrar, Jammalamadugu to register the property in the name of my daughter on the occasion her marriage on 04-01-2016. Immediately I and the 2nd petitioner-my wife approached the 3rd respondent- The Assistant Commissioner of Endowments, kadapa, and asked about keeping our property in the list of Prohibited Properties U/Sec. 22(A) (1) (C) of the Registration Act, 1908, The 3rd respondent- The Assistant Commissioner of Endowments Department, kadapa,, after verification of the records and after observing that the property is kept in the list of Prohibited Properties U/Sec. 22 (A) (1) (C) of the Registration Act, 1908, erroneously and asked us to keep application for deletion of the properties from the Sec.43 Property Register of Sri Vankadari Gurappa Choultry the properties from the Sec.43 Property Register of Sri Vankadari Gurappa Satram. Accordingly I kept the application to 3rd respondent- The Assistant Commissioner of Endowments Department, kadapa on 04-01-2016 requesting him to declare the property in Sy.No.489/1 as Patta land. I am filing the office copy of the application dated 04-01-2016. The same may be marked as Ex.P6. The 3rd respondent- The Assistant Commissioner of Endowments Department, kadapa appointed The Inspector, Endowments

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Department , Proddatur as investigation Officer to ascertain the facts of my application. The Inspector, Endowment Department , Proddatur, after enquiry submitted her report to the 3rd respondent- Assisat Commisioner, Endowment Department for necessary action of deleting the land in Sy.No.489/1 situated at Peddapasupula (V), Peddamudium Mandal, Y.S.R kadapa District up to an extent of 10-40 Cents, belonging to us. I am filing the Photostat copy of the report dated 15-11-2018 submitted by the Inspector, Endowment Department , Proddatur to the 3rd respondent- Assistant Commisioner, Endowment Department for necessary action of deleting the land in Sy.No.489/1 situated at Peddapasupula (V), Peddamudium Mandal, Y.S.R kadapa District up to an extent of 10-40 Cents the properties from the Sec.43 Property Register of Sri Vankadari Gurappa Satram. The same may be marked as Ex.P7.

- 8) The 3rd respondent - Assisat Commisioner, Endowments Department, Kadapa also requested the 4th respondent - The Special Deputy Collector, Land Protection Cell, Endowments Department, MZ-II, Tirupathi., to enquire on my application and to submit a report whether the lands in Sy.No.489/1 up to an extent of A.c. 10-40 cents of Peddapasupula Village of Peddamudium Mandal

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Are belonging to endowments department or not. The 4th respondent - The Special Deputy Collector, Land Protection Cell, Endowments Department, MZ-II, Tirupathi also enquired and submitted his report after proper enquiry to the 3rd respondent - Assistant Commissioner, Endowment Department, Kadapa on 16-02-2019 through his proceedings in ROC No.61/2018 date: 16-02-2019, recommending for necessary action of deleting the land in Sy.No.489/1 situated at Peddapasupula (V), Peddamudium Mandal, Y.S.R kadapa District up to an extent of 10-40 Cents from the properties from the Sec.43 Property Register of Sri Vankadari Gurappa Satram. The same may be marked as Ex.P8.

9) I submit that I have been turning around the 3rd respondent and other respondents to delete my properties up to an extent of A.c.10-40 Cents in Sy.No.489/1 of Peddapasupula Village of Peddamdium Mandal from the sec.43 Property register of the Endowments Department of Vakadari Gurappa Choultry and to send a letter to the 6th respondent - to delete from the list of Prohibited Properties U/Sec. 22 (A) (1) (C) of the Registration Act, 1908. The 3rd respondent - Assistant Commissioner, Endowments Department, Kadapa was reporting every time that he sent the proceedings to the 2nd respondent -

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The Commissioner, Endowment Department, Kadapa was reporting every time that he sent the proceedings to the 2nd respondent - The Commissioner, Endowments Department, Andhra Pradesh, Gollapudi, Amravati through his proceedings in Rc.No. A4/2629/2018 dt: 27-02-2019 to get formal permission for deleting the land in Sy.No.489/1 situated at Peddapasupula (V), Peddamudium Mandal, Y.S.R. kadapa District up to an extent of 10-40 Cents from the the properties from the Sec.43 Property Register of Sri Vankadari Gurappa Choultry and he has been awaiting for permission. I am filing the Photostat copy of the proceedings in Rc.No. A4/2629/2018 dt: 27-02-2019. The same may be marked as Ex.P9.

