I humbly submit that I have already filed S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 and my deceased paternal uncle has already executed a Registered Will by bequeathing all his properties including the death benefits, further he has entered my name as nominee in the service register. In such circumstances the Respondents should have provide job to me under compassionate appointment along with death benefits of my deceased paternal uncle Pamarthi Basava Sankar. The 3rd respondents being the proper authority, without looking into the documents, he is not responding on my request. In fact, I have been visiting the offices of Respondent's nos. 2 and 3 continuously, but there is not response from their end. The said inaction on the part of Respondents is nothing but violation of Article 19, 21 & 300-A of the Constitution of India. I state that the Respondents being come under the definition of 'State' as defined under Article 12 of the Constitution of India, they cannot usurp my rights. The 3rd Respondent without any application of mind and considering my explanation, simply issued a letter 09-08-2023 to produce the Legal Heir Certificate. In said circumstances, I constrain to file the present Writ Petition questioning the action of Respondents and to issue necessary directions and for appropriate reliefs. Hence, this Writ Petition.

11. I humbly submit that I have no other alternative remedy than to approach this Hon'ble Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. I state that I have not filed any Writ or Suit or other proceedings seeking the same relief now sought in this Writ Petition before any other forum.

Therefore, for the reasons stated above I humbly pray that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to consider the case of the Petitioner by providing employment under compassionate grounds, thereby by not consider the candidature of 4th Respondent pending disposal of Writ Petition and pass such other order or orders in the circumstances of the case in the interest of Justice.

Therefore, for the reasons stated above I humbly pray that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action, things and deeds of Respondents in not providing job under compassionate appointment for the death of Pamarthi Basava Shankar who worked as sweeper in 3rd Respondent Temple, further not paying the death and other service benefits of late Pamarthi Basava Shankar which is illegal, irregular, arbitrary, against to the Principles of Natural Justice, contra to the provisions of A.P. Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987 and Rules and inviolation of Articles 14, 19, 21 & 300-A of Constitution of India, consequently direct the Respondents to provide employment to the Petitioner under compassionate appointment for the death of Pamarthi Basava Shankar further direct to pay all death and other service and monitory benefits to the Petitioner payable to the deceased Pamarthi Basava Shankar and pass such other order or orders in the circumstances of the case in the interest of Justice.

4. It is submitted that during the lifetime the said Pamarthi Basava Sankar on account of his avocation used to reside at Krishnalanka and possessed of immovable properties at Kapileswarapuram. The petitioner was very much affectionate towards Pamarthi Basava Sankar. 5. It is submitted that the said Pamarthi Basava Sankar, during his life time executed a Will dated 05-09-2018, which was registered as document No.300/2018, in a sound and disposing state of mind.

7 bequeathing immovable property consisting of 265 sq.yards and also bequeathed the death benefits entitled from the 2nd respondent and also nominated him for his compassionate appointment in the service of 2nd respondent. The said Pamarthi Basava Sankar, died testate on 01-06-2023. Thus, the registered Will executed by Pamarthi Basava Sankar, came into force.

6. The petitioner conducted all the obsequies of Pamarthi Basava Sankar. Thereafter applied for retirement benefits and for compassionate appointment of petitioner in view of bequest in the registered Will. To the utter surprise of the petitioner, he received a letter dated 09-08-2023 from the office of Joint commissioner that the 1st respondent made a similar representation claiming herself is the daughter of late Pamarthi Basava Sankar for retirement benefits as such informed to obtain legal heir certificate for further action. Hence, the present application is filed.

7. It is not out of place to submit that the 1st respondent also got issued a notice dated 12-09-2023, claiming herself as daughter of late Pamarthi Basava Sankar for surrendering vacant possession of immovable property gifted to the son of the petitioner under the above referred registered settlement deed. For which the petitioner got issued a reply dated 04-10-2023, with all true and correct facts. Thereafter the petitioner received proceedings before the Honourable Mandal Legal Services Authority, at Gannavaram, vide P.L.C. No. 14 of 2023. The contentions that are being raised by the 1st respondent in the said proceedings are not only false but also spurious to the knowledge of the 1st respondent.

Infact, late Pamarthi Basava Sankar, never married to the mother of the 1st respondent at any point of time and the 1st respondent is not at all the daughter of late Pamarthi Basava Sankar. Inview of false contentions raised before the 2nd respondent the 1st respondent is also added as a party to the proceedings. It is not out of place to submit that inview of acquaintance with the 1st respondent, after demise of Pamarthi Basava Sankar, on 09-06-2023, the petitioner has arranged amount of Rs.5,18,100/- as she was under pressure of creditors and for her domestic expenses with an understanding to repay the same together with interest at 24% p.a. The material averments in the petition are not true and the same are not tenable under law.

