**Affidavit filed by the Petitioner**

I, Akula Venkaiah S/o late Chinnaiah, aged 58 years, R/o at Punuguntapalem village, Chillakuru Mandal, SPSR Nellore District presently Tirupati District, having now temporarily come down to Amaravati, do hereby solemnly affirm and sincerely state as follows;

1. I am the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner herein and as such I am well acquainted with the facts of the case. I am filing this affidavit on behalf of the petitioners 2 to 4 herein who authorized me to do so.
2. I respectfully submit that we filed the writ petition No.9712/2016 before this Hon'ble Court for seeking mandamus against the respondents authorities herein questioning the proceedings No.LD NO.D3/6818/2016 dated 17-03-2016 passed by the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent commissioner of Endowments Department as illegal , arbitrary and without jurisdiction. and consequently direct the respondents to permit us the performance of Gollavedukalu by our families during the Jathara of Muthyalammavari Temple, , East Kanuru village, Chillakuru Mandal from 29-03-2016 to 10-04-2016 and hence, the writ petition.
3. I further respectfully submit that this Hon'ble Court was pleased to granted interim orders by order dt. 23-03-2016 the grievance of the petitioner is being only against the proceedings dt.17-02-2016 issued by the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent as the same is being prima facie in contravention of the Government Memo NO.1246/Endowments-IV1/2014-I dated. 18-01-2014 , the same shall be **suspended in so far as the Gollavedukalu until further orders.**
4. I further respectfully submit that the petitioners belongs to Yadava Community and the Muthyalammavari who is their Kuladaivam and the goddess also is their Gramadevatha. The origina of temple is unknown. As per the information of our elders, the Swayambhu Devatha was bring reversed as Grama Devatha

from times immemorial by our villagers. Since my ancestors offering pongal on the happening of some event in our family. Since 1942 temple stone and mud walls with thatched roof was erected and then onwards for a period of 4 days Jathara is performed by the village before Ugadi in every year. In this Jathara our families ie., Kota and Akula have been performing "Gollavedukalu" which is one of the important part of the festival.

5. I further respectfully submit that we used to Panchaloha Idols of Bolli Aavu and Basavanna which are kept in Ganga Box and secured in the temple. During festival time there two idols will be taken out and decorated by our family members and taken through the streets offering poojas to the public devotees and brought back to the temple. These procedure goes on all the years by got the two idols made by our forefathers. **The name of Kota Lingaiah and Naraish are inscribed on the idols. So my families have been performing this special festival for the last many years by way of our family custom.** But in the year 2016 the commissioner of endowments issued a proceedings dt. 17-03-2016 vide LD.No.R3/6818 to conduct the festival with 21 members committee and against the same we approached this Hon'ble Court and granted interim suspension of the said proceedings regarding the Gollavedukalu by order dt. 23-03-2016. Since then no body will interfere in the performance of the jathara by way of Gollavedukalu by our families.
6. I further respectfully submit that due to local politics at their influence the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent is going to permit the other persons to perform the Jathara without

giving the idols to us even after notice to him on 18-03-2024 and he gave evasive reply without obey the interim orders passed by this Hon'ble Court and used the abusive language by supporting other OC communities in the village. The Executive Officer, the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent is trying to destroy out ancestral custom of the performance of the Gollavedukula Jathara for period of 4 days from 4-04-2024 to 08-04-2024 ie., for every year before the Ugadi Festival.

7. I further respectfully submit that the respondents without obey the order, the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent violated the same by disobey and also violated the principles of natural justice and supported illegally to the third persons who are nothing to do with the Gollavedukala Jathara of Muthyallammavari Temple of East Kanupur of Chillrakur Mandal. This action of the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent herein will be clearly indicates that he has wilfully disobeyed the Hon'ble Court order and hence, he is liable for face the contempt proceedings as 4<sup>th</sup> respondent herein who intentionally, deliberately and wilfully disobeyed the interim orders passed by this Hon'ble Court and therefore, the respondent No. 4 is held liable for punished under the provisions of Contempt of Courts Act..

