

I, Kristipati Suryanarayana, S/o. Late Venkata Ramanaiah, Age 81 Years, Occ : Hereditary Archaka of Sri Ramalingeswara Swamy Temple, Nanganurupalli village, Proddatur Mandal, YSR Kadapa District, having temporarily came down to Vijayawada do hereby solemnly affirm and state on oath as follows:


1. I am the petitioner herein, as such I am well acquainted with the facts of the case.





2. I submit that, the present writ petition is filed challenging the action of the 4th respondent in issuing auction notification dated 14.04.2025 for conducting public auction for leasehold rights of the land measuring Ac.3.96 cents in Sy. No. 36/3 and kalyanamandapam in land measuring Ac. 0.50 cents in Sy. No. 93/1 of Nanganurupalli village, Proddatur Mandal, YSR Kadapa District on 23.04.2025 as bad, illegal, arbitrary, without application of mind, unreasoned, violative of principles of natural justice, without jurisdiction and violative of Article 14, 21 & 25 of Constitution of India.
3. I submit that, originally my forefathers used to perform the hereditary archakatvam in the subject temple by managing the same since time immemorial. Thereafter my father rendered hereditary archakatvam by enjoying the land measuring Ac.3.96 cents in Sy. No. 36/3 and land measuring Ac. 0.50 cents in Sy. No. 93/1 of Nanganurupalli village, Proddatur Mandal, YSR Kadapa District and managed the temple, thereafter I am managing the affairs of the temple & rendering hereditary archakatvam by enjoying lands.
4. I submit that, while the matter stood thus my possession was proposed to be disturbed in the year 2003 from Ac.3.96 cents which is an archakatvam land in lieu of remuneration. I have filed WP No. 2892/2003 on the ground that temple was not published under the Endowments Act and I am the hereditary archaka and interim orders were granted on 18.02.2003. Pending the writ petition the temple was published U/Sec. 6(c) on 06.03.2003 and thereafter the writ petition was dismissed as infructuous on 30.09.2010.
5. I submit that, even when the trust board was proposed to be constituted on 10.03.2003 I have filed R.P. 71/2003 before Regional Joint Commissioner, Endowments Department, Tirupathi and stay was granted with a direction not to interfere with the possession and





management. Thereafter again on 08.11.2011 Executive Officer was directed to be appointed, I have approached the Deputy Commissioner, Endowments Department, Kurnool and he endorsed as "when the archakas are not getting wages and traditionally cultivating small extent of land Ac.3.96 cents why are we harassing them by issuing such notices".

6. I submit that, thereafter the Deputy Commissioner, Endowments Department, Kurnool issued proceedings in Rc. No. A2/10397/2010/EO.Estt dated 04.06.2011 appointing me as single trustee and authorized me to manage the affairs of the temple with some conditions. Thereafter none have interfered with the management of the temple and also with the possession of archaka service inam land. While the matter stood thus Ac.0.50 cents in Sy. No. 93/1 which is in front of the temple has become non cultivable, I with the help of donors have constructed kalyanamandapam and 80% of the same is completed. The reason for construction of kalyanamandapam is to generate income to the temple.
7. I submit that, the temple does not have any source of income and there are no hundials also. The income of the temple is below Rs.2 lakhs, as such I was managing and rendering hereditary archakatvam in the temple by enjoying Ac. 3.96 cents toward remuneration. While the matter stood thus the 4th respondent E.O. has issued auction notification dated 14.04.2025 for conducting public auction for leasehold rights of the land measuring Ac.3.96 cents in Sy. No.. 36/3 and kalyanamandapam in land measuring Ac. 0.50 cents in Sy. No. 93/1 of Nanganurupalli village, Proddatur Mandal, YSR Kadapa District on 23.04.2025. Hence challenging the same the present writ petition is filed.

8. I submit that, the Commissioner, Endowments has issued a circular in Rc. No. L2/63873/2001 dated 04.12.2001 directing not to interfere with the land under the possession of archakas in Sec. 6 (c) institutions, thereafter the Govt. has also issued GOMs No. 298 dated 06.07.2023 exempting the temples from Sec. 15, 29, 57 & 65 to those temples whose income is below Rs.5 lakhs, as such E.O. issuing notification is bad, illegal, arbitrary and without jurisdiction.
9. I further submit that, as per Sec. 144 of Act 30/87 abolition of share in hundis and other rusums including the lands, but this provision is not made applicable to the temples having income below Rs.5 lakhs, as such the land which is being cultivated by me towards archakatvam service cannot be put to public auction. Further as per Sec. 34 (3) of Act 30/87 the hereditary archaka families have right to enjoy the lands while rendering archakatvam till the scheme framed U/Sec. 144 but Sec. 144 proviso makes it clear that archakas lands cannot disturbed whose temple income is below Rs.5 lakhs, in the instant case the 4th respondent temple is below Rs.2 lakhs. Even the similar provision is defined in Sec. 35 (3) of Act 30/87 for enjoying lands.
10. I submit that, in the above mentioned circumstances the 4th respondent issuing auction notification for conducting public auction of the subject lands which are in my possession is illegal, arbitrary and without jurisdiction, hence the same are liable to be set aside.
11. I submit that, if the auction is allowed to be continued, I will be put to irreparable loss and injury as the said land is only source of income / remuneration for my archakatvam service.
12. I submit that the petitioner has no other alternative and efficacious remedy except to approach this Hon'ble Court under Article 226 of constitution of India.



