AFFIDAVIT

I, R.V. Murali Raghava Kumar, S/o. Late Ramanatha Babu, Aged about 52 years, Occ: Business, R/o. H. No.17-113/31, Pulipativari Complex, Radham Street, Nandigama – 521 185, NTR District, do hereby solemnly and sincerely affirm and state on oath as follows.

- 1 I submit that, I am the petitioner in the writ petition and deponent herein and as such I am well acquainted with the facts of the case.
2. I submit that I am filing the present writ petition is filed challenging the action of respondents 1 to 6 in not protecting the land measuring Ac.0.79 Cents out of an extent of Ac 8.32 cents in Sy No.822 of Nandigama Town & Mandal NTR District belonging to the 4th respondent temple from the illegal constructions being made by the respondents 7 and 8 as bad illegal, arbitrary and violative of article 14, 21, 25, and 300-A of Constitution of India.
3. I submit that, this Hon'ble Court was pleased to grant interim orders on 30.06.2025 directing all the parties to maintain Status Quo and the operative portion of the order is extracted hereunder for kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court:
"Till such time, there shall be 'Status Quo' as of today shall be maintained"
4. I submit that, even though this Hon'ble court has directed the

respondents herein to maintain staus quo, the respondents no.6 and 7 are proceeding with the constructions on a war footing basis and the said fact is evident from the photographs which are filed along with the present contempt case.

5. I submit that, the respondents no.1 to 5 who are duty bound to protect the subject lands which absolutely belongs to Sri Ramalingeswara Swamy Devasthanam, Nandigama Town & Mandal, NTR District are not taking any steps to protect the said lands. Further when I requested the respondents no.1 to 5 to halt the construction process obliging the orders of the Hon'ble court, they behaved in an unabashed manner. I have even taken them to the site and shown the order copy and the construction activity but the same is in vain and no action is taken to stall the same and the construction is going as on today.
6. I submit that, the action of the respondents is not only arbitrary but amounts to clear violation of the orders of this Hon'ble Court. The respondents, despite being aware of the directions, have deliberately chosen to contravene the same. This act of the respondents clearly establishes that they are willfully flouting the orders of this Hon'ble Court. Hence the present contempt case.
7. I submit that the respondents do not have any respect towards the orders of this Hon'ble Court and they are willfully and wantonly violating the orders, as such they are liable for punishment under the Contempt of Courts Act.

It is therefore prayed, that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to punish the respondent under Sections 10 to 12 of The Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for willful violation and disobedience of the orders of this Hon'ble Court passed in W.P

ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the respondents.

It is contended that the respondent No.4 - Temple is the absolute owner of the subject land, however, the unofficial respondents have encroached over the subject land and made constructions and no action has been taken against them.

Learned Standing Counsel for the 4th respondent Temple would submit that the Temple has taken all necessary steps to protect the lands belonging to it.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue would also submit that the subject land belongs to the respondent No.4 - Temple.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to takeout personal notice to the unofficial respondent Nos.7 & 8 through registered post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service in the Registry by the next date of hearing.

AFFIDAVIT

I, R.V. Murali Raghava Kumar, S/o. Late Ramanatha Babu, Aged about 52 years, Occ: Business, R/o. H. No.17-113/31, Pulipativari Complex, Radham Street, Nandigama – 521 185, NTR District, do hereby solemnly and sincerely affirm and state on oath as follows.

1. I submit that, I am the petitioner herein and as such I am well acquainted with the facts of the case.
2. I submit that I am filing the present writ petition is filed challenging the action of respondents 1 to 6 in not protecting the land measuring Ac.0.79 Cents out of an extent of Ac 8.32 cents in Sy No.822 of Nandigama Town & Mandal NTR District belonging to the 4th respondent temple from the illegal constructions being made by the respondents 7 and 8 as bad illegal, arbitrary and violative of article 14, 21, 25, and 300-A of Constitution of India.
3. I submit that, I am the founder family member of 4th respondent temple and I was declared as such by proceedings of the 2nd respondent dated 12.06.2022. As such I am person having interest as defined under section 2 (18) of the Act 30/87 and I have locus standi to file the present Writ Petition.
4. I submit that the 4th respondent temple is absolute owner of the lands measuring around Ac. 1200.00 cents in various Survey Numbers Situated in Nandigama Etc out of which, Sy.No Ac 822 of an extent of Ac 8.32 cents also belongs to 4th respondent temple, the said fact is established as per the entries made in the R.S.R and Section 38 register of Act 30/87 of the temple.