8. Under these circumstances, I am constrained to file this contempt case and it is just and necessary that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to punish the respondent NO.4 herein under sec. 10 and 12 of contempt of courts Act as he is deliberately, intentionally and wilfully violated/disobey and flouting the Interim Orders dt. 23-03-2016 passed by this Hon'ble Court in WP No.9712 of 2016 or else we will be put to serious and irreparable loss and hardship.

9. Therefore, I pray that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to punish the respondent NO.4 herein under sec. 10 and 12 of contempt of courts Act as he is deliberately, intentionally and wilfully violated/disobey and flouting the Interim Orders dt. 23-03-2016 passed by this Hon'ble Court in WP No.9712 of 2016 and pass such other and further order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deems fit and proper in the circumstances of this case.

10. It is further prays that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to direct the respondent No.4 herein to allow us to perform the Gollavedukalu Jathara of Muthyalammavari Temple, East Kanupur, Chillakuru Mandal, Tirupati District by virtue of interim orders granted by this Hon'ble Court by order dt.23-03-2016 passed in WP No.9712/2016 pending disposal of the contempt case and pass such other and further order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deems fit and proper in the circumstances of this case.

Affidavit filed by the 1<sup>st</sup> Petitioner

I, Akula Venkaiah S/o. Late. Chinnaiah, Aged about 50 years, R/o. Punuguntapalem Village, Chillakur Mandal, SPSR Nellore District, do hereby solemnly affirm and state as follows:

1. I am the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner herein and as such well acquainted with facts of the case. I am filing this affidavit on behalf of the other petitioners as well, as they have authorized me to do so.
2. I submit that in this Writ Petition we are challenging the action of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent in appointing committee persons to Act during the Jatara of Muthyalamma Ammavari Temple of East Kamepur Village is challenged.
3. I submit that we belong to Yadava Community, Muthyalamma Ammavaru is our Kula Daivam and she is also our Grama Devatha. The origin of the Temple is unknown. As per the information of our elders the Swayambu Devata was being reversed as Grama Devata from times immemorial by Villagers of Turpu Kanupur, Eaddavaripalem, Kumara Varipalem, Pochinaripalem and Ravulu Varipalem. They have been offering Pongal on the happening of some event in their family. In 1942 temple with stone and Mud Walls and thatched roof was constructed. Then onwards a 4 days Jathara is being performed by the villages before Ugadi each year. I submit that several ceremonies like Pothuraju, taking the Devatha through the village streets etc., were being added. One such ceremony is "Gollavedukala" which was being performed by our ancestors and it has become customary for our families. Till 1991 the Jatara festivals were being conducted by the members of Simhadri Family by collecting donations and also from the Temple Funds. In this Jatara the families Kota and Akula have been performing "Gollala Vedukalu" which is one of the important part of the festival. The Panchaloha Idols of Bolli Aavu and Basavanna which are kept in Ganga Box and secured in the temple. During festival time these two idols will be taken out, decorated by our family members and taken through the streets offering Poojas to the Public devotees and brought back to the temple. This procedure goes on during all the three days. These two idols are got

made by our fore fathers. The name of Kota Lingaiah and Naraiah are inscribed on the idols. Our families have been performing this special festival for the last many years.

