AFFIDAVIT

I, Kousika Naga Hanumath Chandra Shekar Kumar, S/o Late Koteswara Sastry, Age 52 years, Occ: Sthanacharya, Sri Ammareswara swami vari Devasthanam, Amaravathi, Guntur District., having come down to Vijayawada, do hereby solemnly affirm and sincerely state on oath as follows:

1. I submit that, I am the petitioner and deponent herein, as such I am well acquainted with the facts of the case.

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2. It is submitted that the present writ petition is filed challenging the action of the 2nd respondent in issuing proceedings in Rc. No.C2/13021(48)/5/2024 dated 17.02.2025 and consequential proceedings of the 3rd respondent issued vide Showcause Notice No. 21/2025 dated 08.03.2025 and Memo. 20/2025 dated 08.03.2025 thereby directing the petitioner not to render his services as Sthanacharya and only limiting to vedaparayanadar as bad, illegal, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14, 16 & 21 of Constitution of India and violative of principles of natural justice.
3. I submit that, I was initially appointed on consolidated pay for an amount of Rs. 100/- per day as Chandi Sapathasiti Parayandar in the 3rd respondent temple as per the orders of the 2nd respondent issued vide L.Dis.No. B1/22566/2007 dated 11.12.2007. Thereafter my pay was enhanced from time to time as per the orders of the respondent authorities.
4. I submit that, my remuneration was enhanced to Rs. 20,000/- per month as per the orders of the 2nd respondent issued vide L.Dis No. C2/13021(39)/33/2019 dated 05.02.2021. Further as per the said orders I was also permitted to render services as Sthanacharya besides Chandi Sapthasiti vedaparayandar, as such I am rendering services as Sthanacharya besides Chandi Sapthasiti vedaparayandar. At present I am drawing an amount of Rs. 48,440/- per month.
5. I submit that, while the matter stood thus one Durga Bharath and Markendeya Sharma have filed W.P No. 6901/2024 before this Hon'ble Court to take action on his representation alleging appointments that have taken place in the 3rd respondent institution. The above said W.P was disposed of on 09.05.2024 with a direction to the 2nd respondent to consider the petitioners representation dated

29.01.2024 within a period of 2 months. It is apposite to mention herein that we were not even made parties in the said W.P. but the orders are granted to take action against us.

6. I submit that, thereafter the 2nd respondent has issued the impugned proceedings vide Rc.No. C2/13021(48)/5/2024 dated 17.02.2025 according permission to the 3rd respondent E.O to utilize my services only as Chandi Sapthasiti vedaparayandar. Pursuant to the same the 3rd respondent has issued Show cause Notice No. 21/2025 dated 08.03.2025 to submit explanation within 7 days but without waiting for the same the 3rd respondent issued Memo. 20/2025 dated 08.03.2025 on the same day itself thereby directing me not to render my services as Sthanacharya and reducing my pay from Rs. 48,440/- per month to Rs. 25,220/- per month which is nothing but illegal, arbitrary, abuse of power and without following Principles of Natural Justice.
7. I submit that, it is the 2nd respondent who has permitted to render services as Sthanacharya besides Chandi Sapthasiti vedaparayandar now without assigning any reasons whatsoever straight away direction has been given to the 3rd respondent to take action against me without affording opportunity to me.
8. I submit that, thereafter the 3rd respondent has issued show cause notice No. 21/2025 dated 08.03.2025 calling for an explanation from me within a period of 7 days. To my utter surprise and dismay without giving me an opportunity of hearing and waiting for reply, on the same day itself Memo. 20/2025 dated 08.03.2025 was issued thereby directed me not to render my services as Sthanacharya because of which my pay got reduced. To 50% which is illegal & arbitrary.

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9. I submit that, it is crystal clear from the above facts that the 2nd and 3rd respondent have issued the impugned proceedings by violating the principles of natural justice and without jurisdiction, hence these are liable to be set aside in limini.
10. I further submit that, under the guise of the above said WP order, the EO of the subject temple is without even following the Principles of Natural Justice is taking coercive action on a war footing basis against me i.e. reverting / reducing the pay, etc.
11. I submit that, unless the impugned orders are set aside, I will be put to irreparable loss and injury which cannot be compensated by any means. Hence the present writ petition is filed.
12. It is submitted that the petitioner has no other alternative and efficacious remedy except to approach this Hon'ble Court under Article 226 of constitution of India.
13. It is submitted that the petitioner has not filed any suit, application or petitions before any court of law and we have not sought for any similar relief.

In the above-mentioned circumstances, it is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ order or direction more particularly, one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the 2nd respondent in issuing proceedings in Rc. No.C2/13021(48)/5/2024 dated 17.02.2025 and consequential proceedings of the 3rd respondent issued vide Showcause Notice No. 21/2025 dated 08.03.2025 and Memo. 20/2025 dated 08.03.2025 thereby directing the petitioner not to render his services as Sthanacharya as bad, illegal, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14, 16, 21 & 25 of Constitution of India and violative of principles of natural justice and consequently set aside the same by directing the



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

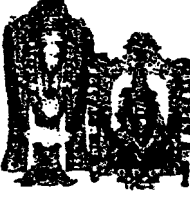

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Attention of Sri K.Naga Hanumanth Chandra Sekhar Kumar working as Chandi Sapthasiti Parayandar is invited, to the reference cited wherein the Commissioner of Endowments was pleased to accord permission to utilize his services only as Chandi Sapthasiti Parayandar with a fixed remuneration of Rs 25220/- P.M (minimum time scale to the cadre of Sapthasiti Parayandar under RPS 2022).

