No. F2/9307210/2024-2, dated 22/09/2024 is illegal and not in accordance with the Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987 read with Sri Ahobila Mutt Parampara Adheena vs The State Of Andhra Pradesh on 13 October2022 as reported in 2022 (6) ALT 628

(DB) (AP) as the same is unlawful, arbitrary, unconstitutional, violative of principles of natural justice, violative of Doctrine of Estoppel and Doctrine of Legitimate Expectation, thereby offending the religious sentiments of the petitioners and consequently direct the Respondents and consequently set aside the the appointment of Respondent No. 5 as Executive Officer to the Sri Mad Virat Pothuluri Veera Bhrahmendra Swamy Mutt and to pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice and in the circumstances of the case.

AFFIDAVIT FILED BY THE PETITIONER

I, Smt.N.Maruthi Mahalakshmi, Gurupathni of the subject Mutt and W/o.Late Sri Sri Sri Veerabhoga Vasanta Venkateswara Swamy Varu, Hindu, Aged about 43 years, R/o.Sri Mad Virat Pothuluri Veera Bhrahmendra Swamy Mutt, Kandi Mallayapalli Village, Brahmamangari Matham Mandal, YSR Kadapa District, do hereby solemnly affirm and sincerely state on oath as follows:

1. I am the Petitioner herein and as such, I am well acquainted with the facts of the case.
2. I humbly submit that the subject matt was founded by Jagdguru Sri Sri Mad Virat Pothuluri Veera Bhrahmendra Swamy varu, famously known as Kalgani who lived on this earth and took Sajeeva Samadhi Nishta in the said Mutt in the year 1693 on

Vaisakha Suddha Dasami which is a auspicious day fixed by him. The said day is being celebrated as Brahmamgari Aradhana Day and disciples, devotees and pilgrims participate in the said Aaradhana on the said day in large numbers. During the said Aradhana celebrations, the Mathadhipathi leads all religious functions including Maha Nivedhana. There will also be other celebrations like Aradhana of previous Mathadhipathis, Guru Matha Govindamamba, Eswari Matha and other Hindu festivals are also celebrated. Except Mathadhipathi and Guru Patni, none can discharge such auspicious poojas in the said celebration including Aradhana. It is being following for the last 330 years, without any break.

Section 2(17) of Act 30/1987 defines "Math" as under:

'Math' means a Hindu Religious Institution presided over by a person, whose principal duty is to engage himself in the teaching and propagation of Hindu religion and philosophy or the teachings and the philosophy of the denomination, sect or sampradaya to which the math belongs and in imparting religious instruction and training and rendering spiritual service or who exercises or claims to exercise spiritual headship over a body of disciples; and includes any place or places of religious worship, instruction or training which are appurtenant to the institution.

3. It is humbly submitted that the present writ petition is being filed assailing the action of the Respondent 2 in appointing R-5 as the Executive Officer of the subject mutt in Item no 2 in Proceedings/Order in Rc. No. F2/9307210/2024-2, dated 22/09/2024 and the unlawful, illegal and un authorised works undertaken by Respondent 5, without consulting the

Gurupathni,. The Commissioner is not empowered to interfere the affairs of the Mutts listed under Section 6(d) of Act 30/1987.

4. It is humbly submitted that the Executive officer dug and excavated the residues of 3 Tombs in side the Mutt and 2 tombs of disciple of Mutt in Munaga Singarayya Satram (Choultry), located in the mutt Premisses without taking consent from Gurupathni, or without taking permission from Dharmika Parishad (R 3) or informing to Revenue or Police Department and Archaeological Survey of India (ASI). Demolition of the normal Tombs is illegal and its crime under IPC Sec 295 & 297 and also disturbing any tombs which are historical or religious significance is illegal under THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES AND REMAINS ACT, 1958.
The incident i.e. Illegal Digging and excavation of the Tombs being reported to Collector Kadapa & SP Kadapa and also reported to Commissioner Endomnets & Minister Endowments. We are waiting for their action. Yesterday we came to know that the WP1070/2025 filled by Mr. Munaga Badari Narayana for illegal digging of their father & grand Fathers Tombs in Munaga Singarayya Choultry.
5. It is humbly submitted that the Executive officer, without issuing notices demolished the shops located in the Mutt premisses and asked the tenants to construct the shops. There is no provision in the Act 30/1987 for the government official to undertake such actions in the Mutt.
6. It is humbly submitted that there is no provision under the AP Act No.30/1987 for appointing any Executive Officer in respect of any Mutt. It has come to our notice vide the Proceedings Order

in Rc. No. F2/9307210/2024-2, dated 22/09/2024, very peculiarly, at Item No.2 of the table reading as follows:

