2. It is submitted that I am working as Commissioner(FAC), Endowments
Department, AP, from 24.01.2025 and that I am 2nd Respondent in this case and as
such acquainted with the facts of the case. I have read and under stood the averments
of the affidavit of the petitioner filed in support of the writ petition. I deny all the

material averments made therein except those which are specifically admitted hereunder and those that are not contrary to the record. The petitioner is put to strict proof of the same.


3. It is submitted that the petitioner filed this writ petition for an order one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents No 1 to 3 in initiating steps to take over the Management of 4th respondent-institution by the Government of A P contrary to the Provisions of Endowments Act 30 of 1987 and also contrary to the provisions of A.P. Education Act, 1982 as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, colourable exercise of the power, contrary to Article 26 of the Constitution of India and contrary to the objects and aims of the 4th respondent-institution and consequently direct the respondent Nos 1 and 2 to implement the G.O.Ms.No:655dated:11.07.1990 especially recommendation No 11. This Writ Petition is not maintainable either on facts or in Law.

4. At the outset, it is submitted that this writ petition is filed by the writ petitioner in his individual capacity claiming as Member of Founder Family of the institution but not filed on behalf of the institution. No cause of action arose to the writ petitioner in his individual capacity to invoke writ jurisdiction under Article 226 of Constitution of India. On this ground alone, this writ petition is liable to be dismissed in limine.

5. It is further submitted that this writ petition is a pre-mature one as the respondents, more particularly the 1st respondent-Government have not yet taken any decision to take over A.J.Kalasala, Machilipatnam, one of the educational institutions maintaining

by the 4th respondent-Institution. On this ground also, this writ petition is liable to be dismissed.


6. It is further submitted that this respondent is not admitting the averment of the petitioner that Kopalle Hanumantha Row Panthulu is his Grand Father. The petitioner is put to strict proof of the same. K Hanumantha Row Panthulu might have established the 4th respondent-institution but he along with 3 others have acted as life members of the 4th respondent-institution and maintained the same by collecting donations from the public and the same is evident from the Registered Memorandum of Association and its Rules 10/1911-12 dated:19-06-1911. It is pertinent to note that copy of Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad, dated as 21-02-1910 filed by the writ petitioner along with this writ petition (page no.23-33) is not true copy to the original registered Memorandum of Association and its Rules 10/1911-12 dated:19-06-1911. Copy of registration extract of registered document 19-06-2011 obtained from District Register Office, Krishna, Machilipatnam is herewith enclosed for consideration. The copy of Memorandum of Association filed by the writ petitioner and the registration extract copy of Memorandum of Association obtained from District Register Office, Krishna, Machilipatnam are not completely identical to each other. For the reasons best know to the writ petitioner, the copy of Memorandum of Association filed by him is conveniently changed. The concept of life members in the Rules, the Board of life members in the management, constitution of Members of Governing Body and Trustees are conveniently omitted in the copy of Memorandum of Association filed by him, which can be clearly understood from the





7. It is respectfully submitted that thus, it clearly shows that the writ petitioner has approached the Hon'ble Writ Court with unclean hands, by suppression of material

facts and with deceitful intention. On this ground alone, this writ petition is liable to be dismissed in limine and that the writ petitioner is liable to be punished.

8. It is further submitted that later, the 4th respondent-institution was published under Section 6(b) of the Act 17 of 1966 and registered under section 38 of the Act 17 of 1966 and approved by the Assistant Commissioner Endowments Department, Machilipatnam, Krishna District vide R.Dis.No:10756/70 Dated 10-05-1972. The said approved register of 4th respondent-institution under section 38 of the Act 17 of 1966 specifically contains **that there are no hereditary rights vested to anybody**. The 4th respondent-institution is maintaining educational institutions. Earlier one Writ petition in W.P.No:4534/1980 was filed by the institution represented by its life trustee Ch.Subramanyeswarao before the Hon'ble High Court at Hyderabad assailing the correctness of taking over of the management of the subject institution, by the Endowments Department, the said writ petition was dismissed vide order dated:06.07.1981. Aggrieved by the said order, a Writ Appeal in W.A.No:427/1981 was filed before the Division Bench of Hon'ble High Court at Hyderabad and the same was also dismissed vide order dated:01.12.1986. Later, the Government has enacted the present Endowments Act 30 of 1987 which came into force by repealing the old Act 17 of 1966. Thereafter, the 4th respondent-institution was also published under section 6(a)(i) the Act 30 of 1987 and the same is under the administrative control of the Endowments Department. The 2nd respondent-Commissioner in exercise of powers conferred under section 29 of the Act, 1987 has appointed an Executive Officer to the 4th respondent-institution in the year 1988. Ever since the Executive





Officer has been administering and managing the day-to-day affairs of the 4th respondent- institution. Now its Executive Officer is in the cadre of Assistant Commissioner. Admittedly. Though, the 4th respondent-institution was initially established by K. Hanumantha Row Panthulu the said institution ever since 1911 was being managed by Life members consisting of Hanumantha Row Panthulu and 3 others. That apart, approved register of the institution maintained under section 38 of the Act 1966 expressly contains **that there are no hereditary rights vested to anybody**. Under these circumstances, the claim of the writ petitioner as member of founder family of the institution does not arise and not tenable under law. Moreover the petitioner has not filed any material document along with this writ petition to show that K Hanumantha Row Panthulu is his Grandfather or at least to show that the writ petitioner is the member of family of K Hanumantha Row Panthulu. Thus, the writ Petitioner has not established the nexus between K Hanumantha Row Panthulu and himself.

9. It is further submitted that the 4th respondent-institution is imparting Education through the following Educational institutions under the provisions of A.P. Education Act, 1982:



The 4th respondent-institution is getting annual income of Rs.53,50,633/- from the landed properties.

10. It is further submitted that since the 4th respondent-institution was not properly managed, the Government vide G.O.Ms.No:531, Rev(Endts-IV) Dept, Dated:28.05.1987 has constituted a Five(5) members committee to enquire into the affairs of the institution. Later, the Government issued G.O.Ms.No:655, Dated: 11.07.1990 in order to provide administration with revitalization. Subsequently the Government vide G.O.Ms.No:716, Dated:19.08.1991 appointed a board consisting of Seven(7) members to look after the affairs of the Institution exempting the institution from the operation of the provisions of Section 15 of the Act 30 of 1987. Later, the Government again issued G.O.Rt.No:1662, Dated:01.10.1997 appointing a Board consisting of Seven(7) members for a period of One(1) year to look after the affairs of the institution. It is pertinent to note that no one from the family of Kopalle was

appointed as Board Member either in G.OMs.No:716, Dated:19.08.1991 or G.O.Rt.No:1662, Dated:01.10.1997.

11. It is further submitted that the writ petitioner is claiming as member of founder family and Trustee of the 4th respondent-institution without any order from the competent authority in force. His alleged claim as Member of Founder Family of 4th respondent-institution is not true and correct. The petitioner is put to strict proof of the same. Admittedly no one much less K Hanumantha Row Panthulu was declared as founder to the 4th respondent-institution and no one was recognized or appointed as member of founder family of the 4th respondent-institution prior to alleged claim of the writ petitioner. In the absence of Founder to an institution, the question of recognition and appointment of member of founder family to the said institution does not arise.

12. It is humbly submitted that the order of the then Assistant Commissioner, Endowments Department, Vijayawada dated 26-01-1999 declaring the writ petitioner herein as member of founder family of the 4th respondent-institution, was set aside by the Regional Joint Commissioner of Endowments in RP.No.53 of 1999 dated 27-05-2000. Aggrieved by the same, the writ petitioner herein filed WP No:12865 of 2000 before the Hon'ble High court at Hyderabad and the said writ petition was dismissed on 07-09-2000. Challenging the same, the writ petitioner filed WA. No:1125/2000 before the Division Bench of the Hon'ble High court at Hyderabad and the said Writ Appeal was also dismissed on 21-01-2002. Later, the writ petitioner herein filed review petition IA. No: 3 of 2005 in RP.No 53 of 1999 before the Regional Joint



Commissioner of Endowments and the same was dismissed on 21-05-2006. Thus, the order passed by the Regional Joint Commissioner of Endowments in RP No 53 Of 1999 dated 27-05-2000 became final and binding on the writ petitioner herein. Thereby the orders of the Assistant Commissioner, Endowments Department, Vijayawada dated:26-01-1999 are set-aside. Therefore, there is no order in force declaring or appointing the writ petitioner herein as member of founder family of the 4th respondent-institution by the competent authority or by the Endowments Tribunal. But, unfortunately, the writ petitioner herein has been claiming as member of founder family of 4th respondent-institution by simply relying on a letter of Regional Joint Commissioner, Multi Zone, Kakinada vide L.Dis.No A3/1431/05 dated 12-03-2005 stating that the writ petitioner herein remains founder family member as his order was set-aside basing on the pendency of disciplinary proceedings and the department officials treated as member of founder family of the 4th respondent-institution. It cannot be considered as estoppel as there can be no estoppel against law. The said letter dated 12-03-2005 cannot be considered as an order of the Regional Joint Commissioner, Kakinada. It is not an order of the then Regional Joint Commissioner, Kakinada. More over subsequent to the said letter dated:12-03-2005 of Regional Joint Commissioner, Kakinada, the writ petitioner filed a review petition IA. No.03/2005 in RP No 53 of 1999 before the Regional Joint Commissioner of Endowments and the same was dismissed on 21.05.2006. The same became final and binding on the writ petitioner as the writ petitioner has not challenged it. More over, subsequently the writ petitioner herein has not filed any representation/application before the competent



authority and has not get declared him or recognized him or appointed him as member of founder family of 4th respondent-institution i.e., subsequent to dismissal of Review Petition IA. No.03 of 2005 in RP. No 53 of 1999. Hence, there is no order in force declaring the writ petitioner herein as member of founder family of the 4th respondent-institution by the competent authority in the Endowments Department or no such order from the Endowments Tribunal. Hence, the writ petitioner cannot and shall not claim as founder family member of the 4th respondent-institution. The petitioner, herein, is fully aware of the same fact.