2. The petition has to be dismissed in limini as the petitioner is not the legal heir of Pamarthi Basava Sankar as per the averments in the petition itself, to claim the petition schedule amount as the legal heir of the deceased Basava Sankar by filing this petition under Succession Act. If any will is there in respect of the schedule amount in favour of the petitioner herein he has to seek his remedy by filing a declaratory suit basing on the said will.

3. The averments in para No:3 of the petition to the effect that Nukarathanam is the wife of deceased Basava Sankar is not true and correct. Similarly the averments in para No:4, 5 and 6 of the petition that Basava Sankar used to show much affection towards the petitioner and in view of the same he had executed a gift deed on 4.2.2022 in favour of the son of the petitioner in respect of his house at Kapileswarapuram and executed a will on 5.9.2018 bequeathing a house site and death benefits to the

petitioner and he died on 1.6.2023 and the petitioner conducted the obsequies of Basava Sankar and this respondent is not the daughter of Basava Sankar as he never married her mother and as such the petitioner is entitled to get the schedule amount are not true and correct.

4. In fact this respondent is the only issue of Pamarthi Basava Sankar and his wife Venkata Ramana. The father of this respondent Basava sankar used to worked as Sweeper in Sri Durga Malleswari Temple, Indrakiladri, Vijayawada, who died intestate on 1.6.2023 leaving behind him this respondent herein as his sole surviving legal representative as his wife Venkata Ramana pre-deceased him on 29.3.2004.

5. During the life time of Basava Sankar he used to reside in Kapaileswarapuram in the house that was constructed by him in the site that was given by his parents. On 13.3.2011 the marriage of this respondent was performed by her father who joined her husband at Allapuram, Gannavaram Mandal. Because of loneliness Basava Sankar addicted to drinking and his health was spoiled. As such as this respondent is his only issue, Basava Sankar since 2014 he also started living with this respondent at Allapuram by attending his duty from Allapuram itself. Five Days prior to his death Basava Sankar fell sick and he was admitted by this respondent in Pinnamaneni Siddharatha Medical college, Chinnautapalli and he lost his last breath there itself. It is this respondent who completed the funeral obsequies of her father and the expenses were given by the respondent No:2 towards the funeral expenses by depositing the amounts in the account of

this respondent on 26.6.2023 in Union Bank of India, Roy Nagar, Gannavaram.

6. After the death of her father this respondent approached the respondent No:2 seeking appointment of Job by submitting a letter dated 6.7.2023 requesting her appointment as sweeper in the place of her father as she is the legal heir to him and also to sanction death benefits of her father by submitting all the material papers. But the respondent No:2 disclosed the Petitioner also approached them claiming himself as the legal heir of her father then only this respondent came to know about the false claims raised by the petitioner by creating fictitious documents with the forged signatures of her father. In fact the father of the respondent never executed the alleged will dated 5.9.2018 and gift deed dated 4.2.2022 which are nothing but the manipulations of the petitioner to knock away the assets of Basava Sankar taking advantage of the absence of this respondent in that village. This respondent already started her legal process challenging the said gift deed by giving legal notice dated 12.9.2023 to the petitioner as the sole legal heir of her father Basava Sankar. This respondent got filed PLC No.14/2023, before the Hon'ble MLS Gannavaram, by producing all her evidence, in which the petitioner also appeared. Having knowledge about the relationship of this respondent, the petitioner approached the Hon'ble court by suppressing the material facts which is nothing but misleading the Hon'ble court. On the other hand the petitioner is trying to divert the issue stating that out of acquaintance he paid an amount of Rs.5,18,100/- to this respondent and to avoid the said payment

only this respondent is claiming herself as the daughter of Basava Sankar. In fact, the said amount is the FD amount laid by Basava Sankar by showing the petitioner as nominee only, who had withdrawn the same and given it this respondent as she is the daughter of Basava Sankar. For that reason only no receipt was obtained by the petitioner from this respondent as such the question of this respondent raising false claims to avoid the repayment to the petitioner will not arise, which is nothing but the creation of the petitioner to get cause of action.

7. From the above discussed facts it is clear that this respondent is the only legal heir of Basava Sankar which is a known fact to all and the petitioner will not be the legal heir of Basava Sankar and as such the petitioner has no locus standi to file this petition and this Hon'ble court is not the proper venue to him to seek his redress.