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which runs totally contrary to the entire proceedings in that, all the other items themselves glaringly show that the Executive Officers (EOs) have been appointed only in respect of Temples. Moreover, the Order is prefaced with the statement that 'in the interest of public service and better administration....', the Executive Officers working in Kurnool Zone are transferred from the Institutions mentioned at Col.No.3 and posted to stations mentioned in Col.No.4 respectively.

7. It is submitted that the Mutt used to have a Matadhipathi HH Sri Veera Bhoga Vasantha Venkateswara Swamy, the 11th Matadhipathi, who is happened to be the descendant of Sree Madvirat Pothuluri Veera Brahmendra Swamy. After he reached heavenly adobe on 08.05.2021, Dharmika Parishad has appointed the AC Kadapa as Fit Person & there was dispute between the Dharmika Parishad and Petitioners for approval of the nomination of deceased Mathadhipathi. Aggrieved by the Orders of Dharmika Parishad, the Petitioners preferred W.P. 12609/2021 and the Hon'ble High Court Set aside the proceedings of Dharmika Parishad and the Division Bench

endorsed the same and liberty granted to appellants to put forth their claims before the Dharmika Parishad in W.A. 535/2021, There after 2 others sons of the deceased Mathadhipathi claimed that they are alone eligible for the office of Mathadhipathi. Instead of resolving the issue, the Dharmika Parishad has appointed the 4th Respondent i.e Assistant Commissioner, Endowments Department Kadapa as Fit Person for the subject mutt and his appointment is purely on temporary basis. As per the Proceedings of Dharmika Parishad, Proc.No.DP1.2530(31)/15/2021-3 Dt. 29.11.2021 the Appointment of the Fit Person is, only for purely on temporary basis on the alleged ground that there is nobody to collect money from Hundials and to disburse salaries and for payment of Electricity Bills and for making arrangement for provisions and Pooja Dravyams. So, in this connection, Fit Person was directed to open Hundis in the presence of Tahsildar, Inspector of Police, and Bank officials along with claimants.

8. Aggrieved by the Orders of Dharmika Parishad, the Petitioners preferred W.P. 29071/2021 and the Hon'ble High Court stayed of Proceedings of DP- DP1/25030(32)/25/2021-1. Dt 29/11/2021 and continued Proceedings of DP DP1/25030(32) /25/2021-3 Dt 29/11/2021 i.e Appointment of Fit Person for very minimal functions as stated above

9. I further humbly submit that after the then Mathadhipathi, reached heavenly adobe on 08.05.2021, Since then, as head of the family, in the capacity of Gurupatni, I have been suitably leading and conducting the practices of the Mutt & other religious day-to-day functions & looking after the religious requirements of

the disciple as practiced, trained and ordered by my late husband, moreover, I was also nominated by him for looking after interim arrangement till Mathadhipathi assumes the office.

In fact, U/Sec.13 of A.P. Act 30 of 1987, the official respondents are barred to interfere with practices, usages of the temples while I am discharging the duties as GuruPatni of the deceased Head of the Mutt till the new Mathadhipathi is recognized. Also it is supported by G.O.MS.No.223 Dt.09-10-2024 (A copy is enclosed)

Relevant part of Section 13 extracts as below

"13. Commissioner etc., to observe appropriate forms, usages and

practices - (1) The Commissioner, the Additional Commissioner, a Regional Joint Commissioner, a Deputy Commissioner, an Assistant Commissioner and every other person, exercising powers or performing the functions under this Act, shall not interfere with and shall observe the forms, usages, ceremonies and practices obtaining in and appropriate to the religious institution or endowment in respect of which such powers are exercised or functions are performed and

"in the case of a math, act in conformity with the rules, practices, usages or customs of the math in his dealings with the head of the math."