10) I submit that the 2nd respondent - The Commissioner, Endowments Department, Andhra Pradesh, Gollapudi, Amravati, dragged on the matter for the years together without going through the proceedings of the 3rd respondent - Assistant Commissioner, Endowment Department, Kadapa and intervened in the matter basing on the proceedings of the District Endowment Officer, Endowments Department, Y.S.R. Kadapa District, through the proceedings in R.C. No.A2/85/2023 dt.14-03-2024. I am filing the Photostat copy of the proceedings in R.C. No.A2/85/2023 dt.14-03-2024 of the District

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Endowment officer, kadapa. The same may be marked as Ex.P10 on my behalf. The Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious institutions and Endowments Act, 1987, nowhere in the act, confers any powers on the Commissioner of Endowment Department in either amending the Commissioner of Endowment Department in either amending the entries or deleting the entries, annulling the entries in the Sec.43 of the property register of Endowments. It is the authority of the Assistant Commissioner of Endowments Department only. The 2nd respondent exceeded his powers and passed rejecting orders in his proceedings No. M2/COE-19024 (35)/6/2024, Dt: 29-04-2024, by rejecting the request for deletion of the land in Sy.No.489/1 with an extent of A.C.10-40 cents situated at Peddapasapula Village, Pdamudium Mandal from the list of Prohibited Properties U/Sec. 22 (A) (1) (C) of the Registration Act, 1908, which are depriving the rights of the petitioners.

11) I submit that the 3rd respondent- The Assistant Commissioner, Endowments Department, Y.S.R. Kadapa District, did not act in accordance with the Endowments Act. As per the Sec.45 of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious institutions and Endowments Act, the aggrieved with

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regard to an entry or omission has to keep an application to the Deputy Commissioner of Endowments for modification or annulment of such entry, or for directing the making of such entry, as the case may be.

12) I submit that we- the 1st and 2nd Petitioners, accordingly, kept applications for deleting the entry with regard to the property of A.c. 10-40 cents in Sy.No.489/1 property of Pedda pasupula Village, Peddamudium Mandal, Kadapa District, from the Sec.43 Property Register of the Vankadara Gurappa Choultry and for deletion of the land in Sy.No.489/1 with an extent of A.C.10-40 cents situated at Peddapasapula Village, Peddamudium Mandal from the list of Prohibited Properties U/Sec. 22(A) (1) (C) of the Registration Act, 1908.

13) I submit that, Accordingly the inspector of the Endowments Department, Proddatur was appointed as an enquiry officer by the 3rd respondent- The Assistant Commissioner, Endowment Department, to enquire into the lands property of A.c. 10-40 cents in Sy.No.489/1 property of Pedda pasupula Village, Peddamudium Mandal, Kadapa District, whether they belong to vankadara Gurappa Choultry or not. Accordingly the inspector of the

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Endowments Department, Proddatur, has enquired and submitted her report to the 3rd respondent- The Assistant Commissioner, Endowment Department, Kadapa stating that the lands property of A.c. 10-40 cents in Sy.No.489/1 property of Pedda pasupula Village, Peddamudium Mandal, Kadapa District does not belongs to the Vankadar Gurappa Choultry and recommended to take necessary action to delete the lands property of A.c. 10-40 cents in Sy.No.489/1 property of Pedda pasupula Village, Peddamudium Mandal, Kadapa District from the Sec.43 property Register of Endowments department belonging to Vankadari Gurappa Choultry and to delete from 22 (A) (1) (c) of the Registration Act and recommended for issuing NOC to the applicant.

