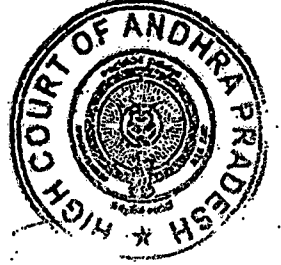

This writ petition is filed to declare the inaction of  
respondents 2 to 6 in appointing the petitioner as Dolu Vidhwan  
at Sri Maddileti Narasimha Swamy Devasthanam, R.S.  
Rangapuram (V), Bethamcherla (M), Nandyala District, on  
compassionate grounds, as illegal and arbitrary.

2. The averments of the affidavit, in brief, are that the  
petitioner's father, while working in respondent No.7,



Devasthanam, died in harness, on 21.09.2015. Thereafter the petitioner made representation to the authorities requesting to provide him employment, on compassionate basis. In pursuance of the same, respondent No.3 addressed letter No.E1/3201/2016 dated 23.08.2016 to respondent No.2, requesting to issue appropriate orders. However, no orders have been passed so far. Hence, the writ petition.

3. Heard Sri N. Chandra Sekhar Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner, and Sri S. Raju, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-I representing learned Government Pleader for Endowments for respondents 1 to 6 and learned standing counsel for respondent No.7.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that since no orders were passed by the authorities, the petitioner made representation on 01.10.2019 through Spandana, and in pursuance of the same, the Executive Officer of respondent No.7 addressed a letter to the Assistant Commissioner, Endowments, who in turn submitted a report to the District Collector. Learned counsel would submit that petitioner submitted another representation, dated 01.11.2022 seeking compassionate

appointment. However, no orders were passed. Learned counsel would submit that, it suffices if a direction is given to the respondent authorities to pass appropriate orders in pursuance of the letter dated 23.08.2016 addressed by respondent No.3 to respondent No.2.

5. The Learned Assistant Government pleader did not refute the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. In the facts and circumstances of the case, without touching the merits of the matter, this writ petition is disposed of at the admission stage with the consent of learned counsel on either side, directing respondent No.2 to pass appropriate orders pursuant to the letter addressed by respondent No.3 *qua* petitioner's appointment on compassionate grounds as expeditiously as possible, preferably within eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.

As a sequel, pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand closed.

1. I am the Petitioner herein as such I am well acquainted with the facts of the case.

2. I am preferring this Writ Petition questioning inaction on the part of Respondents 2 to 6 herein in giving me an appointment as Dolu Vidhwan at Sri Maddileti Narasimha Swamy Devasthanam, R.S.Rangapuram (v), Bethamcherla (m), Nandyala District on Compassionate Grounds as a son of deceased Employee as same is illegal, arbitrary against principles of natural justice.

3. I humbly submit that I am son of one M.Tirupathaiah, who, on 21.09.2015, died in harness while discharging his duties as Bhajantri Dolu Vidhwan at Sri Maddileti Narasimha Swamy Devasthanam, R.S.Rangapuram (v), Bethamcherla (m), Nandyala District, I further submit that at the time of his demise my father had been drawing a salary of Rs.7,000/-, I further submit that after his demise as there is no earning member in family I being unemployed dependent son of diseased employee requested authorities to provide me an employment on compassionate grounds, to discharge duties as Bhajantri Dolu Vidhwan at Sri Maddileti Narasimha Swamy Devasthanam by submitting all relevant documents as directed by Respondents 3 to 6 herein.

4. I further submit that, while so by Letter dt.23.08.2016 The Regional Joint Commissioner, Department of Endowments, Tirupati, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Respondent herein has requested, The Commissioner, Department of

Endowments, Vijayawada, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent herein to issue appropriate orders as contemplated in Circular No.C.O.E/110/2010 dt.24.05.2010, for giving me an appointment under compassionate grounds, as Dolu Vidhwan at Sri Maddileti Narasimha Swamy Devasthanam, R.S.Rangapuram Village, the 7<sup>th</sup> Respondent herein.

5. I further submit later as Respondents 2 to 6 have not passed any orders for giving me compassionate appointment I approached The District Collector, Kurnool by way of preferring a Representation dt.01.10.2019 through Spandana Grievance Redressal System, in pursuance of same The Executive Officer has requested The Assistant Commissioner to take appropriate steps, in turn The Assistant Commissioner has submitted his report to The District Collector informing about Letter dt.23.08.2016 from The Regional Joint Commissioner requesting The Commissioner to issue appropriate orders to act upon my plea for compassionate appointment, except addressing letters they have not taken any steps in that regard.

