I submit that the above Writ Petition is filed challenging the action of the Respondent No.4 in issuing an impugned Notice dated.21.10.2024, purportedly exercising the powers conferred under Section 83(2) of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987 for eviction of the Petitioners herein in respect to the subject land in an extent of Ac.1.60 cents situated in Survey No.52/14, Kurijala Village, Ramasamudram Mandal, Annamayya District and the subsequent action of the respondents herein in trying to dispossess the Petitioners

It is further submitted that subsequently, the respondent authorities herein had tried to auction the lease hold rights over the above mentioned property and also tried to dispossess the Petitioners herein from the subject land and when the Petitioners herein had requested them to grant lease hold rights in terms of GO Ms.No.379, the 4<sup>th</sup> Respondent herein had lodged criminal complaint/s against the Petitioners herein and whilst being so, the 1<sup>st</sup> Petitioner herein had

submitted a Representation dated 25.10.2025 before the Respondent No.3 herein requesting him that the Petitioner herein has been cultivating the subject land for almost 40 years and contributing to the development of the temple and living without any demur and that the Petitioner herein has no other source of livelihood except this land and therefore requested the Respondent No.3 to kindly recognize the Petitioner herein as a landless person and help him as per G.O.Ms.No.379, Rule 3. However, there was no reply to the above-mentioned Representation dated 25.10.2025 from the respondents herein.

9. It is submitted that multiple F.I.R's were Registered against the Petitioners herein, basing on complaints by the complainants namely one P. Ramana, which was registered as Crime No.158 of 2024 under sections 126(2), 308(2), 118(1), 351(2), 351(3) R/w. 3(5) of B.N.S on the file of the Ramasamudram P.S., Annamayya District and one V. Jaswanth Kumar and the same was registered by Crime No.159 of 2024 under Sections 189(2), 191(2), 132, 115(2), 351(2), 351(3), 62 R/w. 192 of B.N.S. on the file of the Ramasamudram, P.S. Annamayya District and by one T. Bhulakshmi and the same was registered as Crime No.04 of 2025 under Sections 131 R/w. 3(5) of B.N.S., Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) of SC ST POA Act on the file of the Ramasamudram P.S., Annamayya District and the Petitioners herein were

falsely implicated in the above mentioned crimes and are duly contesting the same on their own merits.

10. It is further submitted that the respondent authorities herein are trying to dispossess the Petitioner herein from the subject land and are also trying to auction the lease hold rights over the above mentioned property, without considering the Petitioner's request to grant lease hold rights in terms of GO Ms.No.379, that too, pending consideration of my request to conduct enquiry and to decide as to whether, as I am a landless poor person or not. Further, as is provided under Section. 83(1) of the Act, 1987, the respondent No.3 being a competent authority has to report to the Endowment Tribunal having jurisdiction over the division in which the institution or endowments is situated where he has reason to believe that, any land, building, tank, well, spring, or water course or any space belonging to the Institution or Endowment. Further, as is provided under Section 83(2) of the Act, 1987 on perusal of the report received by the Endowment Tribunal finds that, there is prima facie case of encroachment, the Endowment Tribunal shall cause to be served upon the encroachers a notice specifying the particulars of encroachment and calling on him to show cause before a certain date, as to why on order requiring him to remove the encroachment date specified in the notice should not be made and a copy of notice shall also be sent to the Trustee of the Institution or Endowment

concerned. As is provided under Section 83(4) of the Endowment Tribunal after conducting such enquiry as may be prescribed is satisfied that, there has been an encroachment, it may, by Orders, require, the encroachers to remove the encroachment and deliver the position of the land or building, or space encroachment upon to the Trustee before the date specified in such Orders.

11. It is respectfully submitted that a mere reading of Section 83(1) (2) (3) & (4) of the Act, 1987 conjointly, the same would amply substantiate that the respondent No.4 is not at all the Competent Authority to issue the notice under Section 83 (2) of the Act, 1987, that too without considering my request for extending the benefits under Section 82(2) of the Act, 1987. Under those circumstances, if the respondent No.4 is allowed to proceed further, in pursuance of the Notice, impugned in the Writ Petition, I will be put to grave and irreparable loss. Therefore, I am constrained to invoke the extraordinary jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court under Article 226 of Constitution of India.

12. It is further submitted that the respondent authorities herein are trying to dispossess the Petitioner herein from the subject land and are also trying to auction the lease hold rights over the above mentioned property, without considering the Petitioner's request to grant lease hold rights in terms of GO

Ms.No.379 and until and unless this Hon'ble Court exercises its extraordinary jurisdiction and intervenes in the matter by directing the Respondents not to interfere with the possession of the petitioners from their lands admeasuring an extent of Ac.1.60 cents in Survey No.52/14, Kurijala Village, Ramasamudram Mandal, Annamayya District, A.P, the Petitioner will suffer irreparable loss and prejudice. The Petitioner has made out a prima facie case and the balance of convenience is also in their favour for grant of an interim order.

13. It is submitted that the petitioner has no other efficacious alternative remedy except to approach this Hon'ble Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. It is also submitted that the petitioner has not filed any writ or suit or case before this Hon'ble Court or before any other forum seeking the relief prayed for in this writ petition.