Relevant part of GO extracts as below

No Administrative authority Including the Commissioner, Regional Joint Commissioner, Deputy Commissioner or the Assistant Commissioner,

who is having Administrative control over the respective temples, shall not interfere with the Agama traditions, Customs and usages of the respective of the temples in any manner.

2. In taking decisions on all important religious matters Including the mode of performing Rituals and Sevas to the deities, Fixation of Muhurthams for performance of Yagams, Kumbabhishekams, other Festivals, for proposing introduction of new Sevas and Rituals etc., the opinion of senior most Archakas / Religious staff of the temple shall prevail over, as far as the religious aspects are concerned. For this purpose, the Executive Officers may constitute Vaidic committees with the senior most religious staff of the respective temples if necessary, in all 6(a) temples. In case any doubt arises or any difference of opinion arises among the members of such committee, then the opinion of Peethadhipathis of renowned peethams pertaining to that particular Agama can be consulted.

10. It is further submitted that the concept of 'better administration' is completely alien to and in utter violation of Articles 26 & 27 of the Constitution of India and thus, clearly a nullity, especially insofar as the Mutts are concerned. Therefore, this is a glaring and palpable illegal and unconstitutional interference into the affairs / administration of a Mutt, which is a denominational institution. Our contention is supported by various judgments of this Hon'ble high court and Hon'ble Apex court.

a. Our Contentions are supported by the Hon'ble court in WP No.17993/2013, order Dt.20.12.2024 **Sree Vyasasramam, Yerpedu, Chittoor District, vs The Commissioner, Endowment Department AP**, the Hon'ble court Held that

"this Court is inclined to allow the writ petitions while declaring the impudent proceedings in both the writ petitions as illegal and arbitrary."

"The impugned Accordingly, both the Writ Petitions are allowed, proceedings in both the writ petitions are hereby set aside, not to interfere with the affairs 18. Further, the of the directed respondents are including operations of its Bank Account. petitioner/Aashramam in any manner There shall be no order as to costs."

b. In **H.H.Jagadguru Channa Basava Mahaswamy, Matadhipathi, Sri Gavi Math Samasthanam, Uravakonda, Anantapur District vs. Commissioner of Endowments, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad and others\ 1997(1) ALT 451** wherein the High Court of Judicature, Andhra Pradesh at Hyderabad was held that;

The Endowment Commissioner by his order dated 28-12-1991 impugned in W. P. No. 2825 of 1992 appointed the Deputy Commissioner, Endowments, Kurnool to be incharge of the affairs of the Gavimath and by his order dt. 10-8-1992 impugned in W. P, No. 1496/93 permitted the third respondent herein to perform only religious and spiritual functions of the Matadhipathi. In the latter order, the Endowment Commissioner has further directed that the third respondent shall not have any right to interfere in the secular administration of the math. The effect of these two orders is to detach the personal beneficial interest of the Matadhipathi sanctioned by customs, usages and Sampradayams from that office and thereby reducing the status of the Matadhipathi to that of a poojari in a temple. The Endowment Commissioner has done this despite he

being of the tentative opinion that the third respondent validly nominated by the predecessor Matadhipathi as his Uttaradhikari and he was functioning as such on the date of demise of the predecessor Matadhipathi. A Matadhipathi has not only duties to discharge in connection with the endowment but he has a personal interest of a beneficial character which is sanctioned by custom and Sampradayam. The Supreme Court in *The Commissioner. Hindu Religious Endowments. Madras Vs. Sri Lakshmindra Thirtha Swamiar of Sri Shirur Mutt.*, observed paras 11 and 12 as under: Thus in the conception of Mahantship, as in Shebaitship, both the elements of office and property, of duties and personal interest are blended together and neither can be detached from the other. The personal or beneficial interest of the Mahant in the endowments attached to an institution is manifested in his large powers of disposal and administration and his right to create derivative tenures in respect of endowed properties; and these and other rights of a similar character invest the office of the Mahant with the character of proprietary right which, though anomalous to some extent, is still a genuine legal right. was 11 It is true that the beneficial interest which he enjoys is appurtenant to his duties and as he is in charge of a public institution, reasonable restrictions can always be placed upon his rights in the interest of the public. But the restrictions would cease to be reasonable if they are calculated to make him unfit to discharge the duties which he is called upon to discharge. A Mahant's duty is not simply to manage the temporalities of a Math. He is the head and superior of spiritual fraternity and the purpose of