8. Finally the rights if any accrued in favour of the petitioner basing on the alleged forged will have to be decided by competent court of law having proper jurisdiction then only the question of allotment of bequest will come into play. As such here a serious question of genuinity of the alleged will, gift deed etc are the points to be decided at 1st instance for which this petition is not the recourse open to the petitioner.

Hence this respondent prays the Hon'ble court to dismiss the petition with costs.

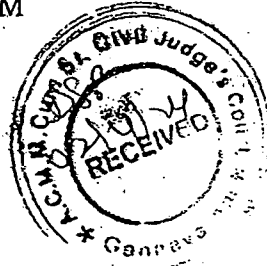

The father of the plaintiff Basava sankar used to worked as Sweeper in Sri Durga Malleswari Temple, Indrakiladri, Vijayawada, who died intestate on 1.6.2023 leaving behind him the plaintiff herein as his sole surviving legal representative to succeed his estate as his wife Venkata Ramana pre deceased him on 29.3.2004.

4. The Vacant site of an extent of 160 sq.yards in R.S.No:366/6 and house site of an extent of 105 sq.yards in R.S.No:366/6 of Kapileswarapuram are the properties acquired by the father of the plaintiff through his father

Pamarthi Reddaiah. In the said 105 sq.yards site during his life time Basava Sankar constructed a residential building with Ground and 1st floor and used to reside therein as an absolute owner. The vacant site is shown as item No:1 and the site with building is shown as item No:2 in the plaint "A" schedule and the same is herein after referred to as Plaint "A" schedule properties.

5. On 13.3.2011 the marriage of the plaintiff was performed by his father who joined her husband at Allapuram, Gannavaram Mandal. Because of loneliness Basava Sankar addicted to drinking and his health was spoiled. As such as the plaintiff is his only issue, Basava Sankar since 2014 he also started living with the plaintiff at Allapuram by spending his time with his grand children i.e.; the daughters of the plaintiff by attending his duty from Allapuram itself. 6. After the death of her father the plaintiff approached The EO, S.D.M.S.Devasthanam, Indrakiladri seeking appointment of Job by submitting a letter dated 6.7.2023 requesting her appointment as sweeper in the place of her father as she is the only legal heir to him and also to sanction death benefits of her father which is an amount of Rs. 13,50,000/- (Group Gratuity is Rs.10,00,000/- and earn leaves is Rs.3,50,000/-) by submitting all the material papers. The said amount particulars are shown in the Plaint "B" schedule and the same is here in after referred to as the Plaint B schedule. But the EO of Devasthanam asked the plaintiff to submit legal heir certificate as per their procedure as the defendant herein also approached them for the same purpose. Then the plaintiff approached the defendant who is the son of her senior paternal uncle and questioned his acts of applying for the job of her father, the defendant disclosed that he was

armed with a gift deed as if executed by the father of the plaintiff in favour of his minor son P.J.satwik, in respect of the plaint A schedule properties and as Basava sankar had no male issues he applied for the job also. At that juncture on enquires the plaintiff came to know that during the life time of her father Basava Sankar who used to stay with plaintiff frequently by leaving the house ,this defendant requested him to permit him to reside in the ground floor of the item No:2 of the plaint A schedule stating that he will look after the house in the absence of the Plaintiff's father while he was with the plaintiff ,with a promise that he will vacate the ground floor as and when demanded by Basava Sankar. Believing his representations Basava sankar permitted the defendant to stay in the said ground floor. In that manner the defendant entered into the said ground floor about 7 years back and gradually made Basava Sankar to Habituate to drinking. Basing on the said situations and the deliberations of the defendant, the plaintiff by coming to the conclusion that taking advantage of the innocence and loneliness of her father the defendant brought in to existence the above said gift deed by manipulating the things with the forged signature of her father to knock away the assets of late Basava sankar, having knowledge about the legitimate rights of the plaintiff and thus to deprive the plaintiff from enjoying her right in the plaint A schedule properties as the sole surviving heir of her father. As the subject matter of the said gift deed No 533/2022 i.e.; the plaint A schedule properties is the property of her grand father the plaintiff is entitled to have the same without any objection from anybody and as such the said gift deed is null and void as Basava sankar has no manner of right to execute the same in which the plaintiff is entitled to a share by birth and full rights after the demise of her father as such the same is nothing but the manipulation of the defendant. As such the plaintiff got issued a legal notice on 12.9.2023 through her advocate calling upon the defendant to vacate her house which was received by the defendant who got issued a reply on 4.10.2023 with false contentions ,which have to be proved by him alone. As the plaintiff is the only issue of her father Basava sankar the LIC amount and the postal deposits were also allotted to her which is also within the knowledge of the defendant. As such the plaintiff filed PLC

No.14/2023, before the Hon'ble Mandal legal Services Authority, Gannavaram, which was closed on 16.3.2024, as the defendant filed his counter with false contents and stating that he filed SOP.No.47/2023, on the file of Hon'ble Prn. SCJ's court, Vijayawada, which is not maintainable under Succession Act. in which this plaintiff got her answer filed stating that the remedy available to the defendant is otherwise but not for succession certificate as his claim was based on a forged will.