6. I submit that though, in the Year, 2016, by Letter dt.23.08.2016, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Respondent herein has requested, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent herein to issue appropriate orders as contemplated in Circular No.C.O.E/110/2010 dt.24.05.2010, for giving me an employment under compassionate grounds, as Dolu Vidhwan at Sri Maddileti Narasimha Swamy Devasthanam till now no action has been taken in that regard, as such I have preferred a

Representation dt.01.11.2022 requesting them to provide me compassionate appointment, but they have not responded.

7. it is further submitted that I am advised to state that the inaction on the part of Respondents 2 to 6 herein in giving me an appointment as Dolu Vidhwan at Sri Maddileti Narasimha Swamy Devasthanam, R.S.Rangapuram (v), Bethamcherla (m), Nandyala District as a son of deceased employee is illegal, arbitrary, against the principles of natural justice, if allowed to stand it would occasion a failure of justice, hence this Writ Petition.

8. I submit that I have no other efficacious alternative remedy except to approach this Hon'ble Court and seek its extraordinary jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. I have not filed any writ, suit or initiated any other suit or other proceedings before any other forum for the same relief except filing this present Writ Petition before this Hon'ble Court.

In these circumstances I pray that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction more particularly one in nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the inaction on the part of Respondents 2 to 6 herein in giving Petitioner an appointment as Dolu Vidhwan at Sri Maddileti Narasimha Swamy Devasthanam, R.S.Rangapuram (v), Bethamcherla (m), Nandyala District as son of deceased Employee as illegal, arbitrary, against the principles of natural justice and consequently direct the Respondents 2 to

I, M.Madhu, S/o. Late M.Tirupathaiah, D.No. 7-15, R.S Rangapuram Village, Bethamcherla(Mandal), Kurnool(Dist), humbly request to submitting memorandum to your kind consideration and favorable orders. My father M.Tirupathaiah, was discharging his duties in Sri Maddileti Lakshmi Narasimha Swamy Temple, R.S. Rangapuram(Vil), Bethamcherla Mandal, Nandyala District, as DoluVidvan(Beating Drum) in the team of Bhajanthri performing at the time of Temple rituals& In the RC.No:C2/59649/99-1, dated18/09/2000 The Commissioner, Hyderabad had issued orders in 1999 to pay remuneration of Rs.50 per day in the Subject Temple. As per RJC Tirupathi, D.Dis.No. B1/1385/07. Dated 29-11-2007 the said Amount of Rs.50/- per day was enhanced to Rs.60/- per day in the subject temple in 2007 and Dis.No.B1/706/2008 RJC dated: 19-07-2008 the said amount Rs.60/- per day was enhanced to Rs.110/- per day in the subject temple in 2008.

I further submit that the Commissioner, Endowments issued orders fixing the salaries of my father at Rs.4,500/-Per Month with effect from 01/10/2011 subsequently as per Vide Dis.No:B1/5897/2012, RJC, dated 10/01/2013 salary of my father was enhanced to Rs.7,000/- per month with effect from 2013 in the subject temple.

I further submit that my father M.Tirupathaiah died on 22/09/2015. My father was the sole bread earner of our family and hence our family became distressed. I am the eldest son to my father and our father died in harness leaving our family in penury. Our

family is not having any means of livelihood. Hence after death of my father I have submitted my representation the then E.O of the subject temple had recommended me for compassionate appointment through the Regional Joint Commissioner, Tirupathi. same vide letter No:B1/3201/2016, Dated 23/08/2016 the RJC. Tirupathi has also recommended for the same and requested the commissioner to consider the same in 2016 and The Assistant Commissioner, Kurnool RC.No:A6/4019/2019 had also recommended for the compassionate appointment on Dated 11/10/2019.

I further submit that we have approached High court of Andhra Pradesh and filled Writ Petition WP.No:4805/2023 for the same and respected Justice issued order to provide appropriate orders to appointment on compassionate grounds.

I, therefore, request your good self to kindly consider me for employment on compassionate grounds in the place of my father as I am a eligible candidate for the post of Dolu Vidvan in the subject temple and save our family from financial crisis on account of sudden demise of my father.

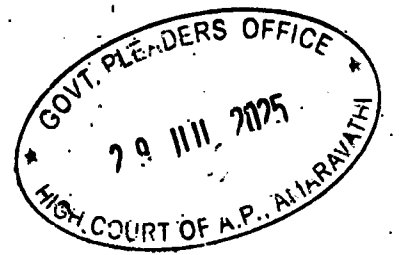