Math, is to encourage and foster spiritual training by maintenance of a competent line of teachers who could impart religious instructions to disciples and followers of the Math and try to strengthen the doctrines of the particular school or order, of which they profess to be adherents. This purpose cannot be served if the restrictions are such as would bring the Matadhipathi down to the level of a servant under a State department. It is from this standpoint that the reasonableness of the restrictions should be judged."

Sections 52, 53 and 54 specifically deal with filling of temporary and permanent vacancies in the office of the Matadhipathi. The general powers of superintendence and control granted to the Endowment Commissioner u/s 8 of the Act are subject to the other provisions of the Act. In other words the power granted to the Endowment Commissioner u/s 8 are subject to the provisions of Sections 52, 53 and 54 of the Act. The provisions of Section 8 are general provisions whereas the provisions of Sections 52, 53 and 54 are special provisions. When an Act contains a general enactment relating to the whole subject matter of the statute, and also a specific and particular enactment relating to certain special matters, the general enactment should yield to the particular or specific enactment. Since Sections 52, 53 and 54 deal specifically with filling of temporary and permanent vacancies in the office of Matadhipathi, the Endowment Commissioner is required to act under those provisions only within the limitations specified in those sections and he cannot resort to the general provisions contained u/s 8 of the Act

c. Our contention also supported by the Hon'ble Division Bench of this High Court observation in **Sri Ahobila Mutt Parampara Adheena vs The State Of Andhra Pradesh** on 13 October 2022 held that; referring the observation in **H.H. Arjun Doss Mahant, Disciple of Guru Devender Dass, Sri Swamy Hathiramji Math, Tirumala, Tirupati v. Commissioner of Endowments, Endowment Department, Hyderabad and others**, the Hon'ble High Court held that;

"The State cannot claim any power or authority to take over the management of the Math by spreading religious scheme, functions of the 'Math'. It was held that only in cases of mismanagement, misconduct etc., the Court has the power to initiate action under section 51 of the Act. Both the judgment of H.H. Arjun Doss Mahant v. The Commissioner of Endowments, Endowments Department, reported in 2006 (3) ALD 22 and the judgment authored by one of us continue to be good law. No judgment of the Division Bench or of a Supreme Court was brought to our notice overruling these orders."

d. Our Contentions are also supported by this Hon'ble Court in the **Sri Raghavendra Swamy Mutt vs \$ The State Of Andhra Pradesh** on 22 September, 2021 held that;

"this Court is of the opinion on this issue that if section 8(1) and section 49 of the Act are read together, the limited powers of the Commissioner become clear. They are limited to the fixing/spending/utilization of the "dittam" only. In case of disagreement, the matter has to be referred to a Court for decision (Section 49-Proviso).

Similarly, the amendments to sections 51-53 etc., where the Commissioner has been substituted by the "Dharmika

Parishad" also makes it clear that the role of the Commissioner is very limited.

Also held that:

In the light of the above well-settled principles of law with regard to the rights of the mathadhipathis, undoubtedly the State cannot claim any power or authority to take over the management of the math by separating the religious functions and secular affairs of the math

11. It is submitted that the petitioner is happened to be the Gurupathni (wife of the deceased Matadhipathi) of the subject Mutt, the petitioner and her ancestors from time immemorial have been in the service of the subject Mutt. In the absence of the Matadhipathi, only the Gurupathni is entitled to perform gurupadeshams, and teachings to disciples of the Mutt etc religious activities. The historical Facts support the same. When the 3rd Mathadhipathi Sri. Potululuraih Swami passed away his wife Matha Parvatamma took over the affairs of the Mutt and assumed the office of the Mathadhipathi, (Enclosed the publications of the Mutt) and later Matha Picchamamba acted as Mathadhipathi after the then Mathadhipathi passed away.
12. It is submitted that earlier the Dharmika Parishad (R-3) appointed R5 as the administrative officer, in DP1/16663/2015. Dt.01.06.2016 and aggrieved by the orders the then Matadhipathi challenged the orders through WP 19503/2016 & the Hon'ble High court suspended the order.
13. It is further submitted that the Dharmika Parishad e-File mentioned at Para -8, "It is submitted that in view of the Hon'ble High Court Orders, the appointment of Departmental Officer to

the subject Mutt is not feasible. But the Commissioner have appointed the departmental person (R5) as Executive Officer.