7. From the above said stage of things the plaintiff has no other go than to conclude that the defendant is a man with easy virtues and to gain wrongfully he will do any undo things of attributing falsities to others by denying the paternity relations which is clearly establishing the attitude of the defendant which has to be curtailed.

8. 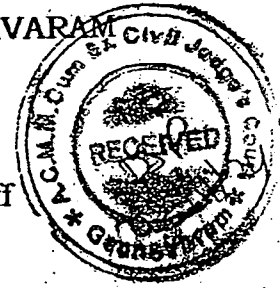

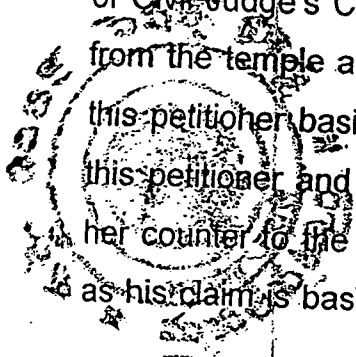

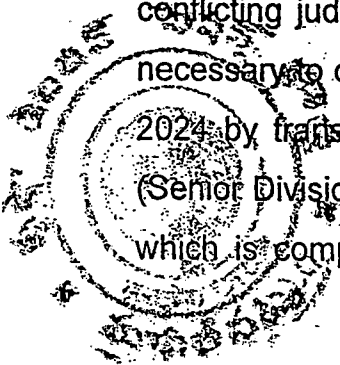

Later, the petitioner has been to the office of the Sri Durga Malleswara Swamyvari Temple, Indrakiladri, Vijayawada by submitting a letter on 06.07.2023 seeking her appointment in the place of her father and for death benefits. Then, she came to know that the respondent i.e. this petitioner's senior paternal father's son also approached the Temple authorities for the same purpose and asked her to get legal heir certificate. Then this petitioner filed a petition before the Mandal Legal Services Committee, Gannavaram, and they called the respondent but the matter was not settled. Meanwhile, the respondent filed S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 on the file of Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Vijayawada for Rs.13,50,000/- from the temple authorities which is the death benefits of the father of this petitioner basing on a Will alleged to be executed by the father of this petitioner and in said S.O.P.No.47 of 2023, this petitioner got filed her counter to the effect that SOP is not the remedy to the respondent as his claim is basing on the Will, for which he has to file a declaratory

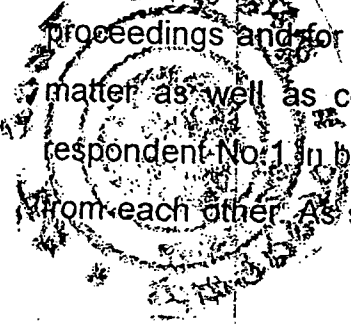
suit. The said matter is posted to 20.06.2024 for cross-examination of P.W.1, in which the material documents including the letters alleged to be submitted by the father of the petitioner to the Temple office were also filed for marking purpose. This petitioner was shocked by observing the same which are not seen the light of day till today and moreover if the same are in existence the same will be within the custody of the temple authorities only. In fact, the temple authorities, who was shown as the respondent No.2 remained exparte in said SOP and it is a question how the official record of the temple came to the hands of the respondent herein. Basing on the above said stage of things, this petitioner is suspecting the bonafides of the Temple authorities, who are supporting the respondent herein for the reasons better known to themselves. On the other hand, this petitioner, who is challenging the fictitious gift deed and the Will in respect of the properties of her father brought into existence by the respondent herein for the purpose of knocking away the same from the reach of this petitioner who is the legitimate legal heir to enjoy the properties of her father, got filed a comprehensive suit filed in O.S.No.44 of 2024 on the file of Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Gannavaram against the respondents herein in which the respondents already received summons. From the above discussed stage of things, a serious question of fact i.e. the existence of legal heir to the deceased Pamarthi Basava Sankar has to be determined by the Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Gannavaram in O.S.No.44 of 2024, then only the allotment of his job and death benefits have to be decided. Because of the filing of SOP, which is coming for cross-examination of P.W.1, there is chance of conflicting judgement in the matter in issue and as such it is just and necessary to conduct trial in both SOP No.47 of 2023 and O.S.No.44 of 2024 by transferring the said SOP to the learned Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Gannavaram, in which comprehensive suit is pending which is competent to decide the entire litigation at a glance and to

conduct trial in both the cases simultaneously and no prejudice is going to be caused to the respondent No.1, who is also seeking the same remedy. Hence, the petitioner pray the Court to withdraw the suit in S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 from the file of Principal Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Vijayawada and transfer the same to the file of Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Vijayawada to try simultaneously with the suit in O.S.No.44 of 2024."

