AFFIDAVIT

affirm and sincerely state on oath as follows:

01. I submit that I am the petitioner and the deponent in the writ petition,
as such I am well acquainted with the facts of the case.
02. It is submitted that the present writ petition is filed challenging the
action of the respondents 2 and 3 in not considering the case of the

petitioner for regularization of his services in the 3rd respondent temple as bad, illegal, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14, 16 and 21 of Constitution of India.

03. It is humbly submitted that, I was appointed in the cadre of helper in the 3rd respondent institution on 20.08.2004 on consolidated pay and till date I have completed around 20 years of service without any blemish and to the utmost satisfaction of my superior authorities.
04. I submit that, I have completed Degree of Bachelor of arts in the year 2007, further I also completed the training programme at Sri Sai Venkateswara Private ITI, Kadapa in Fitter Trade in the year 2011. It is not out of place to submit that I passed competency test in module plumber under construction sector on 27.09.2008 which is conducted by National Council for Vocational Training. As such I am fully qualified and eligible to hold the post of Fitter/Helper or any equivalent post as per my qualification.
05. I submit that, while the matter stood thus in the year 2005, I along with my fellow employees have submitted a representation to the 3rd respondent Executive Officer, requesting him to regularize our services in our respective cadres. Thereafter on 24.04.2005 the 3rd respondent Executive Officer after careful examination of workload and financial viability of the institution, has submitted proposal to the 2nd respondent vide proceedings in Rc.No. A1/756/2005 for sanctioning of following posts:
- A) Fitters - 2 Posts
 - B) Pump Operators- 8 Posts
 - C) Helpers - 4 Posts
06. I submit that, thereafter the matter regarding sanction of 3 Fitter posts, 8 Pump operators and 4 Helper Posts and to regularize the services of NMRs was placed before the trust board of the subject temple in

the meeting held on 26.05.2005 by the 3rd respondent Executive Officer and the trust board in its resolution no. 60 accepted the proposal of the Executive Officer and also for addressal of the matter to the 2nd respondent.

07. I submit that, the 3rd respondent Executive Officer vice proceedings in Rc.No. A1/2579/2005 dated 27.05.2005 has addressed a detailed report to the 2nd respondent and requested him to take appropriate action as per the resolution of the trust board. But till date no positive action is taken and our services are not regularized even after lapse of around 20 years.

08. I submit that the following employees working in the 3rd respondent Devasthanam were regularized who were appointed on par with me.

09. I submit that recently the services of three NMRs are regularized on 21-6-2022 by the 2nd respondent for the reasons best known, but our services were not regularized even though we have been working for around 20 years in the 3rd respondent temple.
10. I submit that, recently the Commissioner, Endowments Department has issued blanket rejection proceedings dated 09.12.2024 rejecting the regularization of the employees all over the state who have filed WP No. 26689/2021 and batch dated 27.02.2024 without application of mind and without properly verifying the records and antecedents, the following are the grounds taken for rejection of regularization which will also be taken in our case also as such the same are replied here under.

GROUND TAKEN BY THE 2ND RESPONDENT FOR REJECTING REGULARIZATION OF TEMPLES / INSTITUTIONS EMPLOYEES AND ITS EXPLANATION:

- a) That the 1st rejection ground mentions about the applicability of G.O.Ms No. 888 dated 08.12.2000 and publication of the temple.
- b) That the 2nd rejection ground taken is that Rule 46 direct recruitment regularization procedure is not followed as prescribed under G.O.Ms. No. 888 dated 08.12.2000. In fact rule 46 prescribes for appointment on regular basis in the instant case I was appointed on consolidated pay, as there was necessity of an employee and as the work is perennial in nature, I was appointed by the institution and the

appointment is not made at my behest but made by the temple. Hence the appointment is not illegal.