The provisions of the Act will not provide for interference with the activities of a Math. A general power of supervision and control is not given to the State. Section 29 of Act 30/1987 talks of the appointment of an Executive Officer for temples listed under Sec 6(a), (b) and (c) endowment based upon the income of the institution. The appointment of Executive Officer for Mutt is not traceable in any of the provisions of the Act. Apart from this, Chapter V of the Act which clearly states in section 48 (of Chapter V) that the provisions of certain sections not apply to a Math or to an endowment attached thereto.

14. In the above circumstances, the petitioners have got no other alternative, efficacious remedy except to approach this Hon'ble Court by invoking the original jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.
15. The petitioners have not filed any other writ, suit or any other legal proceedings before this Hon'ble Court or any other legal forum for the relief sought for herein.

PRAYER

It is prayed that this Hon'ble court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction, more particularly on in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS or any other appropriate Writ, order or direction, declaring that appointment of Respondent No. 5 as Executive Officer to Sri Mad Virat Pothuluri Veera Bhrahmendra Swamy Mutt as reflected in the item no 2 in the proceedings Rc. No. F2/9307210/2024-2, dated 22/09/2024 is illegal and not in accordance with the Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions

and Endowments Act, 1987 read with Sri Ahobila Mutt Parampara Adheena vs The State Of Andhra Pradesh on 13 October 2022 as reported in 2022 (6) ALT 628 (DB) (AP) as the same is unlawful, arbitrary, unconstitutional, violative of principles of natural justice, violative of Doctrine of Estoppel and Doctrine of Legitimate Expectation, thereby offending the religious sentiments of the petitioners and consequently direct the Respondents and consequently set aside the appointment of Respondent No. 5 as Executive Officer to the Sri Mad Virat Pothuluri Veera Bhrahmendra Swamy Mutt and to pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice and in the circumstances of the case.

INTERIM PRAYER

In the circumstances stated above, it is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to suspend the appointment of Respondent No. 5 as Executive Officer to Sri Mad Virat Pothuluri Veera Bhrahmendra Swamy Mutt as reflected in the item no 2 in the proceedings Rc. No. F2/9307210/2024-2, dated 22/09/2024 and all further proceedings of the 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th respondents to interfere the administration of the Mutt, which also includes demolishing the tombs, chowitrees or any other structures, buildings, altering any existing structure and constructing any permanent structures and withdrawals from the Bank Accounts other than the duties empowered by Dhramika Parishad Orders in proc DP1/25030(32)/25/2021-3. Dt 29/11/2021, which is in judicial review in this Hon'ble High Court in WA1066/2024, pending disposal of the writ Appeal and until a fit person is appointed in terms of the orders of this Hon'ble Court in W.P. No. 29071 of

In the circumstances reported by the Special Commissioner of Endowments in the reference read above, Government after careful examination, hereby issue the following orders to all the Departmental authorities for compliance of Section -13(1) of the A.P.Charitable and hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act,1987 to ensuring autonomy to the temples in the matters of Valdic and Agama Issues-Preserving the sanctity of Customs and traditions of the respective temples without any disturbance.

1. No Administrative authority including the Commissioner, Regional Joint Commissioner, Deputy Commissioner or the Assistant Commissioner, who is having Administrative control over the respective temples, shall not interfere with the Agama traditions, Customs and usages of the respective of the temples in any manner.