13. It is further submitted that on considering the note of the District Collector, Krishna District i.e., 3rd respondent, through Public Grievance Redressal System on 17.10.2024, the Government issued memo No:Rev-01/Endw-1081/2024-Endts.ii, dated:20.10.2024 directing the Commissioner of Endowments i.e., 2nd respondent to examine the issue i.e., for taking over of Andhra Jatheeya Kalasala, Machilipatnam by Government of A.P. and furnish a detailed report to the Government. In turn, the 2nd respondent-Commissioner has issued a memo in Rc.No:B1/COE- 12026(51)/19/2025, Dated:03.02.2025 to the 4th respondent herein to examine and submit a report. Accordingly, the 4th respondent has submitted a report vide Rc.No:13/EO/AJVP/MTM, Dated:07.03.2025 to the 2nd respondent. The same is under examination with the 2nd respondent-Commissioner so as to submit a report to the Government as called for.

14. While the matter stood thus, the Petitioner in his individual capacity filed this

writ petition challenging the proposals initiated by the Government. The above writ petition was not filed on behalf of the institution. Hence it is in premature stage as the issue itself is under examination at the department level. Consequently this writ petition is liable to be dismissed.

15. It is further submitted that the 4th respondent-institution was established with a noble object to impart and promote the Education-Literary, Scientific, Technical and Professional on National lines, but now the Educational institutions (above) which are under the management of the Correspondent (a retired employee) are not running up to the mark with the original objects of the Association. Those educational institutions are running for the sake of running with very less number of students particularly single digit in some of the courses. The teaching staff are not well qualified and experienced. Most of them are working on temporary basis with low remuneration as part time lectures. Thereby, the name and fame of the 4th respondent-institution is being degraded in the Society. The details of students, staff and their remuneration of AJ Kalasala which is the subject matter of this case are as below:



16. It is further submitted that the 3rd respondent-District Collector, Krishna District has received a grievance under Public Grievance Redressal System. Basing on note of the 3rd respondent, the 1st respondent-Government directed the 2nd respondent-Commissioner of Endowments to examine the issue in detail and submit a report on the issue of taking over of Andhra Jatheeya Kalasala, Machilipatnam by the Government of A.P. The said proposal of the Government is with a view to strengthen the Teaching staff and to improve the admissions thereby promote the educational institution maintaining by the 4th respondent-institution beneficial to Society and to meet the foundation objects of the Association, but not with any other motive or intention. Hence, no prima facie case is made out by the petitioner in support of reliefs as prayed for in this case.




I submit that, in the reference 1st cited, the Commissioner,
Endowments Department, Andhra Pradesh, Vijayawada was pleased to
Communicate the Government Memo issued in the reference 2nd cited
and directed to examine the matter of taking over of Andhra Jatheeya
Vidhya Parishad, Machilipatnam by Government of A.P and to submit a
detailed report immediately for taking necessary further action.

I submit that, in the reference 3rd cited, Commissioner's Memo along with its enclosures has been communicated to FFM of subject institution and opinion of the FFM was called for to submit the report to the Commissioner of Endowments, A.P, Vijayawada. In the reference 4th cited, the FFM has submitted the following report and same is herewith enclosing for kind perusal and necessary action.

"the Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad was established in 1907 by my Grandfather Sri Kopalle Hanumantha Rao Panthulugaru to impart and promote education, literacy, scientific, technical and professional on national lines as mentioned in the Memorandum and Articles of Association duly registered under the provisions of the Act XXI of 1860 of the Acts of the Viceroy and Governor-General of India in Council (vide No.1/1911-12 dated 19.06.1911 of Deputy Registrar, Krishna District) and such institution is being administered as per the founding objects of the Association.

As a part of its curriculum, the Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad, at the time of its inception, introduced various courses in ancient Indian fine arts like Shilpa Sastra (Sculpture), Vasthu Sastra, Chitra Lekhana (Drawing) and Weaving. Further, the Institution had passed through a tumultuous regime during the peak freedom movement and had its complete revival with the change in Educational System in the post-Independence era as such the ancient Indian fine art courses were closed due to lack of proper support from the affiliating authorities.

The Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad is imparting education through the following subsidiary educational institutions (Private) under the provisions of A.P. Education Act, 1982 prior to the taking over the administration by the Endowments Department:

- 1) *The A.J. Kalasala offered U.G. Courses since 07.06.1949. Subsequently, Intermediate (Senior Secondary) Education was introduced on 14.06.1969. The Government of Andhra Pradesh extended grant-in-aid for AJ Kalasala (Composite College) from 1964. (At present it is under un-aided category)*
- 2) *The AJK Oriental Secondary School was started in 1959 to impart School Education (6th to 10th class) with Sanskrit as one of the main subjects. The AJK Oriental Secondary School was started in 1959 to impart School Education (6th to 10th class) with Sanskrit as one of the main subjects. The Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad established A.J.K. Oriental Secondary School in 1959 to impart education-literacy with history and philosophy of our nation with a mix of knowledge from the Vedas and modern education as the Vedas are considered to be the oldest form of literature in Sanskrit and it is a language of ancient India with a history going back about 3,500 years with primary liturgical language of Hinduism and the predominant language of most works of Hindu philosophy as well as some of the principal texts of Buddhism and Jainism which was migrated to Southeast Asia, parts of East Asia and Central Asia, emerging as a language of high culture and of local ruling elites in these regions and it is traceable to the 2nd millennium BCE in a form known as the Vedic Sanskrit, with the Rigveda as the earliest known composition, though it not necessarily Classical Sanskrit, is the root language of many Prakrit languages such as Hindi, Marathi, Bengali, Punjabi and Nepali. As such, the school curriculum is primarily aimed at promoting Sanskrit language and it is included as main subject for 8th to 10th class curriculum in place of Social Studies and was extended grant-in-aid from 1975 by the Government of Andhra Pradesh and still it is in existence as aided school.*
- 3) *The AJ College of Education was started to offer Teacher Education course (B.Ed) in 1967 and was extended grant-in-aid from 1977.*
- 4) *The Engineering workshop offered industrial training courses from 1907 and it was re-designed as Industrial Training Institute (ITI) from 1951.*

Further the Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad was published under section 6 (b) (1) of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious and Endowments Act, 1966 (Act 17 of 1966) duly registered U/s 38 of the Act 17 of 1966. In 1979, the Government issued instructions to the Commissioner, Endowments Department to enquire and submit a report on the affairs of the management. After due consideration of the representation made by the Secretary of Parishad for exempting the Institution U/s. 108 of the Act 17 of 1966, the Government requested the commissioner to constitute a trust board and to appoint an Executive officer for its management.

The Secretary of the Institution filed a review petition dated 12-07-80 to Government U/S. 84 of the AP Act 17 of 1966. There upon, the revisional authority suspended the operation of sections 15 & 27 of the Act, pending final disposal of the said review petition (Govt. Memo. No. 1920/E.I/801, dt; 17-07-1980) and later vacated the order of suspension vide Memo. No. 1920/E.I/80-2, dated 3-9-1980 by rejecting the Review Petition.

There upon, the Managing Trustee/Secretary of the Institution filed a W.P. No. 4534/80 on the file of Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh and obtained injunction in W.P.M.P. No. 7020/80 restraining the Government from giving effect to the Orders issued by the Commissioner vide D.Dis No. G4/45363/80, Dt: 10.09.1980 appointing the E.O. to the institution. Subsequently, the Writ Petition was dismissed and also Writ Appeal vide W.A. No. 427 of 1981 was dismissed on 01.12.1986. The Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh was pleased to dismiss the writ petition and its appeal, confirming that the Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad was established for charitable purpose to impart education as defined in Clause (5) of section 2 of the Act 17 of 1966.

Meanwhile, Sri K. Koteswara Rao, Editor, Telugu Vidyarthi (Monthly Publication) and Member of Legislative Council, Machilipatnam had submitted a representation to the Government (Letter dated 19-5-1987) requesting to take over the management by the Government to facilitate the development of the historic institution in accordance with the objects for which the institution was founded. In spite of dismissal of the writ petition and writ appeal filed by the Private management of subject institution against the registration under the Act 17 of 1966 to take over the management of Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad by the Endowments Department, upon the request of Sri K. Koteswara Rao, Editor, Telugu Vidyarthi (Monthly Publication), the Government constituted a committee with four persons as members viz., 1) Sri K. Koteswara Rao, 2) Sri G.J.V. Jagannadha Raju, VC, Nagarjuna University 3) Sri Jaffer Nizam representative of Commissionerate of Higher Education and 4) District Collector, Krishna under the convenorship of Commissioner, Endowments to examine and submit a comprehensive report on the following points along with the Committee's recommendations dated 28.05.87.

