
1. I am the petitioner in the writ petition and in the present contempt case and as such I am well acquainted with the facts of the case.
2. It is humbly submitted that, the writ petition was filed challenging the action of the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent in not declaring the petitioner as Founder Family Member of Sri Raja Rajeswari Ammavari Temple, Durgamitta,

Nellore, SPSR Nellore District by considering petitioners application dated 28.11.2024 as bad, illegal, arbitrary and abuse of power, violative of principles of natural justice and violative of Article 14, 16 & 21 of Constitution of India

3. I submit that, thereafter this Hon'ble Court was pleased to dispose of the WP 31285/2024 on 07.01.2025 and the operative portion of the said order is extracted hereunder for kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court:
  - "6. Considering the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader, Respondent No.1 is directed to consider and dispose of the representation, dated 28.11.2024 submitted by the petitioner within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order after giving opportunity to the petitioner herein.
  7. With the above directions, this Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs".
4. I submit that, thereafter I have submitted representation dated 27.01.2025 to the respondents herein requesting to consider my representation dated 28.11.2024 as per the directions of this Hon'ble Court.
5. I submit that, the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent has issued Memo Rev01.Endomisc/6/2025 dated 02.01.2025 (wrongly typed instead of 01.02.2025) to the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to submit the remarks with regard to the representation filed by me for taking further action.
6. I submit that, thereafter again I have submitted representation dated 23.04.2025 to the respondents herein requesting to consider my representation dated 28.11.2024 as per the directions of this Hon'ble Court and the Memo dated 02.01.2025 and to declare me as Founder






Family Member of Sri Raja Rajeswari Ammavari Devasthanam but as on today no action is taken.



ORDER

This petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the following relief:-

*"...may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction one more particularly in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent in not declaring the petitioner as founder family member of Sri Raja Rajeswari Ammavari Temple, Durgamitta, Nellore SPSR Nellore District by considering petitioners application dated 28.11.2024 as bad, illegal, arbitrary without Jurisdiction and violative of Articles 14, 21, 25 and 26 of*

*Constitution of India and consequentially direct the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent to declare the petitioner founder family member of Sri Raja Rajeswari Ammavari Temple, Durgamitta, Nellore SPSR Nellore District and pass....".*

2. The case of the petitioner in brief is that the father of the petitioner Chinnappa Ratna Swamy Mudilyar has constructed Sri Raja Rajeswari Ammavari Temple, Durgamitta, Nellore in the year 1968 out of his own funds and sought declaration as founder trustee. To that effect, he has filed O.A.No.35 of 1985 as per 1966 Act and he was declared as such by the Deputy Commissioner, Endowments Department, Guntur District on 27.03.1986. After the death of his father, one of his brothers Ratnam Sundaraju got declared as founder family member on 05.12.1996 and he was managing the temple. Thereafter, the elder brother Ratnam Jayaram has submitted application to declare him as founder family member. The application filed by his eldest brother Sri Ratnam Jayaram was allowed by the office of the Commissioner, Endowments Department *vide* proceedings in Rc.No.C3/20126/2002, dated 23.09.2002. In the said proceedings, the so called applications seeking petitioner declaration as founder family member which was submitted by Ratnam Sundar Raju was rejected on the ground that he did not file any documents. The petitioner has not submitted any application along with his brother Ratnam Sundar Raju. But his signature was forged and submitted applications. As per Section 15 r/w. Section 17 of the Act 30/87, it is the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent who is the competent authority to declare the petitioner as founder family member as the income of the temple is




between 1 crore to 5 crores. Explaining the above facts and circumstances, the petitioner has submitted a detailed representation to the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent on 28.11.2024. But the said representation was not considered by the Respondent No.1. Hence, the present Writ Petition is filed.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader for Endowments appearing for the respondents.

4. On hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the petitioner has submitted a representation, dated 28.11.2024 to the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent, requesting to declare the petitioner as founder family member of Sri Raja Rajeswari Ammavari Temple, Durgamitta, but the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent has not considered the said representation, which is illegal, arbitrary and violative of principles of natural justice. Hence, the learned counsel for the petitioner requests to pass appropriate orders.