13. I submit that the petitioner has not filed any suit, application or petitions before any court of law and we have not sought for any similar relief.

For the reasons stated above, it is prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ order or direction more particularly, one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, Declaring the action of the 4th respondent in issuing auction notification dated 14.04.2025 for conducting public auction for leasehold rights of the land measuring Ac.3.96 cents in Sy. No. 36/3 and kalyanamandapam in land measuring Ac. 0.50 cents in Sy. No. 93/1 of Nanganurupalli village, Proddatur Mandal, YSR Kadapa District on 23.04.2025 as bad, illegal, arbitrary, without application of mind, unreasoned, violative of principles of natural justice, without jurisdiction and violative of Article 14, 21 & 25 of Constitution of India and consequentially set aside the same and direct the respondents not to interfere with the petitioner's peaceful possession over the subject lands and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

Pending disposal of the writ petition it is prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings pursuant to impugned auction notice dated 14.04.2025 issued by 4th respondent for conducting public auction for leasehold rights of the land measuring Ac.3.96 cents in Sy. No. 36/3 and kalyanamandapam in land measuring Ac. 0.50 cents in Sy. No. 93/1 of Nanganurupalli village, Proddatur Mandal, YSR Kadapa District on 23.04.2025 and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

Land Lease Public Auction Notice

The land belonging to Sri Ramalingeswara Swamy Devasthanam, located in Nanganurupalle village, Proddatur Mandal, YSR Kadapa District, which is under the ownership and enjoyment rights of the temple, will be leased for a period of 3 years through public auction. The auction will be held on Wednesday, 23-04-2025 at 10:00 AM at the said temple premises in the presence of departmental officials. Those who wish to participate in the auction must deposit Rs. 10,000/- as security deposit. Immediately after the auction, the highest bidder must pay one year's lease amount in advance. If the amount is not paid, the deposit will be forfeited, and the land will be immediately re-auctioned. The department reserves the right to postpone or cancel the auction without assigning any reason. Anyone who has financial dealings with the temple or has any outstanding dues is not eligible to participate in the auction. The remaining terms and conditions will be disclosed before the auction.

CONDITIONS

1. This auction will be conducted by the Executive Officer of the temple, subject to the approval of Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments Department, Vijayawada.
 2. Every bidder intending to participate must submit property details and a certificate from Revenue Officials, and pay Rs. 10,000 as deposit before the auction to the Executive Officer.
 3. Those with pending dues to the temple or any kind of transactions with the temple are not eligible to participate. The Executive Officer has full authority to disallow ineligible participants.
 4. Generally, the highest bid will be accepted. However, the department reserves the right to select any other bidder if deemed fit.
 5. The Executive Officer has full authority to postpone or cancel the auction at any time without providing a reason.
 6. The property will be leased for 3 financial years only: 2025-2026, 2026-2027, and 2027-2028.
 7. Immediately after the auction, the successful bidder must pay the entire lease amount and obtain a receipt.
 8. Only Hindus are eligible to lease temple land. Bidders must submit a copy of their Aadhaar card along with their bid.
- Note: The highest bidder must pay the lease amount for each year by March 31st of that financial year and obtain a receipt. Failure to do so will result in the land being re-auctioned without any notice.

Petition under Section 151 of CPC praying the High Court may be pleased to pass suitable order or orders in the nature of directions to the respondents 1 and 2 not to interfere petitioner's management of the temple Sri Rama Lingeswara Swamy and possession of land bearing S.No. 36/3 situated at Naganoorupalli Village of Proddatur Mandal Cuddapah District pending W.P. No. 2892 of 2003 on the file of the High Court.