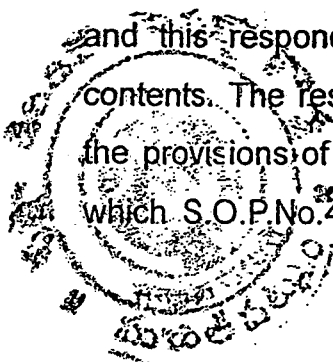
3. The respondent No.1 filed counter denying the contents of the transfer petition filed by the petitioner. The contents of counter filed by the respondent No.1, in brief, are as follows: "the nature of the proceedings in S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 on the file of Principal Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Vijayawada are quite contrary to the proceedings in O.S.No.44 of 2024 on the file of Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Gannavaram. There are absolutely no justifiable ground muchless tenable grounds urged by the petitioner for clubbing the proceedings. The reasons assigned by the petitioner are quite unsustainable. In case the matters are tried separately it will not result in conflict of decisions since the scope of the S.O.P., and Original Suit are different; moreover, in view of Section 387 of the Indian Succession Act, the petitioner has no manner of right to seek transfer the Succession O.P., from the file of Principal Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Vijayawada to the file of Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Gannavaram as the S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 is part heard and the suit in O.S.No.44 of 2024 on the file of Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Gannavaram is at the stage of filing of written statement on behalf of this respondent as such the contention of the petitioner for clubbing the proceedings and for joint trial is impermissible under law. The subject matter as well as contentions of both the petitioner as well as this respondent No.1 in both the proceedings are quite different and distinct from each other. As such the apprehension of the petitioner of getting

conflicting decisions do not arise and the petition is liable to be dismissed. Hence, pray the Court to dismiss the petition."

4. The respondent No.2 filed counter denying the contents of the transfer petition filed by the petitioner. The contents of counter filed by the respondent No.2, in brief, are as follows: "the Succession O.P. No.47 of 2023 is of a summary proceedings case and more particularly there was a special objection taken by the respondent No.2 in the suit, that the suit for declaration filed by the petitioner is hit by law and the suit in O.S.No.44 of 2024 filed by the petitioner claiming for the assets of the deceased and that this respondent is not a party in the suit in O.S.No.44 of 2024 on the file of Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Gannavaram, the nature of the suit and the relief claimed in both the cases, are not one and the same and also the disputes so also reliefs are also not one and the same and any orders passed will not infringe either by the petitioner or to the respondents. There is no common cause of action in both the cases and there is no common evidence in both the cases and there is no chance to conflict decisions in both the cases and one suit is relating to properties basing on the gift deed and the S.O.P. is claiming for the death benefits of the deceased. There is no common point involved in both the cases. The transfer O.P. is hit by law and there is no specific reason why the transfer has to be affected and in case if both the cases independently disposed off, what is the loss sustained to the petitioner, has not been explained and also it is an admitted fact that Chinnavutapalli Medical College Hospital, where the deceased died and claiming that the petitioner is the daughter. Whether the petitioner is a daughter or not has nothing to do with the respondent and this respondent has nothing to do with the gift deed and its contents. The respondent is only disbursing the death benefits as per the provisions of the Act or else as per the directions of the Court for which S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 filed on the file of Principal Civil Judge's

Court (Senior Division), Vijayawada claiming Rs.13,50,000/- and the suit in O.S.No.44 of 2024 is based on the gift deed in respect of the estate of the deceased and also claimed for cancellation of the gift deed and as such this transfer O.P., is hit by law and is liable to be dismissed. Hence, pray the Court to dismiss the petition."

5. I have heard the submissions of learned counsels for petitioner and respondents and perused the entire material available on record.

6. Now the points that arise for determination in this original petition are as follows:-

1. Whether the petitioner has made out valid and sufficient grounds to withdraw the suit in S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 from the file of Principal Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Vijayawada and transfer the same to the file of Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Gannavaram to try along with O.S.No.44 of 2024?