5. Learned Government Pleader for Endowments appearing for the respondents has furnished a copy of the letter, dated 31.12.2024 addressed by the Executive Officer of Sri Raja Rajeswari Ammavari Temple, Durgamitta, Nellore to the District Endowments Officer and Executive Officer. Basing on the same, learned Government Pleader submits that the applications submitted by the family members of the petitioners ie., Sri R.Bala Krishna, R.Krishna Murthy, Smt M.Vasantha, Smt D.Bhuvaneswari, Smt T.Menaka and Smt C.V.Visalakshi are rejected on the ground that their names have not been mentioned in the Will, dated 31.05.1989 executed by the father of the



petitioner. He further submits that in view of the contents of the Will, the request of the petitioner to declare him as founder family member of Sri Raja Rajeswari Ammavari Temple, Durgamitta will be rejected and prayed to dismiss the Writ Petition..

6. Considering the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader, Respondent No.1 is directed to consider and dispose of the representation, dated 28.11.2024 submitted by the petitioner within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order after giving opportunity to the petitioner herein.

7. With the above directions, this Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall also stand closed.

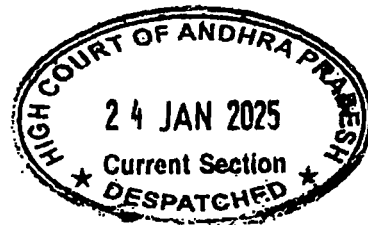

1. I humbly submit that, I am the deponent herein and petitioner in the  
present writ petition and as such, well acquainted with the facts the  
case.
2. I submit that the present writ petition is filed challenging the action of  
the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent in not declaring the petitioner as founder family

member of Sri Raja Rajeswari Ammavari Temple, Durgamitta, Nellore by considering petitioner's representation dated 28.11.2024 as being illegal, arbitrary, without Jurisdiction and violative of Articles 14, 21, 25 and 26 of Constitution of India.

3. I submit that, my father Chinnappa Ratna Swamy Mudiliyar has constructed Sri Raja Rajeswari Ammavari Temple, Durgamitta, Nellore in the year 1968 out of his own funds.
4. I submit that, my father sought declaration as founder trustee and filed O.A NO. 35/1985 as per 1966 Act and he was declared as such by the Deputy Commissioner, Endowments Department, Guntur District on 27.03.1986. Thereafter he functioned as founder trustee of the temple. Thereafter the hereditary trusteeship was abolished. Subsequently by virtue of amendment to the Act 30/87, as per Sec. 17 the founder family members were given chance of acting as trustees and chairman to the temple.
5. I further submit that, my father had 6 male children, 4 daughters and the details are follows:

**SONS:**

- i. Ratnam Jayaram
- ii. Ratnam Kannappa (Died)
- iii. Ratnam Selvaraj (Died)
- iv. Ratnam Balakrishna
- v. Ratnam Sundar Raju (Died)
- vi. Ratnam Krishnamurthy

- i. Visalakshi
- ii. S. Vasantha- (Died)
- iii. T. Menaka
- iv. A. Bhuvaneswari

6. I submit that, after the death of my father, one of my brother Ratnam Sundarraju got declaration as founder family member on 05.12.1996 and he was managing the temple. Thereafter my eldest brother Ratnam Jayaram has submitted application to declare him as founder family member. In the said application it was categorically observed @ Page 3 at para 2 that Sri Ratnam Sundar raju has forged other family signatures along with my signature and also submitted application seeking declaration as founder family members.
7. I submit that, the application filed by my eldest brother Sri Ratnam Jayaram was allowed by the office of the Commissioner, Endowments Department vide proceedings in Rc.No.C3/20126/2002 dated 23.09.2002 in the said proceedings the so called applications seeking my declaration as founder family member which was submitted by Ratnam Sundar Raju was rejected on the ground that he did not file any documents and was absenting and also mentioning about a will executed by my father dated 31.05.1989 wherein our rights were not relinquished, but for the time being Jayaram the eldest son was asked to act as founder trustee along with others to the temple hereditarily and all other rituals were also given to all the family members, this

was interpreted as if our rights were relinquished and our applications were rejected in 2002.