5. I submit that, all of a sudden, without any notice and without any enquiry, the revenue records show that Survey No. 822 is sub-divided into 822/2, 822-1A, & 1C measuring around Ac 0.79 cents, 2.38 & 2.54 cents respectively. Out of the said land, the ownership of the land bearing Survey No. 822-2 of the extent of Ac. 0.79 cents is changed from the 4th Respondent Temple to the District Board. These entries were made without any notice or enquiry what so ever behind the back of the temple.
6. I submit that there are not documents or proceedings to shown that the land is sold to the District Board and there are or no land acquisition proceedings and the temple having received the compensation on the subject land, as such changing the name of the temple in the Adangal is illegal, arbitrary and abuse of power.
7. I submit that, at present Respondents No. 7 and 8 are resorting to illegal constructions in the said land bearing Survey No. 822 i.e. sub-division 822-2 of an extent of Ac. 0.79 cts. They neither have the requisite permissions from the Nandigama Nagara Panchayat to construct the building nor do they have any documentary evidence to prove their ownership of the said land. Further the temple has not given any permission to the respondents No. 7 and 8 to make any construction as such the construction are illegal construction.
8. I submit that having come to know about the illegal constructions, immediately I have submitted representation dated 11.05.2025 to the 4th Respondent requesting to him to take necessary action for stopping constructions and to recover the possession of subject lands from the 7th and 8th respondent and to change the name from the District Board to temple, by changing records from their names. Consequently, the 4th Respondent had sent a letter dated 12.05.2025 to the Respondent No. 5 informing that the lands belongs to 4th respondent temple and to change the name to the 4th respondent temple from the District Board.

9. I submit that, except making the above mentioned representation to the 5th Respondent, the 4th Respondent Executive Officer failed to take any further action to recover the possession of the land belonging to the 4th Respondent Temple and to protect the said lands from illegal construction.
10. I submit that, to this date, the Respondents No. 7 and 8 are continuing their illegal constructions on the said land and no action is being taken by the official Respondents. As I am the sole trustee to the temple, I am unable to evict /stop the illegal construction, as the respondent 7 and 8 are powerful people. Coming to official respondent they are having power and system for taking action against the illegal constructions being made by the respondent No.7 and 8.
11. I submit that the Respondent No. 1 to 3 are not initiating any action on the illegal constructions being made by the respondent No.7 and 8 and if the same is allowed further, it will cause irreparable loss and injury to the 4th Respondent Temple. Further the official respondents are entrusted with the duty of protecting the temple lands, they have failed to take the necessary action. Hence the present W.P is filed.
12. I submit that, I have earlier filed W.P No. 5570/2023 seeking to restore the Inam lands belonging to the 4th respondent temple and interim orders were also granted on 06.05.2024 and the said W.P is pending. As no action is taken basing on the interim orders, I have also filed C.C No. 4329 of 2024 for non-compliance of the said interim orders and the same is pending.
13. It is humbly submitted that the petitioner has no other alternative and efficacious remedy except to approach this Hon'ble Court under Article 226 of constitution of India.
14. It is submitted that the petitioner has not filed any suit, application or petitions before any court of law and I have not sought for any similar relief.