2. In taking decisions on all important religious matters including the mode of performing Rituals and Sevas to the deities, Fixation of Muhurthams for performance of Yagams, Kumbabhishekams, other Festivals, for proposing Introduction of new Sevas and Rituals etc., the opinion of senior most Archakas / Religious staff of the temple shall prevail over, as far as the religious aspects are concerned. For this purpose, the Executive Officers may constitute Valdic committees with the senior most religious staff of the respective temples if necessary, in all 6(a) temples. In case any doubt arises or any difference of opinion arises among the members of such committee, then the opinion of Peethadhipathis of renowned peethams pertaining to that particular Agama can be consulted.

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However, for this purpose each religious institution shall be considered as a single entity. No religious institution shall be insisted to follow the customs and usage of another religious institution, even on the ground that such other institution is also belong to the same Agama.

3. For this purpose, the Executive Officers may constitute Vaidic committees with the senior most religious staff of the respective temples if necessary, in all 6(a) temples. In case any doubt arises or any difference of opinion arises among the members of such committee, then the opinion of Peethadhipathis of renowned peethams pertaining to that particular Agama can be consulted.

However, for this purpose each religious institution shall be considered as a single entity. No religious Institution shall be insisted to follow the customs and usage of another religious Institution, even on the ground that such other institution is also belong to the same Agama.

3. The Executive authorities concerned shall not interfere in the Rituals and Sevas to the deities, Fixation of Muhurthams for performance of Yagams, Kumbabhishekams, other Festivals etc except for the purpose to ensure that no deviation from the Agama traditions, Customs and Usages of that particular temple, is taken place.

It has come to our notice vide the above Proceedings, very peculiarly, at Item No.2 of the table reading as follows:

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which runs totally contrary to the entire proceedings in that, all the other items themselves glaringly show that the Executive Officers (EOs) have been appointed only in respect of Temples. There is no provision under the AP Act No.30/1987 for appointing any EO in respect of any Mutt at all. Moreover, your Order is prefaced with the statement that 'In the interest of public service and better administration....', the Executive Officers working in Kurnool Zone are transferred from the Institutions mentioned at Col.No.3 and posted to stations mentioned in Col.No.4 respectively.

- 2) The concept of 'better administration' is completely alien to and in utter violation of Articles 26 & 27 of the Constitution of India and thus, clearly a nullity, especially insofar as the Mutts are concerned.
- 3) Therefore, this is a glaring and palpable illegal and unconstitutional interference into the affairs / administration of a Mutt, which is a denominational institution.
- 4) Therefore, you are requested to withdraw the above Order, insofar as 'Sri Brahmamgarl Mutt' is concerned.

- 1) Sri Veera Bhoga Vasantha Venkateswara Swamy varu, the 11th Peetadhipathi of Sri Madvirat Pothuluri Veerabrahmendra Swamy Mutt, Kandimallayapalli (V) Brahmamangari Mutt (M) YSR Kadapa District (herein after referred as "The Mutt") expired on 8-5-2021 due to Covid. The said Mutt is published U/s.6(d) of the Act 30/1987. The Deputy Commissioner, Endowments, Kurnool has submitted a report vide Lr.No.B2/ENDOW-ADMIN/26/2021 Dt.1-6-2021 stating that his 1st wife got four sons and four daughters and 2nd wife got 2 minor sons. The eldest son, second son of the 1st wife and 1st son of the second wife of Matadhipathi are strongly agitating for succession as Matadhipathi of the Mutt.
- 2) In view of disputes between family members of deceased Matadhipathi for succession regarding "Matadhipathi" of the Mutt and in the interest of public service and for better administration, the Dharmika Parishad appointed the Assistant Commissioner, Endowments Department, Kadapa as Fit Person to the subject Mutt till a permanent Matadhipathi is appointed to the Mutt vide Rc.No.DP Cell/COE-25030(31)/15/2021 Dt.12-6-2021.
- 3) Aggrieved by the orders of appointment of Fit Person, Sri N.Govinda Swamy and Smt N.Maruthi Mahalakshmi filed W.P.No.12609/2021 and to consider nomination made by deceased Matadhipathi. The Hon'ble High