1. Verification of the Extent of land and Physical infrastructure owned by the Institution.
2. The existing institutional framework and financial resources with reference to the objectives.
3. Identification of new courses, consistent with the changing times.
4. The method and extent of affiliation and associations between the various universities in the State add this Instruction.
5. The pattern of administrative and technical control of this institution vis-à-vis the provisions of the Hindu religious and charitable Endowment Act.
6. The new educational requirements, which this institution can serve in the context of modern science, technology and Human Resources Development

Meanwhile, pursuant to the dismissal of the Writ Appeal No. 427 of 1981 filed by the private management, the Commissioner, Endowments Department appointed the Executive Officer on 20.02.1988.

The Committee constituted under G.O.Ms. No. 531 Revenue (Endts.IV) Department dated 28.05.1987 has made a comprehensive study of the various issues referred to them and submitted its report through Commissioner, Endowments to Government on 28.03.1988 & 02.05.1990. In turn the Government has carefully studied the reports of the Committee and the recommendations made therein and felt that there is a need for restructuring this institution without prejudice to the original objectives with a view to achieve larger objectives consistent with the modern educational and cultural requirements. As such the Government issued orders on the recommendations of the Committee to restructure this institution without prejudice to the original objectives with a view to achieve larger objectives consistently modern educational and cultural requirements and to revitalize the institution and accorded permission to the Commissioner, Endowments to explore the possibilities of getting financial assistance under the different schemes of the State Government and the Government of India and send if necessary, specific proposals to the Government through G.O.Ms. No. 655, Rev (End. IV),dt: 11.07.1990 vide reference 3rd cited. It is relevant to submit here that the said G.O holds good till date. Further, by virtue of recommendation 11 of G.O.Ms.No.655, Revenue (Endts. IV) Dept., dt.11.07.1990 the Commissioner of Endowments Dept., is requested to explore the possibilities of getting financial assistance under the different schemes of the State Government and the Government of India and send if necessary, specific proposals to the Government. At the same

time, the institution must be able to mobilize its own resources coupled with grants being received in a very profitable and useful way.

At present The Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad is imparting education through the following subsidiary educational institutions in a composite campus with common playground and common auditorium:

In the light of the above said facts and circumstances coupled with the orders of the Hon'ble High Court passed in W.P.No.4534 of 1980 and its Writ Appeal No.427 of 1981, the subject-Institution is covered as a "charitable institution" to impart education through its subsidiary institutions as per provisions of Section 2(4) of the AP Act 30 of 1987, and as per Section 14 of AP Act 30 of 1987, all the properties belonging to, or given or endowed to a subject-institution shall, vest in the institution.

Further I have gone through the correspondence vide references cited which were circulated to me by you and it is noticed that there is discrepancy of the instructions issued by the Government of AP, and Commissioner of Endowments that the Government of AP sought detailed report from the Commissioner Endowments for taking over of Andhra Jatheeya Kalasala, Machilipatnam considering the status report submitted by the District Collector- Krishna where as the Commissioner's office and your office mentioned that taking over of Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad, Machilipatnam by the Government of AP. Further you are aware that Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad and Andhra Jatheeya Kalasala are two different institutions with separate legal entities. Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad is a Private Charitable Institution under the administrative control of Endowments department where as the Andhra Jatheeya Kalasala is a private un-aided subsidiary educational institution of Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad, imparting higher education (Intermediate, UG & PG courses) as like other subsidiary educational institutions of Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad.

As the Government of AP has already reviewed the status of the Institution and restructured this institution without prejudice to the original objectives with a view to achieve larger objectives consistently modern educational and cultural requirements and accorded permission to the Commissioner, Endowments to explore the possibilities of getting financial assistance under the different schemes of the State Government and the Government of India through G.O.Ms. No. 655, Rev (End. IV), dt: 11.07.1990 without disturbing its entity, you are requested to examine the connected records and relevant material in respect of the establishment, continuance and present status of Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad and its subsidiary educational institutions in consonance with its

founding objectives, and clarify the following queries and circulate the file with all relevant material and the substantial material mentioned in the above queries through your detailed report to offer my opinion on the above subject matter as sought by you.

- 1. The circumstances led to consider the proposal by the Government to take over Andhra Jatheeya Kalasala(Private Institution) which is under the management of Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad as there is no specific reason to take a decision on taking over of Andhra Jatheeya Kalasala as Hon'ble Chief Minister's assurance in Krishna District.*
- 2. Circulate the note of District Collector – Krishna Dt.17/10/2024 which was mentioned as the reference in Government memo dated 20.10.2024.*
- 3. Specify whether the Government is intended to taking over the administration of Andhra Jatheeya Kalasala or the Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad with the ideology of Government to take such step against these organizations alone in Krishna District.*
- 4. Circulate the relevant rule position to protect the entity of a charitable institution and/or the established procedure to take over of Private charitable institution which is under the administration control of Endowments Department by the Government of AP, if any.*
- 5. The Connected material which is root cause for the formulating such proposal by the Government to take over Andhra Jatheeya Kalasala.*
- 6. In 3rd reference the Government sought detailed report from Commissioner, Endowments for taking over Andhra Jatheeya Kalasala by the Government, where as in 4th reference the District Collector Mentioned that it is in progress, hence furnish the stage of such progress with the details of the authority who initiated the process with relevant rule position and*
- 7. Any other relevant information to take a decision on the above said proposal.*

As a part of its curriculum, the Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad, at the time of its inception, introduced various courses in ancient Indian fine arts like Shilpa Sastra (Sculpture), Vasthu Sastra, Chitra Lekhana (Drawing) and Weaving. Further, the Institution had passed through a tumultuous regime during the peak freedom movement and had its complete revival with the change in Educational System in the post-Independence era as such the ancient Indian fine art courses were closed due to lack of proper support from the affiliating authorities.

The Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad is imparting education through the following subsidiary educational institutions (Private) under the provisions of A.P. Education Act, 1982 prior to the taking over the administration by the Endowments Department:

- 1) The A.J. Kalasala offered U.G. Courses since 07.06.1949. Subsequently, Intermediate (Senior Secondary) Education was introduced on 14.06.1969. The Government of Andhra Pradesh extended grant-in-aid for AJ Kalasala (Composite College) from 1964. (At present it is under un-aided category)
- 2) The AJK Oriental Secondary School was started in 1959 to impart School Education (6th to 10th class) with Sanskrit as one of the main subjects. The AJK Oriental Secondary School was started in 1959 to impart School Education (6th to 10th class) with Sanskrit as one of the main subjects. The Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad established A.J.K. Oriental Secondary School in 1959 to impart education-literacy with history and philosophy of our nation with a mix of knowledge from the Vedas and modern education as the Vedas are considered to be the oldest form of literature in Sanskrit and it is a language of ancient India with a history going back about 3,500 years with primary liturgical language of Hinduism and the predominant language of most works of Hindu philosophy as well as some of the principal texts of Buddhism and Jainism which was migrated to Southeast Asia,

parts of East Asia and Central Asia, emerging as a language of high culture and of local ruling elites in these regions and it is traceable to the 2nd millennium BCE in a form known as the Vedic Sanskrit, with the Rigveda as the earliest known composition, though it not necessarily Classical Sanskrit, is the root language of many Prakrit languages such as Hindi, Marathi, Bengali, Punjabi and Nepali. As such, the school curriculum is primarily aimed at promoting Sanskrit language and it is included as main subject for 8th to 10th class curriculum in place of Social Studies and was extended grant-in-aid from 1975 by the Government of Andhra Pradesh and still it is in existence as aided school.

- 3) The AJ College of Education was started to offer Teacher Education course (B.Ed) in 1967 and was extended grant-in-aid from 1977.
- 4) The Engineering workshop offered industrial training courses from 1907 and it was re-designed as Industrial Training Institute (ITI) from 1951.

Further the Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad was published under section 6 (b) (1) of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious and Endowments Act, 1966 (Act 17 of 1966) duly registered U/s 38 of the Act 17 of 1966. In 1979, the Government issued instructions to the Commissioner, Endowments Department to enquire and submit a report on the affairs of the management. After due consideration of the representation made by the Secretary of Parishad for exempting the Institution U/s. 108 of the Act 17 of 1966, the Government requested the commissioner to constitute a trust board and to appoint an Executive officer for its management.

The Secretary of the Institution filed a review petition dated 12-07-80 to Government U/S. 84 of the AP Act 17 of 1966. There upon, the revisional authority suspended the operation of sections 15 & 27 of the Act, pending final disposal of the said review petition (Govt. Memo. No. 1920/E.I/801, dt; 17-07-1980) and later vacated the order of suspension vide Memo. No. 1920/E.I/80-2, dated 3-9-1980 by rejecting the Review Petition.