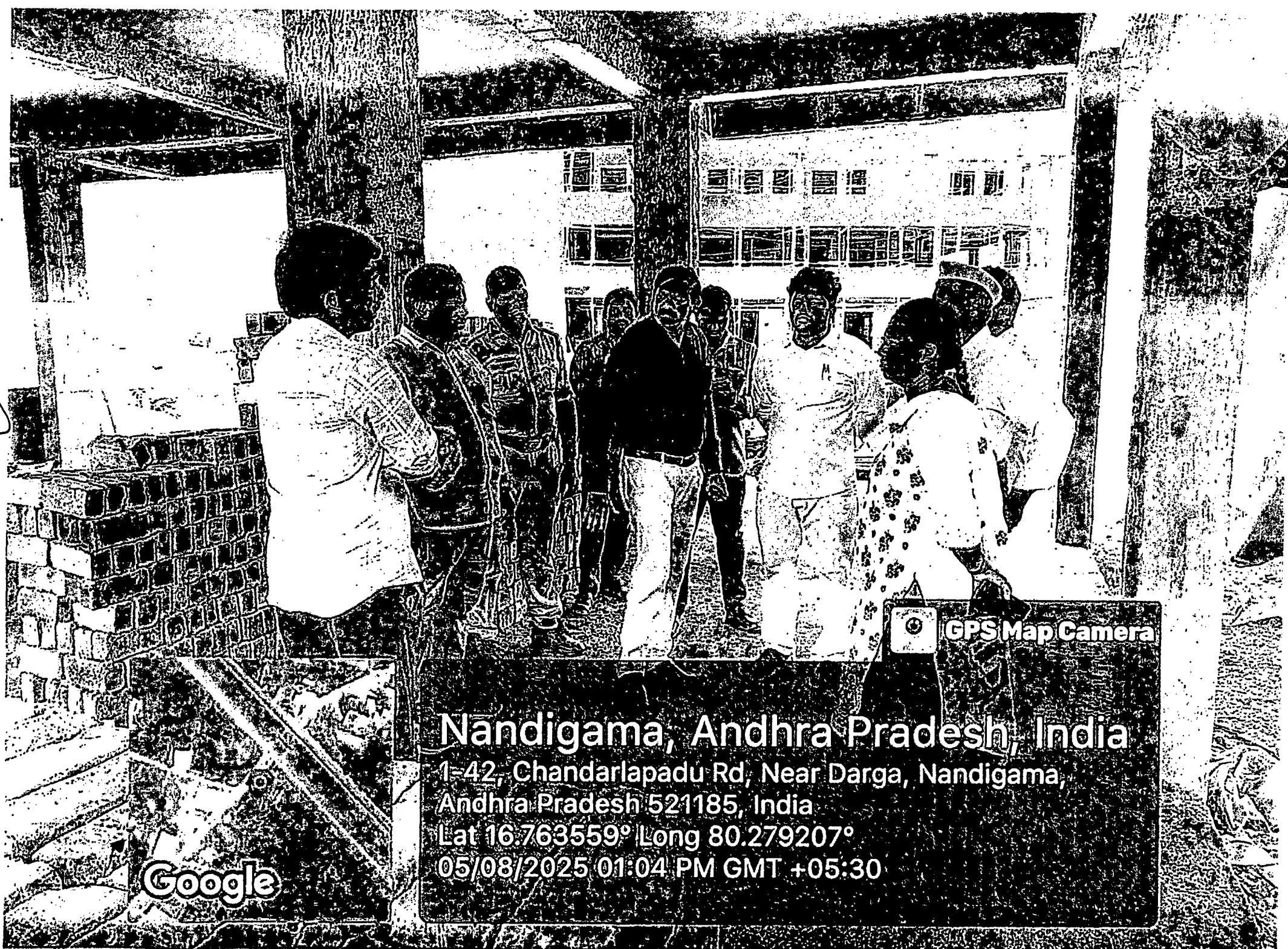

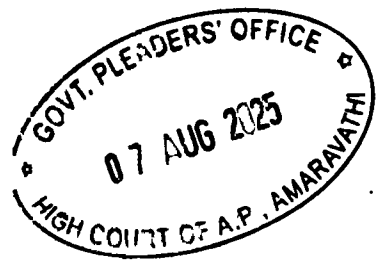