14. It In these circumstances and for the reasons aforesaid, the petitioner pray that the Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue a writ, direction or order or orders more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring that the action of the Respondent No.4 herein in issuing an impugned Notice dated 21.10.2024 under purported exercise of the powers conferred under Section 83(2) of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987 for the eviction of the Petitioners herein in respect

to the subject land in an extent of Ac.1.60 cents situated in Survey No.52/14, Kurijala Village, Ramasamudram Mandal, Annamayya District, A.P without having any power or authority, as wholly illegal, arbitrary, unjust, contrary to provisions of Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987, violative of principles of Natural Justice, besides being violative of Article 21 and 300A of Constitution of India. The brief facts of the case are as follows and consequently set aside the Notice dated 21.10.2024 issued by the Respondent No.4 herein and pass such other order(s) as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper.

15. It is further prayed that, pending disposal of the writ petition that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in pursuance to the impugned Notice dated 21.10.2024 issued by the Respondent No.4 herein and pass such other order(s) as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

16. It is further prayed that pending disposal of the above writ petition this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to interfere with the possession and enjoyment of the Petitioner herein, including cultivation of the existing potato crop in the subject land in an extent of Ac.1.60 cents situated in Survey No.52/14, Kurijala Village, Ramasamudram Mandal, Annamayya District, A.P and pass

such other order or orders as are deemed fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.



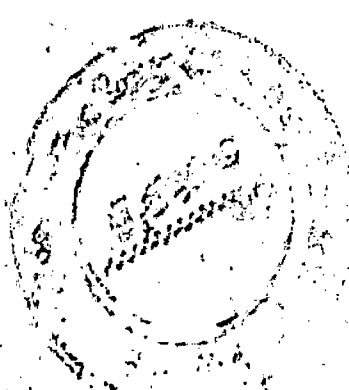

I belong to a poor family, my father owned AC 1.60 in Sy from about 40 years ago. No. 52/14 Kurijala Village, Ramasamudra. We were told that they had borrowed a sum of Rs. Since then this land has been under our possession and we have been farming it ourselves. I have also arranged a pipe line to bring water from the adjacent land for water to this land. Now I planted potato crop in this land. Once the temple priests objected to the cultivation of this land. On the advice of the Darimila village elders, we came to an agreement that a part of the income from farming on this land would be given to the development of the temple and the monthly salary of the priest and the rituals performed in the temple. Since then we have adhered to the above agreement without fail. Now we are trying to reconstruct this temple mainly to develop it. It is well known that in 1989 I filed Ordinary O.S No. 225/1989 in the District Magistrate's Court Punganur and on that day some of the villagers who objected were included as respondents and the judgment was delivered on 06-11-1989. This judgment is in my favor.

Since almost 40 years, I have been cultivating the temple land and contributing to the development of the temple without any hindrance. I have no livelihood other than this land. Therefore, the Assistant Commissioner kindly issued GO MS No.: 379 Praying that I may be recognized and supported as Lands Pur under Rule 3.

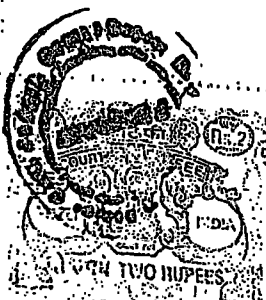
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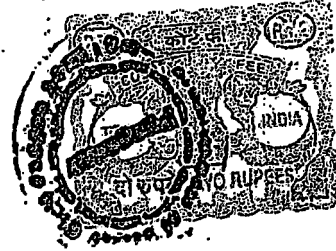

Moreover, we have also distributed the auction pump plate stating that it is an open auction announcement. On this day, i.e. 06-11-2024 at 3:00 pm, I, our Endowment Department Inspector Shasikumar, our clerk Bala Apanna and attendant B Rajasekhar went to auction the temple lands at Sri Ramalayam in Kurijala village. While there, C Chengareddy, who was cultivating the temple land at 1-60 cents per acre, his younger brother Gopal, Chengareddy's wife Tulasamma, Gopal's wife Yashodamma, Chengareddy's son Chandra Shekhar, Shasikumar, Chengareddy's daughter Prema Mamata, Gopal's sons Srikanth and Chengareddy's sons Prasad and Sivakumar, all of them formed an illegal association with the intention of stopping the auction and came to Kutrapanni Guddi and atrocities were committed against us and said that the lands should not be auctioned and should go away from here. They lifted the chairs there and threw them on the villagers and caused blunt injuries, obstructing our duties. 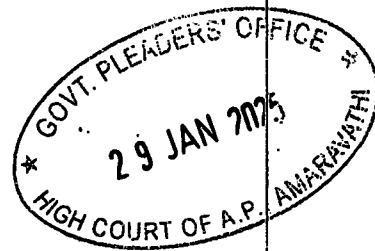
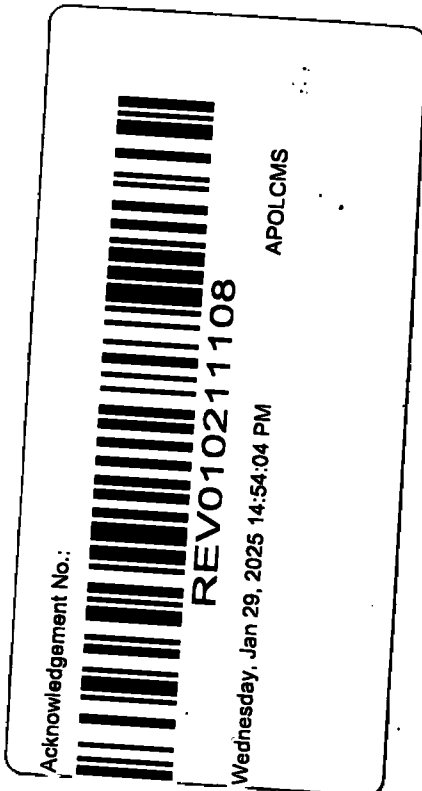