There upon, the Managing Trustee/Secretary of the Institution filed a W.P. No. 4534/80 on the file of Hon'ble High Court of Andhra

Pradesh and obtained injunction in W.P.M.P. No. 7020/80 restraining the Government from giving effect to the Orders issued by the Commissioner vide D.Dis No. G4/45363/80, Dt: 10.09.1980 appointing the E.O. to the institution. Subsequently, the Writ Petition was dismissed and also Writ Appeal vide W.A. No. 427 of 1981 was dismissed on 01.12.1986. The Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh was pleased to dismiss the writ petition and its appeal, confirming that the Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad was established for charitable purpose to impart education as defined in Clause (5) of section 2 of the Act 17 of 1966.

Meanwhile, Sri K. Koteswara Rao, Editor, Telugu Vidyarthi (Monthly Publication) and Member of Legislative Council, Machilipatnam had submitted a representation to the Government (Letter dated 19-5-1987) requesting to take over the management by the Government to facilitate the development of the historic institution in accordance with the objects for which the institution was founded. In spite of dismissal of the writ petition and writ appeal filed by the Private management of subject institution against the registration under the Act 17 of 1966 to take over the management of Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad by the Endowments Department, upon the request of Sri K. Koteswara Rao, Editor, Telugu Vidyarthi (Monthly Publication), the Government constituted a committee with four persons as members viz., 1) Sri K. Koteswara Rao, 2) Sri G.J.V. Jagannadh Raju, VC, Nagarjuna University 3) Sri Jaffer Nizam representative of Commissionerate of Higher Education and 4) District Collector, Krishna under the convenorship of Commissioner, Endowments to examine and submit a comprehensive report on the following points along with the Committee's recommendations dated 28.05.87.

1. Verification of the Extent of land and Physical infrastructure owned by the Institution.
2. The existing institutional framework and financial resources with reference to the objectives.
3. Identification of new courses, consistent with the changing times.
4. The method and extent of affiliation and associations between the various universities in the State add this Instruction.

5. The pattern of administrative and technical control of this institution vis-à-vis the provisions of the Hindu religious and charitable Endowment Act.
6. The new educational requirements, which this institution can serve in the context of modern science, technology and Human Resources Development

Meanwhile, pursuant to the dismissal of the Writ Appeal No. 427 of 1981 filed by the private management, the Commissioner, Endowments Department appointed the Executive Officer on 20.02.1988.

The Committee constituted under G.O.Ms. No. 531 Revenue (Endts.IV) Department dated 28.05.1987 has made a comprehensive study of the various issues referred to them and submitted its report through Commissioner, Endowments to Government on 28.03.1988 & 02.05.1990. In turn the Government has carefully studied the reports of the Committee and the recommendations made therein and felt that there is a need for restructuring this institution without prejudice to the original objectives with a view to achieve larger objectives consistent with the modern educational and cultural requirements. As such the Government issued orders on the recommendations of the Committee to restructure this institution without prejudice to the original objectives with a view to achieve larger objectives consistently modern educational and cultural requirements and to revitalize the institution and accorded permission to the Commissioner, Endowments to explore the possibilities of getting financial assistance under the different schemes of the State Government and the Government of India and send if necessary, specific proposals to the Government through G.O.Ms. No. 655, Rev (End. IV), dt: 11.07.1990 vide reference 3rd cited. It is relevant to submit here that the said G.O holds good till date. Further, by virtue of recommendation 11 of G.O.Ms.No.655, Revenue (Endts. IV) Dept., dt.11.07.1990 the Commissioner of Endowments Dept., is requested to explore the possibilities of getting financial assistance under the different schemes of the State Government and the Government of India and send if necessary, specific proposals to the Government. At the same time, the institution must be able to mobilize its own resources coupled with grants being received in a very profitable and useful way.

At present The Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad is imparting education through the following subsidiary educational institutions in a composite campus with common playground and common auditorium:

In the light of the above said facts and circumstances coupled with the orders of the Hon'ble High Court passed in W.P.No.4534 of 1980 and its Writ Appeal No.427 of 1981, the subject-Institution 's covered as a "charitable institution" to impart education through its subsidiary institutions as per provisions of Section 2(4) of the AP Act 30 of 1987, and as per Section 14 of AP Act 30 of 1987, all the properties belonging to, or given or endowed to a subject-institution shall, vest in the institution.

Further I have gone through the correspondence vide references cited which were circulated to me by you and it is noticed that there is discrepancy of the instructions issued by the Government of AP, and Commissioner of Endowments that the Government of AP, sought detailed report from the Commissioner Endowments for taking over of Andhra Jatheeya Kalasala, Machilipatnam considering the status report submitted by the District Collector- Krishna where as the Commissioner's office and your office mentioned that taking over of Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad, Machilipatnam by the Government of AP. Further you are aware that Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad and Andhra Jatheeya

Kalasala are two different institutions with separate legal entities. Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad is a Private Charitable Institution under the administrative control of Endowments department where as the Andhra Jatheeya Kalasala is a private un-aided subsidiary educational institution of Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad, imparting higher education (Intermediate, UG & PG courses) as like other subsidiary educational institutions of Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad.

As the Government of AP has already reviewed the status of the Institution and restructured this institution without prejudice to the original objectives with a view to achieve larger objectives consistently modern educational and cultural requirements and accorded permission to the Commissioner, Endowments to explore the possibilities of getting financial assistance under the different schemes of the State Government and the Government of India through G.O.Ms. No. 655, Rev (End. IV), dt: 11.07.1990 without disturbing its entity, you are requested to examine the connected records and relevant material in respect of the establishment, continuance and present status of Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad and its subsidiary educational institutions in consonance with its founding objectives, and clarify the following queries and circulate the file with all relevant material and the substantial material mentioned in the above queries through your detailed report to offer my opinion on the above subject matter as sought by you.

1. The circumstances led to consider the proposal by the Government to take over Andhra Jatheeya Kalasala (Private Institution) which is under the management of Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad as there is no specific reason to take a decision on taking over of Andhra Jatheeya Kalasala as Hon'ble Chief Minister's assurance in Krishna District.
2. Circulate the note of District Collector – Krishna Dt. 17/10/2024 which was mentioned as the reference in Government memo dated 20.10.2024.
3. Specify whether the Government is intended to taking over the administration of Andhra Jatheeya Kalasala or the Andhra Jatheeya

Vidya Parishad with the ideology of Government to take such step against these organizations alone in Krishna District.

4. Circulate the relevant rule position to protect the entity of a charitable institution and/or the established procedure to take over of Private charitable institution which is under the administration control of Endowments Department by the Government of AP, if any.
5. The Connected material which is root cause for the formulating such proposal by the Government to take over Andhra Jatheeya Kalasala.
6. In 3rd reference the Government sought detailed report from Commissioner, Endowments for taking over Andhra Jatheeya kalasala by the Government, where as in 4th reference the District Collector Mentioned that it is in progress, Hence furnish the stage of such progress with the details of the authority who initiated the process with relevant rule position and
7. Any other relevant information to take a decision on the above said proposal.

Memorandum of Association

:o:

In the matter of Act XXI of 1860 of the Acts of the Viceroy and Governor-general of India in Council, being an Act for the registration of Literary, Scientific and Charitable societies and in the matter of The Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad (the Andhra National Council of Education),

1. The name of the Association is The Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad.

2. The objects of the Association are:—

- a. To impart and promote the imparting of Education Literary, Scientific, Technical and Professional on national lines and exclusively under National Control—not in opposition to, but standing apart from, the existing system of Primary, Secondary and Collegiate Education—attaching special importance to a knowledge of the country, its Literature, History and Philosophy, and designed to incorporate with the best Oriental Ideals of life and thought the best assimilable ideals of the west and to inspire students with a genuine love for their country and a real desire to serve it.
- b. To promote and encourage the study chiefly of such branches of the Arts, Sciences, Industries, and Commerce as are best calculated to develop the material resources of the country and to satisfy its pressing wants, including in scientific Education generally a knowledge of the scientific truths embodied in Oriental Learning and in Medical Education specially, a knowledge of such scientific truths as are to be found in the Ayurvedic and Hakimi systems.

- c. To promote physical and moral Education.
- d. To provide for religious education. Such Education, however, is not to include the enforcement of religious rites and practices. It is to be presumed that the members of the different religious bodies desire that their wards should receive religious education in their respective creeds unless the guardians of such wards express a contrary intension.
- e. To enforce strict discipline in accordance with the best traditions of the country.
- f. To impart and to facilitate the imparting of Education ordinarily through the medium of the vernacular language.
- g. To establish at Masulipatam and elsewhere in the Andhra country Schools, Primary and Secondary, as well as Colleges, and other educational institutions for the imparting of Education as aforesaid,
- h. To affiliate, admit, recognize or otherwise utilise schools, Colleges and other educational and research institutions for the imparting of education as aforesaid,
- i. To prepare and encourage the preparation of suitable text books especially in the vernaculars in Arts, sciences and Technical and professional subjects.
- j. To found and maintain professorships, lectureships, scholarships and fellowships for the encouragement of learning and research,
- k. To create and maintain a high standard of qualification, intellectual as well as moral in teachers by providing where necessary advanced instruction in all subjects included in a liberal education, by supplying a training in the principles and practice of Educational methods

- and by instituting examinations for testing such qualifications and granting certificates to successful candidates.
- l. To establish and maintain and affiliate, admit or recognize hospitals, workshops, laboratories, libraries, and museums, art-galleries and other institutions conducive to the objects of the Association,
 - m. To establish, maintain and control suitable boarding-houses and residences for students prosecuting their studies in institutions connected with the Association,
 - n. To provide for examination of students prosecuting their studies in institutions connected with the association, to award certificates to successful students, to award prizes, stipends and scholarships for enabling them to prosecute further studies either in institutions connected with the Association or other educational institutions in India or elsewhere,
 - o. To confer titles, diplomas and other marks of honor on any person who by reason of eminent position and attainments may be deemed a fit and proper person to receive the same and to grant certificates and diplomas, confer degrees, titles, distinctions and other marks of honor on students who pass the requisite tests,
 - p. To print and publish any journals, periodicals books, or leaflets that the Association may think desirable for the promotion of its objects,
 - q. To carry on any other work which may seem to the Association capable of being conveniently carried on in connection with the above or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render profitable any of the Association's property or rights,
 - r. To purchase, take on lease or in exchange, hire or otherwise acquire property moveable or immoveable

and any rights or privileges which may be deemed necessary or convenient for the purpose of the Association and in particular any lands, buildings, and easements and to improve, develop, manage, sell, lease, mortgage, dispose of, turn to account or otherwise deal with all or part of the property of the Association.