- c) I further submit that continuing me for more than 10 years itself shows my necessity and now when it has come for regularization denying the same, when I have reaped for regularization on the ground of procedure etc is illegal and arbitrary. In the similar circumstances the Hon'ble Apex Court in the recent judgment in **Jaggo Vs Union of India** dated 20-12-2024 has observed as follows:-

"26. While the judgment in Uma Devi (supra) sought to curtail the practice of backdoor entries and ensure appointments adhered to constitutional principles, it is regrettable that its principles are often misinterpreted or misapplied to deny legitimate claims of long-serving employees. This judgment aimed to distinguish between "illegal" and "irregular" appointments. It categorically held that employees in irregular appointments, who were engaged in duly sanctioned posts and had served continuously for more than ten years, should be considered for regularization as a one-time measure. However, the laudable intent of the judgment is being subverted when institutions rely on its dicta to indiscriminately reject the claims of employees, even in cases where their appointments are not illegal, but merely lack adherence to procedural formalities. Government departments often cite the judgment in Uma Devi (supra) to argue that no vested right to regularization exists for temporary employees, overlooking the judgment's explicit acknowledgment of cases where regularization is appropriate. This selective application distorts the judgment's spirit and purpose,

effectively weaponizing it against employees who have rendered indispensable services over decades.

27. In light of these considerations, in our opinion, it is imperative for government departments to lead by example in providing fair and stable employment. Engaging workers on a temporary basis for extended periods, especially when their roles are integral to the organization's functioning, not only contravenes international labour standards but also exposes the organization to legal challenges and undermines employee morale. By ensuring fair employment practices, government institutions can reduce the burden of unnecessary litigation, promote job security, and uphold the principles of justice and fairness that they are meant to embody. This approach aligns with international standards and sets a positive precedent for the private sector to follow, thereby contributing to the overall betterment of labour practices in the country.

- d) That the rejection ground taken at point 3 about rule 38 prescribes the fixation of cadre strength by Commissioner. In the instant case the cadre strength is approved by the 2nd respondent and rule is followed. Hence this ground also doesn't have the footing and there is no illegality.
- e) That the rejection ground taken @ point 4, that rule 39 prescribes qualifications mentioned in annexure-III are fulfilled by me and I am fully qualified to hold the post of record assistant / plumber / attender etc.,
- f) That the rejection ground taken @ point No.5, that G.O.Ms No. 1997 dated 18.10.2005 prohibits recruitment and the same is in force is made without verifying the precedents and the Hon'ble High Court orders i.e.:-



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- i. In G.O.Rt No. 1813 dated 26.12.2009 regularizations were made in Sri Venugopala Swamy Temple Moolapeta, Nellore District relaxing G.O.Ms No. 1997 dated 18.10.2005 and the relevant rules issued in G.O.Ms No. 888 dated 08.12.2000, as such I also stand in the similar footing and once ban GO is related it cannot be applied.
- ii. That in W.P No. 8399 of 2010 dated 27.02.2018, the Hon'ble High Court has observed at para No.7 & 12 that the ground of ban imposed as per GOMs No. 1997 dated 18.10.2005 was rejected, as other regularizations were made etc., as such this ground was already rejected by the Hon'ble high Court on 27.02.2018.
- iii. Further that once the Commissioner and the Govt. has taken decision to regularize the employees and issued proceedings in Rc. No. A1/11026/55/2019 dated 21.06.2022 and Memo of the Govt. in Endw/502/2019/End-I(2) dated 02.02.2022 against ban GO, the question of again raising the ground of ban GO is impermissible as once regularization is made the ban GO does not have any legal force.
- iv. That, prior to issuance of Govt. Memo dated 02.02.2022 and Commissioner proceedings dated 26.02.2022, the claim of the applicants therein who were working in the 3rd respondent temple was rejected vide Memo No. Endw/502/2019 Endt-I(2) dated 02.07.2020 on the ground that they were not appointed through direct recruitment and there is ban and their appointment is irregular. But still the then Commissioner has forwarded a letter in Lr No. COE-11026/68/2019 dated 30.09.2021 on humanitarian grounds & keeping length of service requesting to reconsider their cases without reference to rejection Memo dated 02.07.2020. Thereafter 02.02.2022

and 21.06.2022 proceedings were issued regularizing the service of those employees and they were extended all benefits, that once regularization is done in favour of certain employees working in the same department, the Commissioner cannot differ other cases on the same grounds, otherwise the same violates to Article-14 of Constitution of India.