4. I submit that from the year 1993 the management committee is being appointed for the Temple. The term of the last committee expired on 13-2-2016. I submit that pawns are moved by political leaders to get their followers to be appointed in the festival committee. I submit that the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent Commissioner appointed festival committee with 21 members by his Proceedings in L.D.No:D3/6818/2016, dated 17-3-2016 to conduct the festival. The names were recommended by the Minister of Endowments. This Committee is appointed inspite of a Government Memo No:1246/Endowments-IV-I/2014, dated 18-1-2014 in which it was directed not to appoint festival committee. To circumvent the Government orders the word festival committee is avoided and it is named the devotees. I submit that in the committee no one from our Yadava Community which is the majority community in the Village are figured. Many members from one community which is representing a small community are appointed. I submit the members in the festival committee all belong to one political party which is opposed to our community and they are giving out that we will not be allowed to perform the ceremony of "Gollavedukalu". I submit that we approached the executive officer to issue orders that we can perform our ceremony without any obstruction from festival committee. We have also produced one of such proceedings issued by the person in charge of Management in the year 2002. I submit that though the appointment of the committee is illegal and unsustainable we are not challenging the appointment as it suffice that either the official respondents or the festival committee do not interfere withoutour customary right to perform the ceremony of "Gollavedukalu".
5. I submit that under these circumstances we are constrained to approach this Hon'ble Court for redressal of our grievance. I submit that the action of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent Commissioner in appoint Festival Committee in the name of devotees without specifying the functions to be carried out by it. The committee can only exercise the secular

administration of the festival, but it can not interfere with the ceremonies of the temple. But taking advantage of the vagueness in the orders it is interfering with our customary rights which is wholly arbitrary, illegal without jurisdiction and void. Under these circumstances it is just and necessary that pending disposal of the writ petition. This Hon'ble Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to permit the performance of "Gollavedukalu" by the Petitioners Families during the Jathara of Muthyalamma Ammavari Jathara, East Kanupur Village, Chillakur Mandal to be held from 29-3-2016 to 1-4-2016 as otherwise we will be put to serious and irreparable loss and hardship.

6. The Petitioner has no other effective alternative remedy its redress their grievance and hence this writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.
7. The Petitioner have not filed any earlier writ petition or civil suit or other proceedings before any authority for the relief prayed for in this Writ Petition.
8. For all the aforesaid reasons the petitioners herein pray that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue a writ in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent Commissioner in appointing the committee, for conducting Jathara of Sri Muthyalamma Ammavari Temple East Kanupur by Proceeding NO:L.D.No.D3/6818/2016, dated 17-3-2016 as wholly arbitrary, illegal without jurisdiction and void and consequently direct the respondents to permit the performance of "Gollavedukalu" by the Petitioners Families during the Jathara of Muthyalamma Ammavari Jathara, East Kanupur Village, Chillakur Mandal to be held from 29-3-2016 to 1-4-2016 and pass such other and further orders as this Hon'ble Court deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.
9. I further pray that pending disposal of the writ petition this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to permit the performance of "Gollavedukalu" by the Petitioners Families during Muthyalamma Ammavari Jathara, East Kanupur Village, Chillakur Mandal, SPSR Nellore District to be held from 29-3-2016 to 1-4-2016 and pass such

Since times immemorial my clients' families are performing "Golla Vedukulu" without any hindrance from whatsoever. While so the commissioner of endowments, Government of Andhra Pradesh appointing the committee for conducting Jatara of Sri Muthyalamma Ammavari temple which was preventing my clients to perform traditional events in the Jatara to the deity Muthyalamma Ammavaru. Therefore my clients approached the Hon'ble A.P. High Court questioning the validity of the proceedings dated 17-3-2016 issued by the commissioner Endowments, Hyderabad. The Hon'ble A.P. High Court, Hyderabad suspended the proceedings of the commissioner of endowments in

W.P.No.9712 of 2016 dated 2-3-2016 as it was in contravention of government memo.

3. My client further states that as per the orders of the Hon'ble A.P. High Court, Hyderabad dated 2-3-2016, my clients are entitled to perform the Golla Vedukulu in the coming Jatara to be held in the month of March 2017 one week before Ugadi festival. My clients further state that my clients have approached you personally and gave petition along with High court order and requested you to take necessary steps to implement the High court order. But so far there is no response from you.