In pursuance to above permission with reference to the available connected record in the temple, Sri K. Naga Hanumanth Chandra Sekhar Kumar, Chandi Sapthasiti Parayandar is informed that,

1. He was initially permitted to render his services as Chandi Sapthasiti Parayandar on a consolidated amount of Rs 100/- Per day in the subject temple as per the orders of the Commissioner of Endowments in L. Dis.No B1/22566/2007, Dt 11.12.2007,
2. His remuneration was enhanced to Rs 5000/- P.M w.e.f 01.07.2010 by the then Executive Officer vide orders in Rc.No A2/364/2010, Dt 05.01.2011.
3. Again his remuneration was enhanced to Rs 6000/- P.M w.e.f 01.11.2011 as per the orders of the Regional Joint Commissioner, Endowments Department, Tirupathi in L.Dis.No A2/5213/2011, RJC Dt 05.11.2011.

4. Again, his remuneration was enhanced to Rs 10,000/- P.M as per the orders of the Commissioner of Endowments, A.P, Hyderabad in L.Dis.No B1/34519/2012, Dt 21.01.2013.
5. Again, his remuneration was enhanced to Rs 13,000/- P.M as per the orders of the Regional Joint Commissioner, Endowments Department, Tirupathi in L. Dis.No A2/3175/2015, Dt 06.07.2015.
6. Again, his remuneration was enhanced to Rs 18,300/- P.M as per the orders of the Commissioner of Endowments, A.P, Vijayawada in L. Dis.No COE-13021(46)/2/2017-C SEC-ENDOWMENTS, Dt 27.07.2017.
7. Again, his remuneration was enhanced to Rs 20,000/- P.M as per the orders of the Commissioner of Endowments, A.P, Vijayawada in L.Dis.No C2/13021(39)/33/2019, Dt 05.02.2021. In these orders the individual was also permitted to render his services as Sthanacharya besides Chandi Sapthasiti Parayandar.
8. Later, the then Executive Officer has submitted the proposals through letter Dt 22.08.2023 to the Commissioner for enhancement of salary to the individual. The Commissioner vide L.Dis.No.C2/COE-13021(46)/8/2022, Dt 30.10.2023 has instructed the Executive Officer to take necessary action as per the circular instructions of the Commissioner in Rc.No A1/11026/64/2018, Dt 12.12.2018 and Rc.No A1/11026(43)/29/2022, Dt 01.08.2022. These two circulars are related to extend of minimum time scale and permission orders to extend RPS 2022.
9. In RPS 2022, minimum time scale for Chandi Sapathasiti Parayandar as per GO 261, Revenue (Endowments-I) Department, Dt 20.05.2002 is Rs 25220. But, the then Executive Officer assumed the above orders dt 30.10.2023 as permission to extend the minimum time scale in the cadre Pradana Archaka and extended minimum time scale Rs 48440/- P.M to Sri K. Naga Hanumanth Chandra Sekhar Kumar, Chandi Sapathasiti Parayandar as Sthanacharya where as his appointment is only chandi Sapthasiti Parayandar. At present he is drawing fixed remuneration of Rs 48440/- P.M.

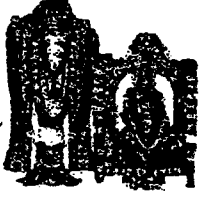

This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the following relief:-

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel appearing for the respondents.

3. The grievance of the petitioners is that the petitioners made a representation dated 29.01.2024 to the 2nd respondent requesting to enquire into the illegal appointments in the 3rd respondent-temple and to take appropriate action by the 2nd respondent against the erring officer.

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4. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that it would suffice to dispose of the writ petition directing the respondents to dispose of the representation dated 29.01.2024.

5. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, without going into merits of the case, this Court is inclined to dispose of the writ petition directing the 2nd respondent to examine the petitioners' representation dated 29.01.2024 and pass appropriate orders within a period of two (02) months from the date of receipt of a copy of the order and communicate the same to the petitioners.

6. With the above said directions, the Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this writ petition shall stand closed.

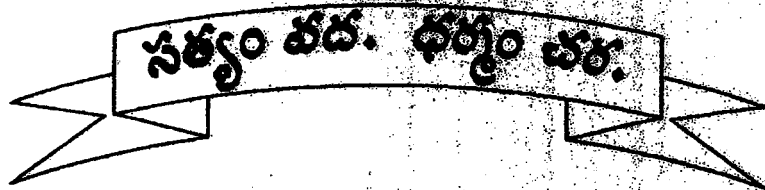
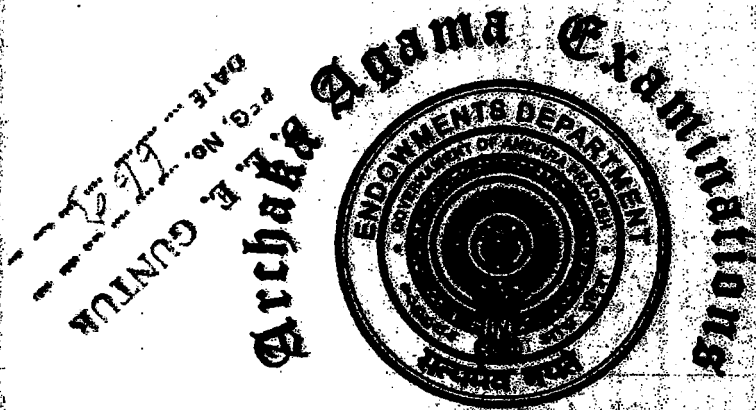

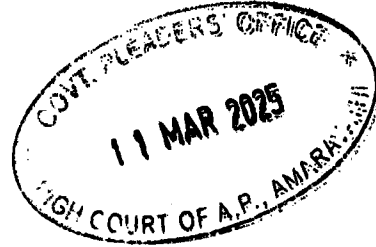