- v. That recently the Government has issued GOMS.No.2 dated 01-01-2025 regularizing the 10 paricharikas in Sri Durga Malleswara Swamy Varla Devasthanam, Vijayawada. They were initially appointed on daily wage basis thereafter converted to minimum time scale, subsequently they were allowed to participate in interviews and they failed in the same, filed writ petitions and later they have withdrawn the same and now their cases were considered and regularized, as such the ground of ban on regularization is bad.
- g) That, the rejection ground taken at point No. 6 of not following Rule 46 direct recruitment mode is already answered above, as such this ground is not sustainable.
- h) That, point No's. 7 & 8 mentions about the extension of minimum time scale which is matter of record and extended to the petitioner.
- i) That, coming to point No. 9 referring to Umadevi case para No. 53 mentions about Union of India, State Governments and its instrumentalities to regularize services who have completed 10 years of service and appointed through selection process, is made for the sake of the rejection, in fact para No. 53 speaks as follows:
- "53. One aspect needs to be clarified. There may be cases where irregular appointments (not illegal appointments) as explained in S.V.NARAYANAPPA (supra), R.N.NANJUNDAPPA (supra), and B.N. NAGARAJAN (supra), and referred to in paragraph 15 above, of duly qualified persons in duly sanctioned vacant posts might have been made*

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and the employees have continued to work for ten years or more but without the intervention of orders of courts or of tribunals. The question of regularization of the services of such employees may have to be considered on merits in the light of the principles settled by this Court in the cases above referred to and in the light of this judgment. In that context, the Union of India, the State Governments and their instrumentalities should take steps to regularize as a onetime measure, the services of such irregularly appointed, who have worked for ten years or more in duly sanctioned posts but not under cover of orders of courts or of tribunals and should further ensure that regular recruitments are undertaken to fill those vacant sanctioned posts that require to be filled up, in cases where temporary employees or daily wagers are being now employed. The process must be set in motion within six months from this date. We also clarify that regularization, if any already made, but not subjudice, need not be reopened based on this judgment, but there should be no further by-passing of the constitutional requirement and regularizing or making permanent, those not duly appointed as per the constitutional scheme".

- j. That, the above paragraph prescribes to regularize the services of such irregularly appointed employees who have worked for 10 years or more, but it does not mention about appointed through selection process etc., Even otherwise in the instant case the temple employees are neither the employees working under Union of India nor under the State Govt. or its instrumentalities as the salaries of the temple employees are not paid from the Govt. exchequer, but paid out of the income generated in the respective temples. Further the Hon'ble Apex Court in Jaggo judgment

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dated 20-12-2024 has clarified the above proposition of law. As such this ground is not sustainable.

FACTS ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES PAID TO THE TEMPLE EMPLOYEES FROM THEIR OWN FUNDS AND NOT FROM GOVT. EX-CHEQUER:

11. I submit that none of the temples or the institutions are established by the Government or its bodies. As such the ban imposed on regularization does not bar regularization of the temple employees, whose salaries are paid only out of the income from the temple, but not from the government exchequer.
12. I submit that the temple employees do not come under the purview of Government employees or its instrumentalities for the reason that the temple employees and their salaries are paid from out of the income of the temple which is treated as an independent autonomous single unit. The income or expenditure of temple are self-acquired, without burden on the Government.
13. I submit that the salaries are paid to the temple employees are from the donations, hundis and offerings made by the general public and not even a single pie is paid from the Government exchequer, as such the question of the denying the regularization on the ground of ban, Manjula Bashini case, Uma Devi case etc., as if the regularization is made to Government employment does not apply to the temple employees. Further the employment in the temples is religious based and unless they follow the Hinduism, they are not eligible for employment. As such employees working for years together on the fond hope of regularization cannot be denied regularization.
 - a) That the incomes generated or procured by the hard work and dedication of the secular and religious employees only, for ex. the Executive Officer or the Authorities does not go the shops for collection of the rents, to the lands for collection of makthas, maintain the Q lines, help in sale of various tickets, does the poojas and any

other works etc; which generate the income to the temple. As such the NMRs deserve the fair treatment and they deserve liable regularization of services, but the Executive Officer enjoys all perks, allowances and retirement benefits also from the income of Temple denies the regularization of its employees.

b) That the following Authorities are appointed by the Government to the various temples and charitable institutions:-

1. Commissioner of Endowments
2. Additional Commissioner's
3. Regional Joint Commissioners
4. Deputy Commissioners
5. Assistant Commissioners
6. Executive Officer Grade-I
7. Executive Officer Grade-II
8. Executive Officer Grade-III

The salaries of all the above officers including their car petrol, food allowances, medical benefits, retirement benefits, pensions, travel allowances and all applicable allowances are paid out of the income derived from the temples and charitable institutions generated by the sweat, determination and hard work of these employees as such they are eligible for regularization of services and equal treatment instead of discrimination while regularization of services.