2. To what relief?

7. POINT No.1:-

(a) The contention of petitioner is that "she is the daughter of Pamarthi Basava Sankar, who used to work at Sweeper in Sri Durga Malleswara Swamyvari Temple, Indrakiladri, Vijayawada and he died intestate on 01.06.2023 leaving behind this petitioner as his sole legal heir as his wife Venkata Ramana pre-deceased him on 29.03.2004. Later, the petitioner has been to the office of the Sri Durga Malleswara Swamyvari Temple, Indrakiladri, Vijayawada by submitting a letter on 06.07.2023 seeking her appointment in the place of her father and for death benefits. Then, she came to know that the respondent i.e. this petitioner's senior paternal father's son also approached the Temple authorities for the same purpose and asked her to get legal heir certificate. Then this petitioner filed a petition before the Mandal Legal

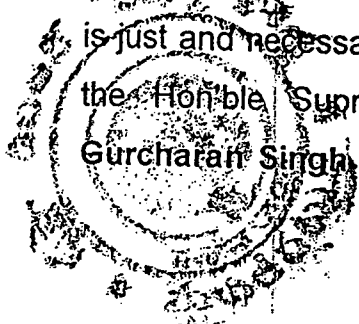
Services Committee, Gannavaram, they called the respondent but the matter was not settled. Meanwhile, the respondent filed S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 on the file of Principal Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Vijayawada for Rs.13,50,000/- from the temple authorities which is the death benefits of the father of this petitioner basing on a Will alleged to be executed by the father of this petitioner, in which this petitioner has got filed her counter to the effect that SOP is not the remedy to the respondent as his claim is basing on the Will, for which he has to file a declaratory suit. The suit in O.S.No.44 of 2024 filed by the petitioner herein is a comprehensive suit and hence the S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 pending on the file of Principal Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Vijayawada which is competent to decide the entire litigation at a glance and to conduct trial simultaneously and hence pray the Court to allow the petition." Per contra, it is the contention of the respondent No.1 that "the S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 is a part heard matter and the suit in O.S.No.44 of 2024 is at the stage of filing of written statement as such the clubbing the proceedings and for joint trial is impermissible under law and the contentions of both parties are quite different and distinct from each other and hence pray the Court to dismiss the petition." On the other hand, the contention of the respondent No.2 is that "the S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 pending on the file of Principal Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Vijayawada is of summary proceedings case and suit filed by the respondent No.2 is filed by the petitioner claiming for the assets of the deceased and that the respondent No.2 is not a party in suit in O.S.No.44 of 2024 filed by the petitioner herein and hence pray the Court to dismiss the petition."

(b) I have given a detailed and thoughtful consideration to the above pleadings. As can be seen from the contentions and rival contentions of both parties, the certified copies of the petition as well as the plaint filed by the petitioner herein, i.e. S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 on the file of Principal

Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Vijayawada and O.S.No.44 of 2024 on the file of Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Gannavaram, it discloses that the respondent No.1 has filed S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 against petitioner herein and respondent No.2 herein for grant of succession certificate in favour of the respondent No.1 herein for petition schedule amount, and for costs. A perusal of the suit in O.S.No.44 of 2024 on the file of Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Gannavaram, would discloses that the petitioner herein as plaintiff sought for (a) to declare the plaintiff is the only legal heir of her father late Pamarthi Basava Sankar, (b) For a declaration that the plaintiff as the legal heir of the deceased Pamarthi Basava Sankar is entitled to the plaint B schedule amount of Rs.13,50,000/-, (c) for a declaration that the registered Gift Deed vide document No.533/2022, dt.04.02.2022 in respect of plaint 'A' schedule properties which was executed by Pamarthi Basava Sankar in favour of minor son of the defendant by name Pamarthi Jishnu Satwik is null and void and the same is not binding on the plaintiff; (d) For cancellation of Gift Deed vide document No.533/2022, dt.04.02.2022 on the file of SRO, Vuyyuru and send a copy of its decree to the SRO, Vuyyuru to endorse the cancellation in his book; and (e) for costs. Admittedly, the property involved in S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 is part and parcel of the schedule property involved in O.S.No.44 of 2024.