The Court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause why this application should not be complied with, made the following order. (The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

ORDER :

"The Writ Petition is filed alleging that the respondents, without passing any order with reference to the Sri Ramalingaswamy Temple, Nanganoorupalli Village, Proddatur mandal, Cuddapah District, are interfering with the possession and orally instructed the petitioner to vacate the temple as well as the temple lands, which is to an extent of Ac.3.97 cents in S.No. 36/3 of the said village. According to the petitioner, the said temple is not notified as contemplated under Section 6 of the A.P., Charitable Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987 (for short, the Act) and, therefore, sought for direction to the respondents not to interfere with the peaceful possession and management of the temple and the temple lands. It is also stated that proceedings were taken up to under section 145 of Cr.P.C. in M.C.No. 33 of 1992 before the Executive Magistrate as there was a dispute between the petitioner and his cousin as to the management of the temple and possession of the temple properties and the Executive Magistrate has passed orders in his favour holding that the Petitioner is in possession and is entitled to be in possession of the temple lands.

In the above circumstances, the respondents are directed not to interfere with the possession and manage, of the temple and the lands unless it is notified under section 6 of the Act, until further orders.

WRIT PETITION No. 2892 OF 2003

ORDER :

This writ petition is filed seeking a declaration that the action of the respondents 1 and 2 in directing the petitioner to vacate the land belonging to Sri Ramalingeswara Swamy Vari Temple at Nanganoorupalli village of Proddutur Mandal, Kadapa District situated in survey No. 36/3 to an extent of Ac.3.96 cents, is arbitrary and illegal.

The petitioner, who claims to be the Archaka of the temple, contended that the land is not notified as contemplated under Section 6 of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987 (for short, 'the Act') and therefore, the impugned action of the respondents 1 and 2 is arbitrary, illegal and without jurisdiction.

This court, while issuing rule nisi, by order dated 18.02.2003 in W.P.M.P.3800 of 2003 granted interim order directing the respondents not to interfere with the possession and management of the temple and the lands unless it is notified under Section 6 of the Act.

A counter affidavit has been filed by the Assistant Commissioner of Endowments, Kadapa stating that after filing this writ petition the temple in question has been published under Section 6 (c) (ii) of the Act under Sl.No.1471 vide proceedings of the Commissioner of Endowments in Rc.No.J3/9773/2003, dated 06.03.2003. A copy of the said proceedings has also been placed before this Court.

In view of the subsequent order dated 06.03.2003, nothing survives for adjudication on merits. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous, leaving it open to the petitioner to challenge the proceedings dated 06.03.2003 by working out the appropriate remedy as available under law, if so advised. No costs.

The Archaka & single Trustee should take steps to lease out the properties in public auction only as per rules and regulations and procedures as laid down in the provisions of the A.P.C. and H.R.I. and Endts., Act 30/87 duly securing the presence of the Departmental Official and get approval orders for every such leases by the competent authority.
4.	That the Archaka & single Trustee should prepare Budget Estimates for every financial year and submit the same to the Assistant Commissioner, Endowments Department, Kurnool before 90 days and get it sanctioned.
5.	That the Archaka & single Trustee should prepare and submit the Income and Expenditure statement of the subject institution at the end of the financial year to the Assistant Commissioner, Endowments Department, Kurnool for assessment of the same U/s 65 of the Act 30/87 for raising of der and for Contribution, Audit fees & C.G.F. by the Commissioner of Endowments Department payable by the institution.
6.	That the Archaka & single Trustee should take steps to get audited the accounts of the institution by the Audit Officer, L.F.Dept., in their respective District soon after closure of every financial year.
7.	That the Archaka & single Trustee should abide for all the provisions of the A.P.C. and H.R.I. Endts., Act 30/87 and rules framed there under applicable to the subject institutions.
8.	That the Archakas should maintain the Inventory Register for Gold & Silver articles and get appraised and insured for their safety from time to time.
9.	However the F.D.Rs if any of the subject temples will be safeguarded in the Assistant Commissioner's office and it will be given for renewal on the date of maturity.
10.	That the Archaka / Single Trustee should not vend or mortgage any Agricultural / Non Agricultural landed properties without the prior permission from the Commissioner, Endowments Department and Government of Andhra Pradesh.
11.	That the Archaka / Single Trustee should not change or vend the Jewellery of the Temple (Gold & Silver) without the prior permission from the competent authorities of Endowments Department.
12.	That the Archaka / Single Trustee should take immediate necessary action to insure the Gold, Silver Jewellery, Utsava Vighrams and Kalasam on Vimana Gopuram & Rajagopurams of the temple if not insured earlier and should renew the Insurance policies every year duly adding the new items.
13.	That the Archaka / Single Trustee should take all precautionary measures to safeguard the Rajagopurams, Vimana gopurams and Dwajasthambam of the subject temple and to watch and take steps for removing of small plants if any raised on the gopurams, Roof etc.,
14.	That the Archaka / Single Trustee should open the hundials of the Temples of the Temple at regular intervals in the presence of the Departmental officers duly obtaining permission from the Assistant Commissioner, Endowments Department, Kurnool.
15.	That the Archaka / Single Trustee should maintain the Cash Books, Ledgers, Vouchers and Bank Accounts properly and should place before the Endowments officers authorised by the competent authorities for verification at any time.