PROVISIONS OF LAW RELATING TO THE INCOME AND EXPENDITURE AND PAYMENT OF SALARIES OF THE TEMPLES/ INSTITUTIONS

c) That as per the section 65(1) of Act 30/87 the temples/religious institutions have to pay contributions @ 9% from the annual income towards the actual expenditure incurred towards services of the above authorities. i.e., towards payment of their salaries etc. Hence the respondents and other authorities appointed by the Government are only there to render their services for the development of the temples/

- charitable institutions and for the well being of the employees who are the main pillars of these temples/ charitable institutions, but not to issue the ban orders on regularizing the employees invoking pick and choose method and placing the employees to severe hardship.
- d). That as per section 65(4) of Act 30/87 the temples/ charitable institutions even pays 1.5% of Audit Fee to the Government, as such the question of any free service rendered by the state does not arise. Hence the employees of temples/ charitable institutions have every right to claim the regularization of their services on par with others.
 - e). That as per Section 69 of the act 30/87 the Endowments Administrative Fund is established and the same is under the control of the Commissioner of Endowments. The amounts collected towards contributions and audit fee as per section 65 of Act 30/87 will be credited to this Administrative Fund. The amounts in this fund run into crores of rupees and expended by the Authorities at their whims and fancies, but coming to the regularization of employees the ban and other financial constraints are shown as reasons, which is illegal and arbitrary.
 - f). That section 69(3) of Act 30/87 provides a provision that the Commissioner shall repay the Government out of the fund for the sums paid towards salaries, allowances, pensions and other remuneration of the persons appointed by the Government for rendering services under the provision of the Act. Hence It is crystal clear that persons mentioned @ ground D are appointed by the Government and the expenditure incurred by the Government toward them is reimbursed, but coming to the case of the employees of temples/charitable institutions they are not appointed by the Government as such their salaries are not paid by the Government and they have to work hard and pay for the others regular employees salaries by starving themselves which is nothing but violation of

Article 14 and 16 of Constitution of India and discrimination. As such all the employees deserves equal treatment and they are also eligible for regularization.

- g). That the temples/charitable institutions monies are left with the above contributions but they have to further pay @ 8 % of the annual income for the Common Good Fund as per section 70 of Act 30/87. The amount so collected @ 25% has to be utilized for the salaries to the Archakas and dhoopa deepa naivedyams etc., as per Section 70(b)(i) of Act 30/87 and @ 25% for establishment of vedapatashalas etc as per 70(b)(ii) of Act 30/87. As such as per the above provisions the payment of salaries can be adjusted from the surplus amounts in the Common Good Fund also after regularizing the services of the temple employees which includes secular and not secular employees without falling on 30% establishment charges.
- h). That even as per Section 70(2) that if any amount is surplus in the Administrative Fund the same can be transferred to the Common Good Fund which make is further clear that the amounts can be utilized for the maintenance of temples/institutions and salaries of the employees. Hence if the services are regularized there will be no burden on the Temple funds.
- i). That the persons appointed by the Government as mentioned above including the respondents herein will draw the salaries at the stake of income generated by the temple/charitable intuitions employees and paid towards Contributions and Audit Fee by invoking the section 69(3) of Act 30/87 and when the regularization is sought the same is denied, which is nothing but illegal and arbitrary and violative article 14, 16 and treating the temple/charitable intuitions employees unequally and without regularizing their long service which is illegal and arbitrary.