8. I submit that, I have not submitted any application along with Sundar Raju my brother, he has forged our signatures and submitted applications further the hereditary trusteeship / founder family member declaration unless specifically relinquished cannot be taken away by averments made in the will are by any authority, as such being a member of the founder family, I am also entitled to be declared as founder family member and I also have the right to function as founder family member of the subject temple.
9. I submit that, while the matter stood thus the law was declared on the declaration of founder family membership by the erstwhile Hon'ble Court in CMA 590/2012 upheld by Supreme Court wherein once a member is declared as founder trustee as per old act, it is not necessary to get a declaration afresh by virtue of operation of Sec. 17 of Act 30/87 and authority can declare. In the instant case there is no dispute relating to my father declaration and I being his legal heir, as such I have to declared. All other aspects are not necessary for declaration.
10. I submit that, Sec. 17 of Act 30/87 speaks as follows:
- Explanation I :- "Founder" means**
- (a) in respect of institution of Endowments existing at the commencement of this Act, the person who was recognized as

Hereditary Trustee under the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1966 or a member of his family recognized by the competent authority.

- (b) In respect of an Institution or Endowments established after such commencement, the person who has founded such institution or Endowment or a member of his family and recognized as such by the competent authority.

**Explanation II** :- "Member of the family of the founder" means children, grandchildren and so in agnatic line of succession for the time being in force and declared or recognized as such by the relevant appointing authority.

11. I submit that by virtue of the above provision of laws & judgment, the order dated 23.09.2002 passed behind my back is non-est in the eyes of law and as per the settled law I have to be declared as founder family member of Sri Raja Rajeswari Ammavari Temple, Durgamitta, Nellore. I was not aware of the 2002 order as the same was not communicated to me, now as the Ratnam Sundar Raju died and my eldest brother Ratnam Jayaram become old and crippled, I am entitled to founder family membership on rotation basis or as desired by the Hon'ble Authorities.
12. I submit that, as per Sec. 15 R/w Sec. 17 of Act 360/87, it is the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent who is competent to declare me as founder family member as income of the temple is between 1 crore to 5 crores.

13. I submit that, explaining the above facts and circumstances I have submitted a detailed representation to the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent on 28.11.2024, but till date the same is kept pending. Hence the present writ petition.
14. I submit that, unless the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent considers my representation dated 28.11.2024 by affording opportunity and declares me as founder family member of Sri Raja Rajeswari Ammavari Temple, Durgamitta, Nellore, I will be put to irreparable loss and Injury which cannot be compensated by any means.
15. I submit that, In the said circumstances, I am constrained to approach this Hon'ble Court seeking Justice, under Article 226 of Constitution of India having no other alternative efficacious remedy.
16. I submit, I have not filed any other writ petition, suit or other proceedings for the relief or reliefs sought herein nor the same are pending.

Therefore, In view of the facts and circumstances stated above, it is further prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction, one more particularly in the nature or writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent in not declaring the petitioner as founder family member of Sri Raja Rajeswari Ammavari Temple, Durgamitta, Nellore, SPSR Nellore District by considering petitioner's application dated 28.11.2024 as bad, illegal, arbitrary, without Jurisdiction and violative of Articles 14, 21, 25 and

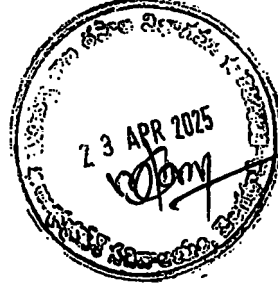



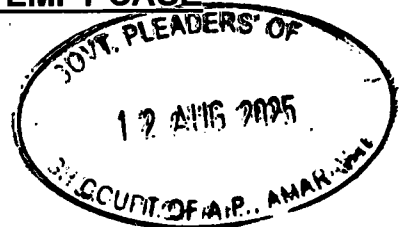