14)I submit that the 4th respondent- The Special Deputy Collector/ Deputy Commissioner, Land Protection Cell, Endowments Department, MZ-II, Tirupathi, at the request of the 3rd respondent - The Assistant Commissioner, Endowment Department, enquired into the matter and sent a letter in his proceedings in ROC No.61/2018 Date 16-02-2019 addressing the 3rd respondent - The Assistant Commissioner, Endowment Department recommending the lands entered in Sec.43 register for deletion from 22 (A) (1) (c) of the Registration

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Act to the Sub-Registrar, Jammalamadugu and recommended for issuing NOC to the applicant.

15) It is submitted that the 3rd respondent - The Assistant Commissioner, Endowment Department, without taking action to amend the Sec.43 property Register of Vankadari Gurappa Choultry by deleting the lands property of A.C. 10-40 cents in Sy.No.489/1 property of Pedda pasupula Village, Peddamudium Mandal, Kadapa District from the Sec.43 property register of Vankadari Gurappa Choultry and to send a letter to the 6th respondent - The Sub-Registrar, Jammalamadugu for deletion of the land in Sy.No.489/1 with an extent of A.C.10-40 cents situated at Peddapasapula Village, Peddamudium Mandal from the list of Prohibited Properties U/Sec. 22(A)(1) (C) of the Registration Act, 1908, pertaining to the petitioners, sent Proceedings in Rc.No.4/2629/2018 dt:27-02-2019 to the 2nd respondent- The Commissioner, Endowments Department, Andhra Pradesh, who is having no jurisdiction on the subject.

16) I submit that the 1st petitioner has been turning around the respondents. But they have not been giving proper reply. All of sudden the 5th respondent sent a letter on 1-05-2024 stating that I and my wife - the 2nd Petitioner are having

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no right on the property in Survey No. 489/1 up to an extent of A.C. 10-40 cents of Peddapasupula Village, Peddamudium Mandal, Y.S.R. Kadapa District by attaching the proceedings of the 2nd respondent - The Commissioner, Endowments Department, Andhra Pradesh, rejecting orders in his proceedings No. M2/COE-19024 (35)/6/2024, Dt: 29-04-2024, by rejecting the request for deletion of the land in Sy.No.489/1 with an extent of A.C.10-40 cents situated at Peddapasapula Village, Pedamudium Mandal from the list of Prohibited Properties U/Sec. 22(A) (1) (C) of the Registration Act,1908.

17) I submit that the 2nd respondent un-necessarily involved in the matter, in which he is having no jurisdiction. The jurisdiction for amendment of the Sec.43 property register of the Endowment department lies with the Assistant Commissioner of the Endowments only and order passed by the Assistant Commissioner of Endowments is final.

18) I submit that the Sec. 45 of The Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious institutions and Endowments Act,1987 reads as under:

45. Application in regard to entry or omission to make an entry in register.

1) Any person aggrieved by an entry or omission to make an entry in the

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register maintained under section 43 may apply to the [Endowments Tribunal] [substituted 'Deputy Commissioner' by Act No.33 of 2007, dated 11.12.2007.] for modification or annulment of such entry, or for directing the making of such entry, as the case may be.

- 2) On receipt of the application the [Endowments Tribunal] [substituted 'Deputy Commissioner' by Act No.33 of 2007, dated 11.12.2007.] may after making such enquiry as may be necessary, pass order as [it] [substituted 'hey' by Act No.33 of 2007, dated 11.12.2007.] may deem fit. The order so passed shall , subject to the provisions of sub-section 3, be final; and the Assistant Commissioner shall amend the entry in the register maintained under section 43 in accordance therewith.
- 3) Where any such application relates to the right claimed by the applicant in respect of such entry or omission, the [Endowments Tribunal] [substituted 'Deputy Commissioner' by Act No.33 of 2007, dated 11.12.2007.] shall enquire into and decide the question as if it were a dispute within the meaning of Sec.87 and the provisions of Chapter XII shall apply.