- s. To construct, maintain and alter any houses, buildings or works necessary or convenient for the purpose of the Association.
- t. To take any gift or property whether subject to any special trust or condition or not for any one or more of the objects of the Association.
- u. To take such steps by personal or written appeals, public meetings or otherwise as may from time to time be deemed expedient, for the purpose of procuring contributions to the funds of the Association in the shape of donations, annual subscriptions or otherwise.
- v. For the purpose of the association to borrow and raise money.
- w. To invest the moneys of the association not immediately required upon such securities and in such manner as the association may think fit.
- x. To undertake and execute any trusts other than religious or any agency business which may seem directly or indirectly conducive to any of the objects of the Association gratuitously or otherwise.
- y. For the purposes of the Association to make, accept, endorse, and execute promissory notes, bills of exchange and other negotiable instruments.
- z. To incorporate any institutions, societies or associations having objects wholly or in part similar to those of the association.

5. The Association shall have the following objects:
- aa. To procure the affiliation of one or more of the institutions of the Parishad to any other institution, society or association, having objects similar to those of its own.
 - bb. To provide a superannuation fund for the professors, lecturers, officers and servants of the Association or otherwise assist them, and their families.
 - cc. To do all or any of the above things either as principals agents, trustees or otherwise and by or through trustees, agents or otherwise, and either alone or in conjunction with others.
 - dd. To do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects or any of them.

3. The names, addresses and occupation of the persons who are members of and form the Governing Body of the Association are:—

4. The income and property of the Association whencesoever derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Association as set forth in the Memorandum and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus, remuneration or otherwise howsoever by way of profit to any of the members of the Association in respect of any services performed by them as members of the Association, provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment in good faith of remuneration to any officers or servants of the Association notwithstanding they may also be members thereof, in return for any work done or services rendered to the Association, as such officers or servants, nor prevent the payment of interest on monies borrowed from any member of the Association.

5. No trustee or trustees of the Association shall be answerable for any loss arising in the administration or application of

the properties of the Association or for any damage to or deterioration in the trust properties unless such loss, damages or deterioration shall happen by or through his or their neglect or default.

A copy of the rules and regulations of the said Parishad filed with this Memorandum of Association and the undersigned being members of the Governing Body of the Association do hereby certify that such copy of such rules and regulations of the said Parishad is correct.

Rules.

relating to the Constitution and
management of the Association named
The Andhra Jatheeya Vidya Parishad.

CONSTITUTION.

1. The association or arishad shall consist of:-

- 1, Ordinary members,
2. Life-members and
3. Patron members.

2. Any person who has given a contribution of not less than Rs. 100 or its equivalent to the Funds of the Parishad becomes an ordinary Member thereof on his expressing sympathy in writing with the objects of the Parishad.

3. Any person who has given a contribution of not less than Rs. 1000 or its equivalent to the Parishad becomes a Patron-member of the Parishad on his expressing sympathy in writing with the objects of the Parishad.

4. Any person who promises to work for the Parishad for at least fifteen years, and being previously nominated by the Board of Life members, is approved of by the Governing body becomes a 'Life member' thereof.

Note:— Life members who complete their term of service and retire will continue to enjoy all the privileges of the 'Ordinary Members' of the Parishad.

- Messrs. 1. K. Hanumantha Row,
2. K. Sitarama Row
3. P. Palnivelu
and 4. C. Srinivasa Row

5. Every Ordinary Member and Patron-member of the Parishad shall have the right of (1) visiting and inspecting the institutions of the Parishad and also of recording any suggestions he may have to offer in the visitors' book and (2) electing Members to the Council of the Parishad.

6. The Parishad shall have the right of

1. electing as a member of the Parishad without payment any person who, in its opinion, is especially fit to advise in matters Educational,
2. Obtaining the affiliation of one or more of the institutions to any other association or body having objects similar to its own.
3. removing any member from the council on the recommendation of the latter at a meeting of the council duly held for the purpose.

The Parishad shall meet at least once a year. The quorum shall be twenty of whom not less than five shall be other than members of the Council. It shall appoint its own secretary for a period of three years and frame its own byelaws for the conduct of its meetings.

MANAGEMENT.

7. The affairs of the Parishad shall be managed by the following four bodies in accordance with the rules hereinafter contained.

1. The council,
2. The Governing body,
3. The Board of Life members,
- and 4. the Board of trustees,

1, THE COUNCIL

8. The Council shall consist of a minimum of 16 members. The Elected members of the council shall ordinarily hold office

for three years. At or about the end of this period or whenever a vacancy arises the secretary of the council shall take steps to see that a fresh election promptly takes place.

9. The council shall be composed of two classes of members.

(i) all the life-members of the Parishad

(ii) and those elected by the ordinary members and patron-members of the Parishad as follows:—

1. The minimum number shall not be increased so long as the number of life-members does not exceed 8 and when the latter exceeds 8, there shall be one additional non life-member-councillor to each additional life-member.

2. When the number of life- member- councillors is less than eight, on the addition of every new life-member, one non life-member-councillor shall go out of office by ballot amongst this class of councillors,

3. Each bye-election to the Council of a non life-member that may be necessitated by death, removal or resignation or by the addition of a life- member shall be made by the remaining non life-member-Councillors for the unexpired term only.

10. The members of the Council shall be entitled to the use of the libraries, laboratories, museums &c of the Parishad and to all other privileges in accordance with the bye-laws in that behalf to be framed from time to time by the Governing body subject to the sanction of the Council.

11. The Council shall have the right to

1 sanction any appropriation of permanent funds to current purposes on the recommendation of the Governing Body.

2 start, affiliate, admit, recognize, or disaffiliate and withdraw the privileges of admission and recognition from schools and Colleges.

- 3 institute and confer degrees, titles and other marks of honor,
- 4 appoint Faculties, and Boards of studies,
- 5 call a general meeting of the Parishad
- 6 publish the auditor's report and balance-sheet,
- 7 appoint an auditor or auditors for the audit of the accounts,
- 8 dismiss any life-member on the recommendation of the Governing body.
- 9 recommend to the Parishad the removal of any member of the Council by the vote of three-fourths of the total strength of the Council at a meeting specially called for the purpose.
- 10 insure when funds permit the lives of and provide pension for the life-members.
- 11 remove a trustee from his office on account of physical disability or a criminal conviction for any offence for holding the office which in the opinion of the Council disqualifies him.

12 The Council shall meet at least twice a year. The quorum shall be half the total strength and not less than 3 out of the quorum shall be other than life-members or members of the Governing Body. It shall frame its own bye-laws for the conduct of its meetings.

2. THE GOVERNING BODY.

13 The Governing body shall consist of 7 members, of whom not more than three shall be life-members elected by the Board of life-members. The remaining shall be elected by the non-life-member-councillors from amongst themselves. The members of the Governing body shall ordinarily hold office for 3 years and at about the end of this period or whenever a vacancy arises, the

secretary of the body shall take steps to see that a fresh election promptly takes place.

14 Any member of the Governing Body who absents himself from the meetings of the Body on three successive occasions or for a period of 2 months during which three or more meetings are held shall be deemed to have vacated his seat in the Governing body, but shall be eligible for re-election.

15 Any vacancy resulting from death, resignation, non-attendance or retirement of a member of this body shall be filled for the unexpired term only.

16 The Governing body shall arrange for;—

A 1. (a) the inspection of schools and colleges, (b) examination and (c) teaching, according to regulations passed by the Council.

2, the selection of text books, the institution of courses of lectures, the opening of libraries, laboratories, museums &c, and the appointment of Professors, Inspectors, Lecturers, Tutors, Research workers, Demonstrators, Fellows and Scholars according to the recommendation of the Board of life-members,

3, the leasing of property for not more than 5 years.

4, the acceptance of endowments

5. Exemption from existing rules and regulations and

6. the maintenance of proper accounts,

B. As regards the following matters, the Governing body shall have the power to submit their recommendations and opinions to the Council.

1. Affiliation, admission and recognition or disaffiliation of schools and colleges,

2, disposal of property and purchase of property,

3, institution and conferring of Degrees.