Court was pleased to allowed the said W.P. on 16.07.2021 by held that

"..... In these circumstances, the Writ Petition is allowed and the resolution of the 2nd Respondent Dharmika Parishad Dated: 12.06.2021 vide proceedings in Rc.No.DPCELL/COE-25030(31)/15/2021 is set aside, leaving it open to the Dharmika Parishad to reconsider and pass resolutions in accordance with the provisions of the Act and Rules"

4) Being aggrieved with the orders in W.P. 12609/2021, the Writ Petitioners preferred Writ Appeal in W.A.No.535/2021. The Division Bench of Hon'ble High Court was pleased to dispose of W.A.No.535/2021 on Dt.23.09.2021 by held that

".....this Court to meet the ends of justice is inclined to dispose of the appeal providing liberty to the appellants to put forth their claims before the Dharmika Parishad which in turn shall consider the same in the light of the provisions of the Act and the Rules framed there under, independently, without reference to any of the observations made by the learned Single Judge or by this Court and pass appropriate resolutions in accordance with the provisions of the Act and Rules. The Dharmika Parishad shall complete the above said exercise, after giving due opportunity to all the concerned, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order".

5) In pursuance of orders of Hon'ble High Court the Dharmika Parishad has conducted an enquiry by issue notices to all the concerned and issued proceedings rejecting the claim of the Writ Petitioners/Appellants in so far as claim U/s.54(1) of the Act. However, the Writ Petitioners/Appellants are entitled to participate along with other claimants before the meeting with the Mathadhipatis of other Mutts of same Sampradayam to be conveyed by the Authorized Officer u/s. 54 (2) of the Act for recognition of Mathadhipati. Separate proceedings are issued appointing authorized officer to conduct meeting as specified U/s.54(2) of the Act.

6) It is brought to the notice of the Dharmika Parishad that Hurdials of Mutt are filled up, there is no body to disburse salaries, there are dues

accumulated for payment of electricity, provisions, pooja dravyams, etc. The Dharmika Parishad felt that some more time will be consumed for appointment of Mathadhipati to the Mutt. To meet the above contingencies, the Dharmika Parishad felt that the appointment of Fit Person is highly essential. As such, the Assistant Commissioner, Endowments Department, YSR Kadapa District is placed as Fit Person, purely on temporary basis, for day to day management, till appointment of Mathadhipati to the Mutt.

7) The Fit Person is instructed to open the Hundlals of the Mutt in the presence of Local Tahsildar, Inspector of Police, concerned bank officials and claimants (family members of late Mathadhipati) and remit the amount in the bank account and deposit the jewellery in the bank locker of the Mutt and pay the salaries to the staff and to clear all the bills and dues pending so far. No cash transactions have to be dealt by the Fit Person. The Fit Person shall obtain prior permission from the Commissioner of Endowments, Vijayawada for withdrawals for every quarter as per budget sanction for day-to-day administration.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to allow the 2nd petitioner to discharge the duties of Mathadhipathi/Peethadhipathi of Sri Mad Virat Pothuluri Veera Bhrahmendra Swamy Mutt, Kandi Mallayapalli Village, Brahmamgari Matham Mandal, YSR Kadapa District, as per the wish of the deceased Mathadhipathi/Peethadhipathi of the said Mutt, as contained in the Will, dt.10.11.2018, executed by the deceased Mathadhipathi / Peethadhipathi, pending disposal of WP.No.29071 of 2021, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri M.Pitchaiah, Advocate for the Petitioners and GP for Endowments for the Respondent Nos.1 to 4, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

"The petitioners contend that the 1st petitioner is to be appointed as Peetadhipathi of Sri Madvirat Pothuluri Veerabrahmendra Swamy Mutt in YSR Kadapa District. The issue went up before the Dharmika Parishad for a decision as to whether the 1st petitioner is entitled to be appointed as Peetadhipathi. After an enquiry into the matter, the Dharmika Parishad by proceedings No.DPI/25030(31)/15/2021-1, dated 28.11.2021, had negatived the request of the petitioners by holding that there was no valid nomination by the late Peetadhipathi of the Mutt and initiated a process under Section 54 of the Endowments Act, 1987 for convening a meeting with the Peetadhipathis of other Mutts of same Sampradayam and disciples of the Mutt for the purposes of recognizing the person, who is to be appointed as the next Peetadhipathi. Proceedings, dated 29.11.2021, were also issued marking temporary arrangements for the management of the Mutt.