19) I submit that the 5th and 2nd respondents exceeded their powers vested as per the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious institutions and Endowments Act, 1987 and passed orders, such as the 5th respondent stating that the petitioners are having no right on the property in Survey No. 489/1 up

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to an extent of A.C. 10-40 cents of Peddapasupula Village, Peddamudium Mandal, Y.S.R. Kadapa District and of the 2nd respondent - The Commissioner, Endowments Department, Andhra Pradesh, rejecting orders in his proceedings No. M2/COE-19024 (35)/6/2024, Dt: 29-04-2024, by rejecting the request for deletion of the land in Sy.No.489/1 with an extent of A.C.10-40 cents situated at Peddapasapula Village, Pedamudium Mandal from the list of Prohibited Properties U/Sec. 22(A) (1) (C) of the Registration Act,1908, without having jurisdiction.

20)I submit that the 3rd respondent failed to perform his duties. The 3rd respondent - The Assistant Commissioner, Endowment Department,without taking action to amend the entry made in Sec.43 property Register of Vankadari Gurappa Choultry by deleting the lands property of A.c. 10-40 cents in Sy.No.489/1 property of Pedda pasupula Village, Peddamudium Mandal, Kadapa District from the Se.43 Properties register of the Vankadari Gurappa Choultry and to send a letter to the 6th respondent for deletion of the land in Sy.No.489/1 with an extent of A.C.10-40 cents situated at Peddapasapula Village, Pedamudium Mandal from the list of Prohibited Properties U/Sec. 22(A) (1) (C) of the Registration Act,1908, pertaining to the

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petitioners, sent Proceedings in Rc.No.4/2629/2018 dt:27-02-2019 to the 2nd respondent- The Commissioner, Endowments Department, Andhra Pradesh, who is having no jurisdiction on the subject.

21) I submit that I, without having any fault on my side, constrained to turn around the officers and courts by spending huge amount and my precious time due to the erroneous decision of the Endowments Department and also by the incorrect decision of the officers in making correction of their misdeed. Moreover, without making rectification of their mistake, harassing me by way of sending letters stating that I have no right up on my property. More particularly the 5th respondent is exceeding his limits and publicly stating that he will dispossess me from the property and will conduct public auction for lease. The 5th respondent, on 31-05-2024 came to the property, while I was ploughing the land for sowing the seeds in forthcoming rainy season, and told me not to plough the land as he is going to conduct public auction for lease and also told me, or otherwise, to pay rent for the land. Then I replied as "why he is having special interest as the 2nd respondent-Commissioner also did not say that I am not the owner. He is also proclaiming in public that he will

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proceeding further for conducting of public auction of the property for lease and to dispossess me from the property.

22) I submit that I am poor farmer. I and my family are depending on the property.

I purchased the property with my sweating tears. The endowment officers intentionally, knowing that they have no right over the property in any manner, entered my property in Sec.43 register and are demanding me illegal gratifications for removing my property from the Sec.43 property Register of Sri Vankadari Gurappa Choultry. Respondents, knowingly, that the 3rd Respondent is only the authoritative to delete the entries made in the Sec.43 Register of the Endowments Department, making me to sustain heavy loss to me are stating in their proceedings to approach the endowment Tribunal. So many farmers are suffering a lot with the attitude of the Endowment authorities. In such situation, I have no alternative remedy, except to approach this Honourable court. This Honourable court has to extend the powerful and mighty hands to protect the god of Justice, who resides in the victims like me suffering from the arbitrary officers of bribe mongers. This Honourable Court also protect the rights of the victims and innocent individuals like me, which are guaranteed by the constitution of India

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by the constitution of India under Art.14 and 21 of the Indian Constitution.

Otherwise they will become mockery.

23) I submit that, at present, there is a need of construing the intention of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious institutions and Endowments Act, 1987 and the AMENDED Act to minimise the litigation. The officers are exceeding their powers vested by the Act and some of the officers are not performing their duties and unnecessarily dragging on the matters to the courts. It is pious obligation of the Honourable High Courts and Supreme Court of India to frame certain guidelines and interpretation the law. This cannot be done by any other courts, excepting this Honourable Court.

24) I submit that In the circumstances stated above, I have no efficacious alternative remedy, except to approach this Hon'ble Court under Article 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India. I have not filed any writ petition, suit or other proceedings for the relief or relieves sought herein.