(c) Indisputably, the Court has got discretionary powers under Section 24 of CPC and it has to be seen whether the parties have proved their bonafide contention that there would be irreparable loss if a suit is not transferred from one court to another court. In this context, it is just and necessary to refer the constitutional Judgment laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Kulwinder Kaur @ Kulwinder Gurcharan Singh v. Kandi Friends Education Trust 2008 (3) SCC

659, wherein the Hon'ble Apex Court at para No.23, set certain guidelines to consider a transfer application under Section 24 of CPC, which is as under:

- (i) Balance of convenience or inconvenience to the plaintiff or the defendant or witnesses;
- (ii) Convenience or Inconvenience of a particular place of trial having regard to the nature of evidence on the points involved in the suit;
- (iii) Issues raised by the parties;
- (iv) Reasonable apprehension in the mind of the litigant that he might not get justice in the court in which the suit is pending;
- (v) Important questions of law involved or a considerable section of public interested in the litigation;
- (vi) Interest of justice demanding for transfer of case etc.

A fair reading of the above decision rendered by the Hon'ble Apex Court, it can be gleaned that while adjudicating the petition under Section 24 of CPC, the Court has to consider whether there is balance of convenience and inconvenience of parties, whether the issues raised by one party are similar with that of the contention raised by other side party in another suit. In the transfer petition on hand, the contention raised by the petitioner is that she is the only daughter of her father and the respondent No.1 with an evil intention claiming death benefits pertaining to her father Late Parmathi Basava Sankar, who died testate on 01.06.2023 without having any manner of right. The suit in CO S.No.44 of 2024 on the file of Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Gannavaram is a comprehensive suit and the petitioner herein is claiming her right over the Item No.3 of the schedule property involved

in O.S.No.44 of 2024 which is a subject matter of the S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 filed by the respondent No.1 herein. If both the cases are tried separately in the respective courts, there is every chance of multiplicity of litigations, and on that, both parties will suffer from the said decrees. Therefore, both the matters can be tried simultaneously by one Court so as to save the precious time of the Courts and to avoid multiplicity of proceedings. Therefore, it is the considered view of this court that since the property in one petition is part and parcel of the property of another suit, if both the matters are not tried by one court, there is every possibility of multiplicity of litigation. If the suit in S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 on the file of Principal Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Vijayawada is transferred to the file of Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division) Gannavaram, to try simultaneously along with O.S.No.44 of 2024, no prejudice is going to be caused to the respondents. Under these facts and circumstances of the case, I have not seen any infirmities in the relief sought by the petitioner. Therefore, in view of the facts and circumstances of the case and discussion made supra, it follows that the petitioner had made out valid and sufficient grounds to grant relief of transfer of S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 from the file of Principal Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Vijayawada to the file of Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Gannavaram to try simultaneously along with O.S.No.44 of 2024. Point No.1 is accordingly answered.


8. POINT NO.2:-

IN THE RESULT, the Transfer Petition is **ALLOWED** without costs. The petition in S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 pending on the file of Principal Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Vijayawada is hereby **WITHDRAWN** and **TRANSFERRED** to the file of Civil Judge's Court (Senior Division), Gannavaram, to try simultaneously with O.S.No.44 of 2024. The learned Principal Civil Judge (Senior Division), Vijayawada

shall transmit the entire record in S.O.P.No.47 of 2023 pending on its file to the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Gannavaram, forthwith, by duly indexing.

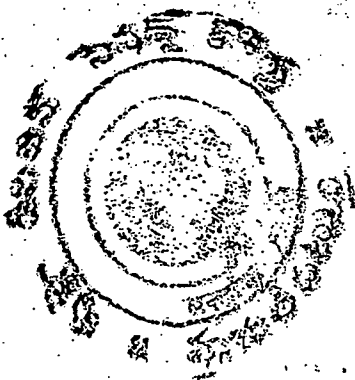

COUNTER FILED ON BEHALF OF THE 1ST DEFENDANT.

1. The main and material allegations made in the application before the Honourable authority are neither true nor correct. The application is liable to be dismissed on facts and law.

2. It is submitted that this defendant is the brother's son of late Pamarthi Basava Sankar, who worked as sweeper in the temple of 2nd defendant during his life time. The wife of Pamarthi Basava Sankar by name Nukaratnam predeceased him and no children were born to them out of their wedlock.

3. It is submitted that during the lifetime the said Pamarthi Basava Sankar on account of his avocation used to reside at Krishnalanka and possessed of immovable properties at Kapileswarapuram. This respondent was very much affectionate towards Pamarthi Basava Sankar. During his life time the said Pamarthi Basava Sankar out of love and affection towards this defendant, executed a registered settlement deed dated 04-02-2022, in respect of house property bearing D.No.3-119, at



Kapileswarapuram, Krishna District in favour of this defendant's son by Pamarthi Jishnu Satwik, being minor represented by the this

defendant as guardian and the same was registered as document No.533 of 2022. The said Gift was acted upon and this defendant being the guardian under the said document has been in possession and enjoyment of the said property.