Aggrieved by the said orders, dated 28.11.2021 and 29.11.2021, the petitioners have approached this Court by way of the present writ petition.

Sri M.Pitchaiah, learned counsel for the petitioners, would submit that the manner in which the Dharmika Parishad has conducted the enquiry and the manner in which the Dharmika Parishad has arrived at a decision are arbitrary and did not follow any of the accepted principles of law. He contends that the Dharmika Parishad erred in refusing to recognize the nomination made by the late Peetadhipathi in favour of the 1st petitioner. He submits that convening of the meeting and appointment of any other persons as the Peetadhipathi, while the present writ petition is pending, would result in irreparable loss to the interest of the petitioners and would create multiplicity of proceedings.

The learned Government Pleader for Endowments submits that the Dharmika Parishad had arrived at its decision contained in the impugned proceedings of 28.11.2021 and 29.11.2021 after giving a detailed hearing to the petitioners and after considering the entire material on record. The contention of the petitioners that the late Peetadhipathi had executed a Will in favour of the 1st petitioner and that the late Peetadhipathi had also sent a nomination to the Dharmika Parishad had been considered and rejected on the basis of the material on record. She submits that there is no irregularity in the said proceedings which requires any interference by this Court.

Having heard both sides, it is necessary to keep in mind the fact that the continuation of the process of nomination of the next Peetadhipathi without disposal of the present case would effectively result in non-suiting the petitioners herein. Any person appointed as Peetadhipathi would have to defend his appointment and the same would result in multiplicity of proceedings. In the circumstances, there shall be an interim stay of convening of any meeting for.

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finalizing the name of the person, who is to be appointed as the next Peetadhipathi of this Mutt.

However, this order shall not preclude the respondents from making any necessary temporary arrangements for managing Mutt, in accordance with Section 52 of the Endowments Act.

In the circumstances, appointment of the Assistant Commissioner, Endowments Department, YSR Kadapa District as a fit person to manage the affairs of the Mutt pending appointment of the Peetadhipathi, by order, dated 29.11.2021, shall remain in force till disposal of the writ petition.

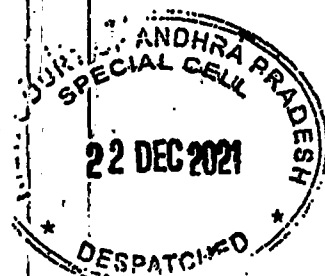

In this, in front of the south wind tower, which has various rooms related to the temple, next to the Ram temple, door numbers 12/113 and 112014, there are old dilapidated inns related to the temple in about one cent area. The management of the temple is also giving them a lease under temporary shops in front of these inns. The Deputy Executive Engineer has given a report that it is in a state of collapse. On this, the Secretary of the Y. Siddaiah, Srivasavi Veerabrahmendra Arya Valshya Nithya Annadana Sangam has filed a Writ No. 20657/ 2024 in the Honorable High Court against the inns in this place. On this, the Honorable High Court has disposed of the case and has given orders that if they are to be removed, they should act according to law and remove the said dilapidated rooms.

Currently, the Arya Valshya The community is not doing anything here. They themselves have given an affidavit in the Honorable High Court that they are using this place commercially and renting it out. Accordingly, they are not doing any kind of service activities. This is a place that is completely related to Maram and the Ram Temple. There is a risk of it collapsing for the devotees who go around the Ram Temple, so there is a possibility of an accident at any moment. Due to this, Maram and the endowment department will also face a lot of trouble. At present, this Arya Valshya Sangam is constructing Arya Valshya Annadana Satras on Telugu Ganga Road and Sri Poleramma Road and conducting Annadana activities for their community. In Nandu, Arya Valshya Annadana Satras are being constructed and conducting Annadana activities for their community. They have not arranged any facilities for the devotees who come to Maram. Currently, the management of the temple has set up a special Annaprasadam center for the devotees who have come to the temple. Therefore, as per the orders of the Honorable High Court, if you have any comments on these dilapidated rooms, you are requested to give them in writing within 7 days of the date of this notice. After that, it will be removed.