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- j). That the temple/charitable institutions employees are never treated on par with the Government Employees and they are always treated inferiorly and as slaves in all aspects including the payment of salaries, regularization, extending the PRC, retirement benefits, pensions etc., even when their salaries are generated by themselves only and without job security.
 - k). That there are number of cases where the archakas or the other secular staff after retirement as NMRs working for more than 20 years from the temple service are begging on the streets or went down below poverty line and are unable to feed themselves. Further there is a classic case where the employee of the temple has died and the family had no monies for bereavement expenses also.
 - l). That the employees without getting up to date scales, pensionary benefits, job security, etc., but the Executive Officers etc., will get the same at the benefit of the contributions paid by the temple/ charitable institutions without burden on the Government Exchequer/Consolidated fund which is nothing but discrimination towards temple/ charitable institutions employees which is nothing but violation of Articles 14 and 21 of Constitution of India.
14. I submit that most of the regularizations are done by the temples and ratified by the respondents 1 and 2 as per their feasibility and comfort which is illegal and violation of Article 14, 16 and 21 of Constitution of India.

That, the Hon'ble Apex Court in Raman Kumar Vs Union of India (2023 Live Law), dated 03.07.2023 at paragraph No. 10 has observed as follows:

"10. We are not inclined to accept the submission on behalf of the respondents. When the Chief Commissioner of Income Tax has himself found that 65 persons were entitled to be regularized, the act of regularizing the services of only 35 employees and not regularizing

the services of other employees, including the appellants, is patently discriminatory and violative of Article 14 of the Constitution of India".

15. I submit that, as per the above judgment recent Jaggo judgment my case has to be considered and my service has to be regularized in the vacant post as per my qualifications. As I am also eligible, qualified and entitled on par with other employees.
16. I submit that recently in Sri Durga Malleswara Swamy Temple employees cases were considered and regularizations were done by the respondents 1 and 2 vide proceedings dated 2-2-2022 and 21-6-2022 and G.O.MS.No.2 dated 01-01-2025 we also stands in similar footing.

17. I submit that unless my services are regularized, I will be put to irreparable loss and injury and the same cannot be compensated by any means. Hence the present writ petition is filed.
18. It is humbly submitted that the petitioner has no other alternative and efficacious remedy except to approach this Hon'ble Court under Article 226 of constitution of India.
19. It is submitted that the petitioner has not filed any suit, application or petitions before any court of law and I have not sought for any similar relief.

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In the above mentioned circumstances, it is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ order or direction more particularly, one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the respondents 2 and 3 in not considering the case of the petitioner for regularization of services in the 3rd respondent Temple as bad, illegal, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14, 16 and 21 of Constitution of India and consequentially direct the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner and grant all consequential service and monetary benefits and to pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the circumstances of the case, in the interest Justice.

Pending disposal of the writ petition it is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased direct the 2nd respondent to consider the case of the petitioner for regularization as was done as per the proceedings of the 3rd respondent vide Rc. No. A1/1205/2019 dated 28.06.2022 relying in the 2nd respondent proceedings in Rc No. A1/11026/55/2019 dated 21.06.2022 and 1st respondent Memo No. Endw/502/2019/Endt.1(2) dated 02.02.2022 and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the circumstances of the case, in the interest of the justice.



ORDER:-

The Commissioner, Endowments Department, Hyderabad in his letter read above, has stated that Sri Venugopala Swamy Temple, Moolapet, Nellore Town is being maintained by the Anam Family since several years. The cadre strength of this temple was approved by the Commissioner, Endowments Department vide D.Dis.No.C3/3820/2002, dated 4.2.2002. Among the posts approved in the cadre strength 3 posts of Record Assistant cadre were also included. Two Record Assistants namely Sri B. Dharma Rao and Sri P. Venku Reddy were working against two Record Assistant vacancies and the 3rd Record Assistant post was vacant. Sri F. Venku Reddy was promoted from Record Assistant to Junior Assistant cadre in the vacancy of Junior Assistant. Thus, the Record Assistant post held by him and the existing Record Assistant vacancy put together have become (2) vacancies. The Managing Trustee of the subject temple considered the applications of Sri V. Giri Krishna and Sri V. Ranga Raju for appointment in the existing (2) Record Assistant vacancies and issued appointment orders through his proceedings dated 20.9.2006, appointing them as Record Assistants in the existing vacancies, in violation of ban imposed by Government vide G.O.Rt.No.1997, dated 18.10.2005 on recruitment in the institutions of Endowments Department and without following prescribed rules in force requested to ratify his action in having appointed them as Record Assistants against the existing vacancies.