4. My client therefore requests you to take all necessary steps to participate my clients in performing "Gollavedukulu" in Muthyalamma Ammavaru Jatara of East Kanupuru village for the year 2017 as per the orders of Hon'ble A.P. High Court, dated 2-3-2016. 1. That my clients informed that they are belongs to Yadava Community and the Muthyalamma Ammavaru is their Kula Daivam and the goddess also is their Grama Devatha. Obviously the origin of temple is unknown. As per information of their elders the Swayambu Devtha was being reversed as Grama Devtha from times immemorial by villagers of Turpu Kanupuru, Edduvaripalem, Kumaravari palem, Pochinaripalem and Ravuluvaripalem. Since my clients ancestors offering pongal on the happening of some event in their family.
2. My clients further states that in 1942 the temple stone and mud walls with thatched roof was constructed and then onwards 4 days Jathara is being performed by the villagers before Ugadi every each year. That several ceremonies like pothuraju, taking the Devtha through the village streets etc.,

were being added. One such ceremony is called as "**Gollavedukalu**" which was being performed by their ancestors and it has become customary for their families. Till 1991 the Jatar festivals were being conducted by the members of Simhadri family by collecting donations and also from the temple funds. In this Jatar the families of Kota and Akula have been performing "**Gollavedukulu**" which is one of the important part of the festival.

3. It is most important to note here that my clients family used the panchaloha Idols of Bolli Aavu and Basavanna which are kept in Ganga Box and secured in the temple. During the festival time these two idols will be taken out, decorated by my clients family members and taken through the streets offering Poojas to the public devotees and brought back to the temple. These procedure goes on all the years by got the two idols made by their forefathers. The names of Kota Lingaiah and Naraiah are inscribed on the Idols. So, my clients families have been performing this special festival for the last many years. In the year 2016 the political involvement the then commissioner has issued one proceedings in LD.No.E3/6818/2016 dt.17-03-2016 to conduct the festival with 21 members committee and against which my clients approached the Hon'ble High Court in WP No.,9712 of 2016 and in the said writ petition the Hon'ble High Court was pleased to granted interim order dt.23-03-2026 "the grievance of the petitioners is being only against the proceedings dt.17-03-2016 issued by the Commissioner as same is being prima facie in contravention of the Government Memo NO.1246/Endowments-IV/2014-1,

dated. 18-01-2014, the same shall be suspended in so far as the  
"GOLLAVEDUKALU" until further orders. The same is pending for final  
decision before the High Court.

I am in receipt of your notice dated 18.03.2024 wherein you have mentioned as per the interim orders in WP No. 9712/2016 dated 23.03.2017 except your clients no other persons shall be allowed to perform the Gollavedukalu during the Jatara in Mutyalamma Ammavari Temple, East Kanupuru, Chillakuru Mandal, SPSR Nellore District

I would like to bring to your notice that, pending the above writ petition two of your clients i.e. Kota Ratnaiah and Kota Subbaramaiah have entered into a compromise with Bonigi Srinivasulu and Bonigi Mohan vide agreement dated 29.03.2019 to share Gollavedukalu every alternative year which will be conducted in the month of March and the copy submitted to this office, as such the issue is being resolved by your clients, as such there is no violation of the orders of Hon'ble high Court as it is their own internal arrangement and I also submit that as per their internal arrangement regarding perform their custom Sri Bonigi Srinivasulu and Sri Bonigi Mohan were performed Gollavedukalu in the year 2018 and 2019.

I further submit that, the WP was filed challenging the orders of Commissioner appointing the committee for conducting jatara vide proceedings dated 17.03.2016 to be held from 29.03.2016 to 01.04.2016. 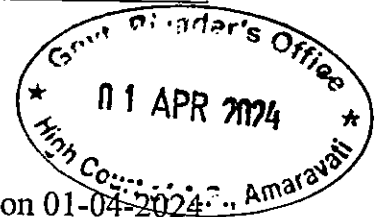