4. It is submitted that the said Pamarthi Basava Sankar, during his life time executed a Will dated 05-09-2018, which was registered as document No.300/2018, in a sound and disposing state of mind bequeathing immovable property consisting of 265 sq.yards and also bequeathed the death benefits entitled from the 2nd defendant herein and also nominated him for his compassionate appointment in the service of 2nd defendant. The said Pamarthi Basava Sankar, died testate on 01-06-2023. Thus, the registered Will executed by Pamarthi Basava Sankar, came into force.

5. This defendant conducted all the obsequies of Pamarthi Basava Sankar. Thereafter applied for retirement benefits and for compassionate appointment of this defendant before the 2nd defendant herein, in view of bequest in the registered Will. To the utter surprise of this defendant, he received a letter dated 09-08-2023 from the office of Joint commissioner that the applicant made a similar representation claiming herself is the daughter of late Pamarthi Basava Sankar for retirement benefits as such informed to obtain legal heir certificate for further action.

6. It is not out of place to submit that the applicant herein also got issued a notice dated 12-09-2023, claiming herself as daughter of late Pamarthi Basava Sankar for surrendering vacant possession of immovable property gifted to the son of the petitioner under the above referred

registered settlement deed. For which this defendant got issued a reply dated 04-10-2023, with all true and correct facts. Thereafter this defendant received proceedings before the Honourable Mandal Legal Services Authority, at Gannavaram, vide P.L.C. No. 14 of 2023. The contentions that are being raised by the applicant in the above proceedings are not only false but also spurious to the knowledge of the applicant. Infact, late Pamarthi Basava Sankar, never married to the mother of the applicant at any point of time and the applicant is not at all the daughter of late Pamarthi Basava Sankar. It is not out of place to submit that inview of acquaintance with the applicant, after demise of Pamarthi Basava Sankar, on 09-06-2023, this defendant has arranged amount of Rs.5,18,100/- as she was under pressure of creditors and for her domestic expenses with an understanding to repay the same together with interest at 24% p.a. This defendant is apprehending that as the applicant was demanded for repayment of the amount borrowed by the applicant, she started the spurious contentions with a malafide intention to harass this defendant.

7. It is submitted that this defendant alone is entitled to get the death benefits amount lying with the 2nd defendant. Since the 2nd defendant authorities insisted for production of a succession certificate to transfer the said amount to the credit of this defendant, he filed an application before the Honourable Principal Senior Civil Judge, Vijayawada in S.O.P.No. 47 of 2023, for granting succession certificate in his favour, in respect of Rs.13,50,000/- lying to the credit of 2nd defendant.

The said matter is posted to 22-01-2024, for appearance of the petitioner herein and the 2nd respondent herein.

8. It is reiterated that the applicant before the Honourable Court is not at all legal heir of late Pamarthi Basava Sankar and the claim made by her is liable to be rejected. In fact, this respondent being the legatee under the registered Will, is entitled for the death benefits before the 2nd defendant authorities. Hence, the petition is liable to be dismissed.

9. There are no tenable muchless valid grounds for maintaining the application under scrutiny.

10. This defendant denies all the allegations made in the petition, that are not specifically traversed herein.

11. Hence, this defendant therefore pray that the Honourable Court be pleased to dismiss the application, with costs.

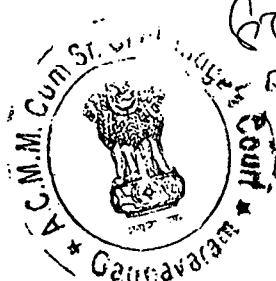





2. The Committee on PRC 2010, which has been constituted vide the references 2nd & 3rd read above, has furnished its recommendations to the Government and stated that it would be appropriate to extend the scheme of Compassionate Appointment which is available in the Government to the employees of the temples and other Endowment institutions. Further it is recommended that a temple or an Endowment institution would be treated as the unit for this purpose and the applicability would have to be with reference to the qualifications prescribed for the post to which the deceased employees' children are to be appointed.

3. Keeping in view of the request of the temple employees and also in the light of the recommendations of the Committee, Government after careful examination, hereby extend the scheme of Compassionate Appointment which has been available in the Government to all the employees of the temples i.e., administration staff including religious staff duly treating the temple or an Endowment institution as a Unit for this purpose.

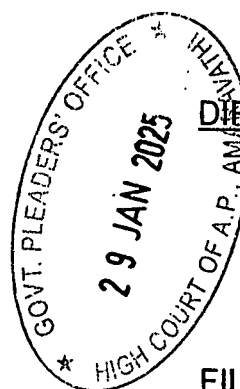