2. The Commissioner, Endowments Department, Hyderabad has further stated that assessable income for the last 4 years of the subject temple already crossed Rs.60,00,000/- lakhs and the expenditure on Establishment charges already crossed statutory limitation of 30% specified under Section 57 of A.P.H.R.C. and Endowments Act. The income of the subject temple is consistently above Rs.10 lakhs from the year 2005-2006 and the Chairman and Managing Trustee is not competent to appoint anybody without obtaining prior permission of the competent authority even if the posts are vacant in approved cadre strength as per Section 35 of the Act. The request of the Chairman and Managing Trustee was once rejected by the Commissioner, Endowments Department vide his order dated 9.2.2009 and refused to ratify the action of the Chairman and Managing Trustee and also directed the Managing Trustee to terminate the services of both Record Assistants who are illegally and irregularly appointed during the ban period. The Chairman and Managing Trustee is not competent to make any appointments without obtaining prior permission of the competent authority i.e. the Commissioner, Endowments Department and in violation of G.O.Ms.No.388, Revenue [Endts.] Department, dated 8.12.2000 for making appointments. The Commissioner, Endowments Department has therefore requested the Government to pass necessary orders in the matter.

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3. As the appointments were already made by the Chairman and the Managing Trustee in the available cadre strength of the temple for administrative convenience and they are already working in the temple, Government hereby ratify the action of the Chairman and Managing Trustee of Venugopala Swamy Temple, Moolapet, Nellore in having appointed two (2) Record Assistants i.e. Sri V. Giri Krishna and Sri V. Ranga Raju, as a special case in relaxation of ban on appointments imposed in G.O.Ms.No.1997, Revenue [Endowments-I] Department dated 18.10.2005 and also the relevant rules issued in the G.C.Ms.No.888, Rev. [Endts.I] Deptt. 8.12.2000.

4. This order should not be treated as a precedent in further.

5. The Commissioner, Endowments Department, Hyderabad shall take further necessary action accordingly in the matter.

 - b. The above appointments are prohibited by the Act 2/1994, as no prior permission of the competent authority was obtained.
 - c. The raising of salary & extending MTS to such employees who are appointed without following the due process is thus irregular.
2. The Special Commissioner of Endowments is therefore advised to approach the AoR for filing stay/quash orders in CC 1102/2017. The concerned officer of the Commissionerate can approach the Finance Department along with the case material for clarification/assistance in this matter for filing an appeal in Supreme Court. Matter needs the urgent attention of the CED.

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Devasthanam, Indrakeeladi, Vijayawada filed W.P.No.6876/2010 with a prayer to regularize the services and for consideration of their services on par with other N.M.M.s.

The Hon'ble High Court was pleased to pass orders in W.P.No.6876 of 2010 on 13.11.2014 that

"Under these circumstances, the respondents are directed to regularize the services of petitioners, subject to their eligibility and in terms of G.O.Ms.No.212, Fin & Plg. Dated 22.04.1994 within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of order."

Later, the applicants filed W.P.No.18568/2015 for regularization without giving weight to G.O.Ms.No.212, Fin.& Plg., dated 22.04.1994 on par with other employees in the light of representation dated 7.01.2015 and 29.01.2015. The Hon'ble Court was pleased to dispose of the said writ petition on 20.07.2015 as follows:

"directing respondents 2 and 3 to reconsider the representations dated 7.01.2015 and 27.02.2015 made by the petitioner for regularization of the petitioners, notwithstanding the fact that they have not completed 5 years of service on or before 25.11.1993 as required under G.O.Ms.No.212, dated 22.04.1994 and pass appropriate orders thereon, within a period 8 weeks."

The Hon'ble High Court has suo-moto registered C.C.No.1102/2017 and disposed of by sentencing the respondents to pay fine of Rs.2,000/- each. Aggrieved by the said orders, the responders therein have preferred separate Contempt Appeals and obtain interim stay on sentence order passed by Hon'ble Single Judge of High Court in C.C.No.1102/2017. The said Contempt Appeals are pending.

Later, the applicants again filed W.P.No.2602/2019. The Hon'ble High Court was pleased to pass interim order in I.A.No.1/2019 in W.P.No.2602/2019 on 18.03.2019 as follows:

"Since the representation dated 31.01.2019 filed by the petitioners is pending consideration before respondent No.2 (commissioner of Endowments), respondent No.2 is directed to consider the same and pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible, preferable within a period of 8 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of the order".