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Main Relief

25) I, there fore, pray that the Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus:

a) Declare the Proceedings of the 5th respondent - The Executive Officer, Group Temples, Jammalamadugu in his letter dated 15-05-2024 addressed to the 1st petitioner stating that the petitioners are having no right on the property in Survey No. 489/1 up to an extent of A.C. 10-40 cents of Peddapasupula Village, Peddamudium Mandal, Y.S.R. Kadapa District and of the 2nd respondent - The Commissioner, Endowments Department, Andhra Pradesh, rejecting orders in his proceedings No. M2/COE-19024 (35)/6/2024, Dt: 29-04-2024, by rejecting the request for deletion of the land in Sy.No.489/1 with an extent of A.C.10-40 cents situated at Peddapasupula Village, Peddamudium Mandal from the list of Prohibited Properties U/Sec. 22(A) (1) (C) of the Registration Act,1908, as null and void, inoperative as having no authority and Jurisdiction to enquire into the matter.

b) Declare the proceedings of the 3rd respondent - The Assistant Commissioner, Endowment Department by sending the

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proceedings in R.C.No. A4/2629/2018 dt: 27-02-2019 to the 2nd respondent – Commissioner of Endowments, who is having no power to decide the matter, to take necessary action to issue NOC to the lands in Sy.No.489/1 up to an extent of A.c 10.40 Cents situated at Peddapasupula (V), Peddamudium Mandal, Y.S.R kadapa District, by way of not performing his duties enshrined in Sec.45 (2) of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987., as null and void, inoperative as having no authority and Jurisdiction to enquire into the matter.

- c) Direct the 3rd respondent to amend the Sec. 43 property register of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987, from the property register Sri Vankadara Gurappa Choultry, by way of deleting the lands in Sy.No.489/1 up to an extent of A.c 10.40 Cents situated at Peddapasupula (V), Peddamudium Mandal, Y.S.R kadapa District, belonging to the petitioners and consequentially to send a letter to the 6th respondent for deletion of the land in Sy.No.489/1 with an extent of A.C.10-40 cents situated at Peddapasapula Village, Pedamudium Mandal from the list of Prohibited Properties U/Sec. 22(A) (1) (C) of the Registration Act,1908, pertaining to the petitioners. And

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d) pass such other order or orders as are deemed fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.

26) I submit that it may take months together in receiving the notices, filing counters and hearing on the petition, if this Honourable court orders prior notice on the respondents and the contemplated mischief will be done by the respondents as the 5th respondent is publicly proclaiming that he will take steps for dispossess me and conduct public Auction for lease to the property and occupy the property. In such a case, it will cause me to sustain irreparable loss and on the other hand that there will be no loss to the respondents in granting interim reliefs as prayed for in the interest of justice.

Interim Relief

I, there fore, pray that the Hon'ble Court may be pleased to pass an order Granting an order :

a) Granting an interim order of stay of all further proceedings of the respondents such as going for auction of the property, alienating the property in any way of lease, mortgage, creating charge on the property and interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the property of the cultivable lands in Sy.No.489/1 with an

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
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extent of A.C.10-40 cents situated at Peddapasapula Village, Pdamudium Mandal, Y.S.R. Kadapa District, belonging to us-the Petitioners as farmers they are preparing for sowing seeds after rains, in the guise of the letter of the 5th respondent and the proceedings of the 2nd respondent in M2/COE-19024 (35)/6/2024, Dt: 29-04-2024.



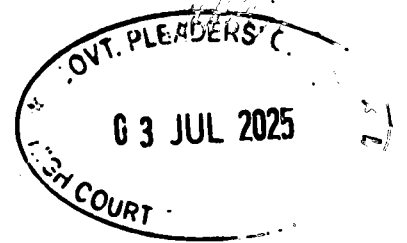

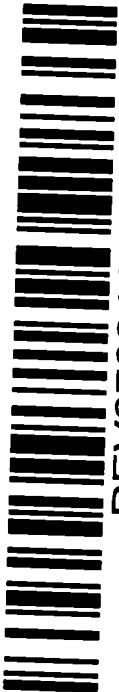