ORDER :

In the reference first read above, the Hon'ble High Court while disposing of W.P.No.21805/2021, directed the State Government to consider the grant of exemption to the temples having an annual income of less than Rs.5.00 lakhs from the provisions of the Act including the requirement to pay the mandatory contributions in the light of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Sri Divi Kodandarama Sarma and others Vs. State of Andhra Pradesh & Others (1997) 6 SCC 139.

2. In the reference second read above, the Commissioner, Endowments Department while narrating the brief history of the case, has requested the Government for necessary orders.

3. The Government has considered all the facts and circumstances and hereby decided to grant exemption to the Temples having assessable income of less than Rupees five lakhs per annum from the operation of Section 15 (appointment of Board of Trustees), where there is a Founder / Member of Founder's Family or where the Temple is under the administration of reputed Religious organization; Section 29 (appointment and duties of Executive Officer) to the Temples, where the Founder / Member of Founder's Family or Hereditary Archaka or reputed Religious organization, in the order of preference, wants to manage the Temples by themselves, and from obtaining Budget approvals and payment of Common Good Fund U/s 57 and from the liability to pay annual contribution [EAF] and Audit Fee U/s 65 of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious institutions and Endowments Act, 1987 (Act No. 30/1987) for a period of 5 years subject to the conditions.

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4. Accordingly, the following Notification will be published in the next issue of Andhra Pradesh Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 154 of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious institutions and Endowments Act, 1987 (Act No.30/1987), the Government of Andhra Pradesh hereby grant exemption to the temples having assessable income of less than Rupees Five lakhs per annum, from the operation of the following provisions of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious institutions and Endowments Act, 1987, for a period of five years:

- i. Section 15: (appointment of Board of Trustees) to the Temples, where there is a Founder / Member of Founder's Family or where the Temple is under the administration of reputed Religious organization.
- ii. Section 29: (appointment of Executive Officer) to the Temples, where the Founder / Member of Founder's Family or Hereditary Archaka or reputed Religious organization in the order of preference, wants to manage the Temples by themselves.
- iii. Section 57: (submission of budget and payment of Common Good Fund) and
- iv. Section 65: (Liability to pay annual contribution to Endowment Administrative Fund and Audit Fee).

Subject to the following conditions:-

1. These exemptions shall not apply to the temples covered either under the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains Act, 1958 (Central Act No.24 of 1958) or under the Andhra Pradesh Ancient and Historical Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains Act, 1960 (Andhra Pradesh Act No 07/1960).
2. The prevailing traditions of pooja vidhanam, customs and sampradayams of the respective Temples shall not be disturbed and same shall be strictly followed.
3. New appointments of any kind, without obtaining prior permission of the Commissioner of Endowments are strictly prohibited. Commissioner can also accord permission to engage staff on outsourcing basis alone.
4. No immovable or movable properties shall be transferred except as per the provisions of section 80 of the A.P. Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987 (Act No.30 of 1987).

"Transfer" means any sale, gift, exchange, mortgage with or without possession or any other transfer of endowed lands and includes a charge on such property or a contract relating to endowed lands in respect of such sale, gift, exchange, mortgage or other transaction.

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5. The landed properties shall be protected from illegal sale, mortgage, exchange, unauthorized lease / license and encroachment.
6. All the properties of such temples shall be entered in section 43 register of the Temple and it shall be ensured that they are included in the prohibitory list maintained by the Registration Department under section 22-A(1)(C) of the Registration Act, 1908.
7. No lands or shops of the Temple shall be given for lease / license for more than three (3) years. All leases of shops, lands and other licenses shall be by way of only public auction and approval from the competent Authority shall be mandatorily obtained as per Rules.
8. No FDRs shall be encashed without the prior approval of the Commissioner under any circumstances.
9. No structural changes shall be made either within the Temple prakaram or abutting the temple prakaram without obtaining prior approval from the Commissioner of Endowments.
10. If any illegality or irregularity is identified in the administration of the Temple, the Commissioner shall initiate action as per the provisions of the Act.

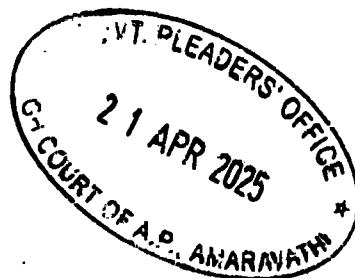