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In this connection, it is submitted that, the applicants are seeking for extension of Time Scale of pay with usual allowances attached to the respective posts. On considering their long service on consolidated pay having required qualifications and in existing approved cadre strength, in the subject Devasthanam.

A detailed report was submitted to the Government in the reference 4th cited. Thereon, the Government vide reference 5th cited has sought for certain information in the matter. This office has submitted the said information to the Government vide reference 8th cited after secure the said information from Executive Officer of the Devasthanam vide reference 7th cited.

Subsequently, this office received Government Memo vide reference 9th cited by observe that

a) The appointment of three individuals namely A.K.D. Siva Kumar, Junior Assistant, 2) V.Praneeth Babu, Junior Assistant and 3) M.Jaya Prakash, Sanitary Inspector is ab-initio irregular, since their recruitment was made without issuance of any public notification and this lacks fairness and transparency.

b) The above appointments are prohibited by the Act, 2 of 1994 as no prior permission of the competent authority was obtained.

c) Raising of salary and conducting MTS to such employees, who are appointed without following the due process is thus irregular.

Thereafter, no action has been taken on the Government Memo Dt.02.07.2020. Though the record pertaining to the regularization of services of other employees are called for from the Executive Officer of the Devasthanam, those details are not received.

In meanwhile, this office has called for certain information point wise from the Executive Officer of the Devasthanam vide reference 12th cited. The Executive Officer of the Devasthanam has submitted report vide reference 13th cited to this office stating that, at present, 59 N.M.R.s

are working in administration wing and 16 N.M.R.s are working in religious side in the Devasthanam with the permission of Commissioner of Endowments and that (7) N.M.R.s are working in religious side without permission of Commissioner of Endowments and that at present the establishment charges @ 27.19% for the year 2020-21. If all N.M.R.s (82) are regularized with PRC 2015 with all allowances, the percentage of establishment charges will come to 28.21%.

Therefore, in view of the report of the Executive Officer, Sri Durga Malleswara Swamyvara Devasthanam, Indrakeeladri, Vijayawada Dt.13.05.2021, Government may be pleased to examine the issue in the matter for consideration of representation of the Writ Petitioners so as to comply with the orders of Hon'ble High Court by reconsider earlier Government Memo in the reference 9th cited and issue necessary orders to this office to proceed further in the matter.

A copy of the reference 13th cited is herewith enclosed for favour of kind perusal.

It is to submit that there are 59 NMRs working in this Devasthanam and their services have been utilising in various places. The Commissioner, Endowments Department has fixed their remuneration in Rc No.A1/47262/2012 Dt.07-01-2013 and later their remuneration has been enhanced by Rs.100/- per day as per the note orders of the then Executive Officer by virtue of powers conferred on her in G.O.Ms.No.815, Revenue (Endts.) Dept., dt.01-08-2016.

Recently, as per the orders of the Government in the reference 1st cited and subsequent orders of the Commissioner, Endowments Department vide reference 2nd cited, devasthanam has extended minimum basic pay of Last Grade Service i.e. Rs.13,000/- per month to the NMRs working in this devasthanam w.e.f 01-08-2018.

Later certain NMRs have represented the Government through the Commissioner, Endowments Department for payment of minimum pay attached to the duties they are rendering as per the Supreme Court observation of "equal pay for equal work". The Government vide reference 3rd cited was pleased to pass orders for extending the minimum time scale of pay to the NMRs/contract employees working in higher cadres other than last grade service in Endowment Institutions subject to certain conditions such as

- i) The NMRs are performing duties assigning to regular employees of similar cadre

- ii) The NMRs possess the requisite qualifications for the respective posts as claimed in the temple;
- iii) Whether permission orders from the competent authority to engage the services of such employees.

As per the instructions of the Government and subsequent orders of the Commissioner of Endowments received in the references 2nd and 4th cited, the NMRs working in the Devasthanam are sanctioned minimum pay of Junior Assistant to all Degree and Intermediate qualified persons (as per G.O.Ms.No.222, minimum qualification for Junior Assistant is Intermediate only) and Record Assistant Pay to 10th class passed persons and Last Grade Pay i.e. Rs.13000/- were given to persons who are possessing below 10th class.