17. The Governing Body shall have power to make rules regarding the internal management of the Parishad's institutions, the fixing and levying of school fees, the grant of scholarships and the boarding and lodging of students. All such rules shall come into force immediately, but are subject to revision by the council.

18. The Governing body shall engage all such officers and servants as they may consider necessary and shall regulate their duties and fix their salaries, award punishments, direct transfers, and grant leave.

19. The Governing body shall:—

- i receive and collect all subscriptions and donations, and may expend or invest the same for the purposes of the Parishad, otherwise than by purchase of property, all investments being made in the names of the trustees
- ii pass the annual Budget prepared by the Board of life members or modify the same as they may think fit.

20. No legal proceedings shall be taken on behalf of the Parishad except with the sanction of the Governing Body. The Governing body shall have full control over the conduct of all legal proceedings by and against the Parishad.

21. The council shall nominate one of the members of the governing body as secretary of the council and the governing body, and the secretary shall exercise such powers as may be conferred upon him by the regulations of the council and the governing body.

22. The governing body shall meet not less than once every month, the quorum being five. It shall pass its own bye-laws for the conduct of its meetings.

23. All questions coming up at the meetings of the several bodies connected with the parishad shall be decided by a majority of votes of members present except as herein otherwise provided for, and in case of equality of votes, the president of the meeting have a second or casting vote.

24. In all bye-elections to the Council or the Governing body, the voters shall have the privilege of sending their votes in writing duly signed by them to the Council. When however no votes are received at a bye-election the vacancy shall be filled by nomination to be made by the remaining members.

25 When at the end of 3 years no general election takes place for any reason the preexisting body shall continue in office until a fresh election takes place and the secretary shall convene two successive meetings at intervals of not more than a month to cause fresh election to take place. If, in spite of these attempts; no election takes place in accordance with the rules, the members present at the 3rd meeting shall conduct the elections without regard to quorum.

3. BOARD OF LIFE-MEMBERS

26 All the Life members for the time being shall constitute the Board of Life-members,

The Board of Life-members

- 1 shall propose and submit for the sanction of the governing body the annual Budget for each of the Parishad's institutions.
 - 2 the Board of life-members shall give effect to the year's budget
 - 3 the Board of life-members shall propose for the sanction of the governing body the names of persons to be elected as life-members,
 - 4 it shall present to the governing body for approval a list of text books to be adopted and any change in them or in the course of instruction.
 - 5 it shall prepare for approval by the governing body annual report of the preceding official year,
- 27 The Board shall frame its own bye-laws for the conduct of its meetings,

28 No person can become a life-member of the Parishad unless his name has been proposed and seconded at a meeting of the Board of life-members and unless he be elected by the votes of $\frac{3}{4}$ of the total number in the Board, and unless after such election he signs an undertaking to work according to the rules and bye-laws in force for the time being.

4. TRUSTEES.

29. There shall be two trustees.

The present trustees are Messrs, Kcpalle Hanumantha. Row, M. A., B. L., and Vadlamannati Narasimham, B. A., B. L.,

30. Whenever a vacancy occurs in the office of the trustees it shall be filled forthwith by the council.

31. All immoveable property, stocks, funds, shares and other securities, the property of the Parishad, shall be vested in the trustees for the time being, but shall be subject to the control of the council and no part of such property of the Parishad shall be sold, assigned, transferred, or otherwise dealt with, by the Trustees without the authority of the council.

32. All legal proceedings by or against the parishad shall be conducted by and in the name of the trustees.

33. Permanent Funds or property of the Parishad shall include

i all money grants made by the public, the Government, or the local boards with the object of being invested at interest or being applied to the purchase of articles for the use of the Parishad or to the permanent payment of the salaries of teachers, scholarships, or prizes in the institutions of the Parishad,

ii such other sums or property as the Governing body makes over to the Council as permanent Fund.

34. Current Funds shall include,

i proceeds of fees and fines received from students.

- 35 Permanent Funds except by the special sanction of the council shall be reserved for the following purposes:—

- ACCOUNT AND AUDIT.

The Parishad shall have a common seal of such make and design as the Governing body shall determine.

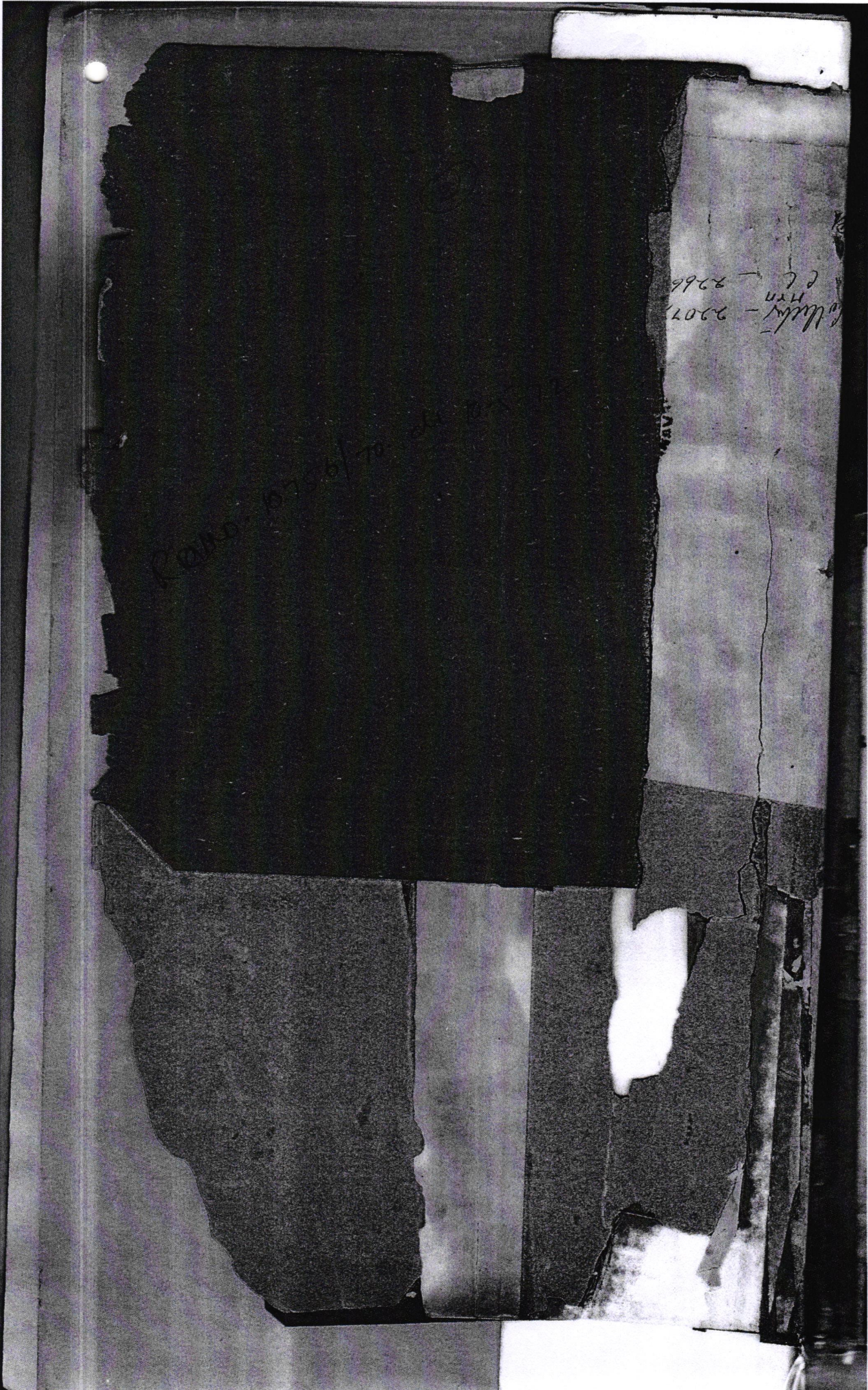

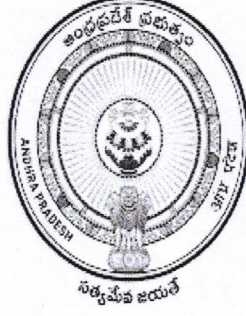

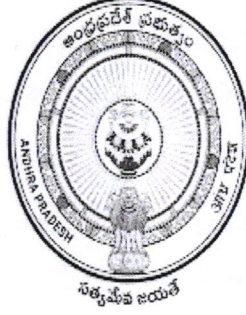

ORDER:

Government have reviewed the present status of the Andhra Jateeya Vidya Parishad, Machilipatnam, Krishna district, It was felt that there was a need for restructuring this institution without prejudice to the original objectives with a view to achieve larger objectives consistent with the modern educational and cultural requirements. It was also felt that this institution could be developed *inter alia* for the benefit of women by introducing vocational courses and training facilities in the context of 30% reservation for women in the jobs.

While making coordinated efforts to revitalize this institution, the following factors should be kept in view:-

- I. the name of the institution should remain as Sri Jatiya Vidya Parishad.
- II. the original ideals and standards of performance of this institution should be restored;

Sri K.Hanumantha Rao has filed this application seeking for recognising him as Founders Family Member for the purpose of managing the institution as their family were in management since several years. Sri Andhra Jaathiya Vidya Parishad, Rajupet of Machilipatnam town, Krishna District was published under section 6(b)(1) of the Act 30/87 and it is under the administrative control of the Commissioner, Endowments Department, Hyderabad and it is being managed by an Executive Officer in the capacity of Correspondent.

The Government of Andhra Pradesh appointed a Commission with Sri Challa Kondalah, Retired Chief Justice of Andhra Pradesh High Court as Chairman. The Committee suggested for abolition of Hereditary Trusteeship. The Government of Andhra Pradesh accepted the Commission's report under section 16 of A.P.C. and H.R.I and Endowments Act 30/87 and the rights of the persons for the office of the Hereditary Trusteeship were abolished on such commencement of Act. Aggrieved by this some of the Hereditary Trustees questioned the validity of the action of the Government in abolishing the Hereditary Trustee rights. The Supreme Court of India, New Delhi after hearing both sides their lordship upheld the validity of sections 15, 16, 17, 29(5) and 144 of the Endowments Act 30/87 subject to the rider that the Trust Board to be constituted under the provisions of the Act should be headed by the Founder or any of his family member for the purpose of management of the institution.

The petitioner filed the following documents as evidence in support of his contention that he is a Founders Family Member.

The said documents have been perused and examined, seen from the approved property register, under column No. 4 the said institution was founded by Sri Kopalla Hanumantha Rao Panthulu garu.

The institution was registered in the year 1972 in R.Dis. No.10756/70 Dt.10.5.1972 by the Assistant Commissioner, Endowments Department, Machilipatnam.

Sub Section 4(b) of section 43 speaks about the mention of the name of the Founder and names of past and present Trustees. Since the right of Hereditary Trustees were abolished under section 16 of the Act which was upheld by the Supreme Court of India, recognition of the Founder or Founders Family Members for management of the temple is now arisen. Hence the above application is now filed.

As seen from the approved property register, Documents, Geneological Tree which speaks that Sri Andhra Janthiya Vidya Parishad, Rajupet of Machilipatnam town, Krishna District is founded by Sri Kopalla Hanumantha Rao Panthulu garu and managed the subject institution during his life time and after his demise Kopalla vari family members has associated themselves with the developmental activities of the subject institution and also donated an extent of Ac.15.59 Cts of wet land situated at Mallavolu village by Sri Kopalla Krishna Rao garu for the maintenance of the subject institution.

As per the Geneological tree submitted by this applicant, it appears that this applicant is the decendant of Kopalla vari family, There is no other person claiming recognition except the petitioner from Founders Family.

The recorded evidence proves that Sri Kopalla Hanumantha Rao, the petitioner is a founder family member and in the exercise of the powers vested in him under section 43 of the Act 30/87 and keeping in view of the Judgement of the Supreme Court, New Delhi in C.M.A.No.908, 1359, 1375, of 1987 and transfer case No.169 of 1988 and 60 of 1989 and in pursuance of the Commissioner, Endowments Department, Hyderabad circular instructions in J5/5288/96 Act and Rules Dt.25.3.1996 and Circular No.40/97 in Rc.No.L/36330/97 Dt.4.10.97; The Assistant Commissioner, Endowments Department, Vijayawada is here by recognised Sri Kopalla Hanumantha Rao (Petitioner) as Founders Family Member for the management of the institution and for all other purposes.

The averments of the petitioner is that Sri "Andhra Jathiya Vidya
Parishad, Rajupeta, Machilipatnam was established by One Sn
Kopalle Hanumantha Rao panthulu nearly 5 to 6 decades back The above
said original Founder died Issueless Subsequently the institution was
registered under Section 38 of the Act 17/1966 and proceedings to this
effect was issued in R. Dis No. 10756/70, Dt 10.5.1972 by the Assistant
Commissioner, Endowments Department, Machilipatnam The registration
certificate indicated the name of the Founder and the names of past and
present trustees The institution is an Educational institution. When the
affairs of the institution were not being properly managed the matter was
brought to the notice of the Government The Government in G.O.Ms No
531, Revenue (Endowments-IV) Department, Dt 28.5 1987 constituted (6)
members committee originally That the committee in management under

the Presidentship of Sri G.J.V Jagannadha Raju, Vice Chancellor, Nagarjuna University was asked to submit a report Basing on the report the Government had issued another GO- GO Ms. No.655, Revenue (Endowments-IV) Department, Dt 11.7.1990. As per the said G.O exempting the institution from the provisions under Section 154 of the Act in so far as it relates to constitution of a trust board is concerned recommended a Board to be constituted with two members One from Education Department and another from Technical Education. Two prominent educationists, to be nominated by the Government Two members from Endowments Department One academician of outstanding achievements nominated by the Government as the Chairman of the trust board. Thus, the trust board should be constituted with the above said four members. Under the administrative control of the Commissioner of Endowments The two GOs, issued by the Government are significantly silent with respect to which all the family members of the late Founder were Associated with the institution The members of the Founder's family of late Hanumantha Rao never evinced any interest for several decades in the administration of the institution, that is the reason as to why the Government stepped into the picture into the picture by constituting a Committee for managing the affairs of the institution. That now for the first time one Sri.K.Hanumantha Rao, Styling himself as member of the Founder's family submitting a false genealogical tree filed application for being declared as member of the Founder's family. Thus the 2nd respondent absolutely a bogus claimant, absolute stranger not in any way connected with the Founder's family, filed application requesting the Asst. Commissioner, Vijayawada to declare him as Member of the Founder's family. The said application was taken on file without any notice of enquiry from any quarter, without any intimation to the Governmental organization Judgement has been delivered by the Asst. Commissioner, declaring him as Member of the Founder's family, by ignoring the earlier two G.Os, and the entries in 38 Register and incorrect genealogical tree.

The 2nd respondent in his counter affidavit averred that the Petitioner has no Locus Standi to file the R.P. and is not an aggrieved party.

He is neither a person claiming to be a Member of Founder's family having any similar or rival claim against the 2nd respondent, as such also the RP is not maintainable being filed by a wrong person.

That the Asst Commissioner passed the orders after making fair and detailed enquiry supported by an enquiry made by the inspector. Endowments Department, Machilipatnam There is no irregularity, wrongful exercise of power nor any error of law in passing the impugned orders.

That the facts relating to the origin of the institution, its founding and its administration upto the passing of the two G.Os and thereafter suggest a positive conclusion that all the facts detailed in the petition should be contained in the records of the institution It is surprising as to how the petitioner is able cover so much of Information from the institution. The 2nd respondent exposed to harassment and unnecessary litigation, be harassed is setting up the institution in the way of proper administration.

That the allegation that the affairs were not being properly maintained by the successors of the original founder late Hanumantha Rao, the matter was brought to the notice of the Government for safeguarding the interests of the institution, the Government Issued G.O.No 532. It is incorrect to state that the institution was not properly managed by the successors of the original founder late Hanumantha Rao. The Government has taken good decision to nominate persons of High Caliber keeping in view of the purposes for which the institution was founded originally by Kopalle Hanumantha Rao. Kopalle Hanumantha Rao was himself a legal practitioner who was dedicated so much for the uplift of Education. The successor family members of Late Hanumantha Rao did struggle for achieving the objectives and to do their best for the purpose for which the original institution was founded and it might be that the Government in course of time found that it should be undertaken by a responsible body This should not mean that there was any intention for the Government to replace the management which was intended from the hands of anybody who was already set into that administration.

That the APC & HRI Act 17/1966 and 30/1987 uphold the right of Member from Founder's family. The term "Founder's Family" is not restricted the way in which it was earlier confined only to a successor to the office of the Hereditary trustee but it is an enlarged meaning that any member of the family or families of the founder is also given the right to represent the founder and to become a member trustee of the institution and it is now further clarified that such member is entitled to embrace the seat of the Chairman and become the head of Board of Trustees if a Board of Trustee is constituted as per the orders of Supreme Court and the circular instructions of Commissioner, the Assistant Commissioner conducted a detailed enquiry and declared the 2nd respondent as Member of the Family of the Founder by his order in Ro. No. A2/10564/98, Dt. 26.1.1999

That the Andhra Jateeya Vidya Parishad, Machilipatnam, was founded on 17.11 1907 by Sri Kopalle Hanumantha Rao, which was initially registered under the Societies Registration Act 61 of 1860 on 19.6 1921

That the above said institution was published under Section 6 (b) of the APC & HRI and Endowments Act 17/1865 and was registered Under Section 38 (5) of the Act 17/1966 in R Dis No 10756/70. 01. 10.5.1972 by the Assistant Commissioner, Machilipatnam Sri.Kopalle Hanumantha Rao Pantulu Garu was the Founder and was also the 1st Principal from 1907 to 1922.

The Commissioner, Endowments Department, Hyderabad in Rc.No 04/45363/80-2, D1 10 9 1980 appointed and Executive Officer Aggrieved by the above said orders the then Secretary filed W.P.No.4534/80, which was dismissed A.W.A No. 427/81 was filed which was also dismissed on 1.12 1966. Successive Executive Officers from then onwards continued to hold office.

Heard the arguments of both the Counsels. The main averment's of the Revision Petition is that the Self-styled Founder Trustee Sri.k Hanumantha Rao, is mismanaging the affairs of the Andhra Jatiya Kalasala,

Machilipatnam and there by causing much damage to the institution, being the former student of this college. I am interested in the Welfare of the institution and ultimately requested to set aside the orders of the Asst. Commissioner issued in Rc No. A2/10564/98, Dt 251 1999.

During the course of arguments, it is brought to my notice by the learned Counsel for the Petitioner about the para (4) of page No 2 of the Property Register wherein it is clearly mentioned that there are no hereditary rights vested in any body and late Sri. Kopalle Hanumantha Rao Panthulu, is shown as Honorary member and institution shall be maintained as per the Rules incorporated in memorandum and articles of association. The said Kopalle Hanumantha Rao died issueless. The Assistant Commissioner, Endowments Department, Vijayawada, had recognized son of 7th brother (ie, Kopalle Hanumantha Rao) as Member of the Founder's Family. When there is express provision at Column No. 4 of the Property Register that there are no hereditary rights and Institution shall be maintained as per rules in articles of association and feel that there are no merits in the contention of 2nd respondent. Moreover the said Late K. Hanumantha Rao along with some other members started the institution with certain objects.

It is also brought to my notice that the Executive Officer and Found Trustee have colluded with each other and committed grave irregularities in filling up Six lecturer posts. Basing on the irregularities the Executive Officer and Correspondent of Kalasala was suspended from his official duties. Charges were framed against him and his explanation was called for. Charges were also framed against the Founder Trustee and his explanation is also called for.

The main contention of the 2nd respondent is that the petitioner has no Locus Standi to file this Revision Petition to set aside the orders of the Asst. Commissioner, Vijayawada, since he is not an aggrieved party. I do not agree with the contention because the institution is a public Educational Institution intended for promoting education. Therefore, any person interested in the Welfare of the institution can represent the authorities to

set right the management. Therefore, it is no desirable to continue a person facing disciplinary proceedings as Founder of the Institution.

Accordingly, the proceedings of the Asst. Commissioner, Endowments Department, Vijayawada in Rc.No.A2/10564/98, Dt.26.1.1999 is hereby set-side and the Revision Petition is allowed.

WRIT PETITION NO. 12865 OF 2000.Order:

The petitioner in the instant writ petition prays for issuance of an appropriate writ declaring the impugned order in R.P.No. 53 of 1999 Dt. 27-5-2000 on the file of the third respondent herein as arbitrary, illegal and unconstitutional.

Before advertng to the question as to whether the impugned order suffers from any error as such, it may be necessary to briefly notice the relevant facts:

The petitioner herein filed an application Dt. 23-8-1998 before the fourth respondent herein for recognizing him as founder's family member of Sri Andhra Jaathiya Vidya Parishad, Rajupet, Machilipatnam, which was established by one Kopalle Hanumantha Rao Panthulu nearly about 5 to 6 decades back. The institution is under the administrative control of the Commissioner, Endowments, Hyderabad and is being managed by an Executive Officer in the capacity of Correspondent. It was registered in the year 1972 by the Assistant Commissioner, Endowments, Machilipatnam. The Assistant Commissioner, on the basis of the application and the documents submitted by the petitioner herein came to the conclusion that he is the dependent of Kopallewari family and there is no person claiming recognition, except the petitioner as the founder's family. The Assistant Commissioner

accordingly recognized the petitioner as the founder's family member for the management of the institution and for all other purposes.

It is that order which is impugned by the 5th respondent in a revision petition before the second respondent on various grounds with which we are not concerned for the present in the instant writ petition. Neither counsel made any submission on the merits of the case. It is however, *inter alia* stated ⁱⁿ ~~that~~ the revision petition that the members of the founder's family of late Hanumantha Rao never evinced any interest for several decades in the administration of the institution. It is submitted, for that reason, the Government stepped into the picture by constituting a Committee for managing the affairs of the institution. It is for the first time, the petitioner herein styling himself as member of the Founder's family submitted a false genealogical tree and filed application for being declared as member of the founder's family. It is the case of the fifth respondent that the petitioner herein is a bogus claimant and absolute stranger not in any way connected with the Founder's family, filed application requesting the Assistant Commissioner to declare him as a member of the founder's family. SR

The revisional authority noticed that the institution was initially registered under the Societies Registration Act on 19: 6-1921. The institution was published under Sec.6(b) of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions

and Endowments Act 17 of 1966 and was registered under Sec.38(5) of the Act 17 of 1966 vide proceedings Dt.10-5-1978 by the Assistant Commissioner. The Commissioner, Endowments by an order Dt.10-9-1980 appointed an Executive Officer. Aggrieved by the said order the then Secretary of the institution filed Writ Petition No.4534 of 1980 which was dismissed. A Writ Appeal No.427 of 1981 preferred in the matter was also dismissed on 1-12-1986. The Commission found that the Successive Executive Officers appointed to manage the affairs of the institution continued to hold the office from time to time.

The Commissioner found that late Kopalle Hanumantha Rao died issueless. The Commissioner relied upon para 4 of page No.2 of the property register wherein it is clearly mentioned that there are no hereditary rights vested in any person and late Kopalle Hanumantha Rao Panthulu himself was shown as honorary member of the institution. The institution was required to be maintained as per the rules incorporated in memorandum and articles of association. The Commissioner accordingly came to the conclusion that the petitioner herein cannot be recognized as a member of the founder's family.

The Commissioner also noticed that the Executive Officer and the petitioner colluded with each other and committed irregularities in filling up six lecturer posts. The Executive Officer and correspondent of Kalashala was

suspended from his official duties. Charges were framed against him and his explanation was called for. Charges were also framed against the Founder Trustee and his explanation is also called for. It is under those circumstances, the Commissioner in the interest of the welfare of the institution declared that it is not desirable to continue the petitioner as the founder of the institution and accordingly set aside the order passed by the Assistant Commissioner.

In this writ petition, learned counsel for the petitioner Sri V.S.R. Anjaneyulu makes only one submission by contending that the Commissioner has no jurisdiction to entertain the revision against an order passed by the Assistant Commissioner recognizing the petitioner as member of the founder's family. This Court after an elaborate consideration in Writ Petition No. 3450 of 2000 came to the conclusion that the revision against an order passed by the Assistant Commissioner recognizing a person as a member of the founder's family is maintainable under Sec. 92 of the Act. Following the said decision, the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner is rejected.

In the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition certain malafides are attributed to the second respondent. But they are not pressed during the course of hearing of this writ petition. No other submission is made by the learned counsel for the petitioner impugning the validity of the order.

This order was framed not on merits.

For the aforesaid reasons, I do not find any merit in this writ petition and the same shall stand accordingly dismissed.

No order as to costs.

The appellant herein begs to prefer the Memorandum of Writ Appeal against the Order of the learned Single Judge in W.P.No.12865/2000 dated 7-9-2000, on the following among other:

G R O U N D S

1. The order of the learned single Judge is contrary to law and facts and circumstances of the case.
2. The learned Judge erred in dismissing the Writ Petition without considering the contentions urged in the Writ Petition and very heavily relying upon the counter affidavit of the private respondent. The learned Judge imported all the contentions from the counter affidavit of the private respondent (5th respondent) in the order and misread the impugned order in the writ petition.
3. The learned Judge erred in observing that no other submission is made by the learned Counsel for the petitioner impugning the validity of the order. In fact the learned Counsel argued all the contentions raised in the Writ Petition but the learned single Judge failed to take note of the same.
4. The learned single Judge failed to see that apart from jurisdictional issue, the impugned order in the Writ Petition suffers from more than one defect.
5. The learned single Judge ought to have seen that the impugned order is contrary to the law laid down by the Supreme Court in AIR 1996 SC 1023.

3. That the Asstt. Commissioner, passed the orders after making fair and detailed enquiry supported by an enquiry made by the Inspector, Endowments Department, Machilipatnam. There is no irregularity, wrongful exercise of power nor any error of law in passing the impugned order.

4. That the facts relating to the origin of the institution, its founding and its administration upto the passing of the two G.Os. and there after suggest a positive conclusion that all the facts detailed in the petition should be contained in the records of the institution. It is surprising as to how the petitioner is able to cover so much of information from the institution. The 2nd respondent exposed to harassment and unnecessary litigation, because he is setting up the institution in the way of proper administration.

5. That the allegation that the affairs were not being properly maintained by the successors of the original founder late Hanumantha Rao, the matter was brought to the notice of the Government for safeguarding the interest of the institution the Government issued G.O.No.531. it is incorrect to state that the institution was not properly managed by the successors of the original founder late Hanumantha Rao. The Government has taken a good decision to nominate persons of High caliber keeping in view of the purposes for which the original institution was founded and it might be that the Government in course of time found that it should be undertaken by a responsible body. This should not mean that there was any intention for the Government to replace the management which

109

was intended from the hands of any body who was already set into that administration.

6. That the A.P. C& HRT Act 17/1966 and 30/1987 uphold the right of member from Founder's family. The term "Founder's family" is not restricted the way in which it was earlier confined only to a successor to the office of the Hereditary Trustee but it is an enlarged meaning that any member of the family or families of the founder is also given the right to represent the founder and to become a member trustee of the institution and it is now further clarified that such member is entitled to embrace the seat of the Chairman and become the head of Board of Trustees if a Board of Trustee is constituted. As per the orders of Supreme Court and the circular instructions of Commissioner, the Assistant Commissioner conducted a detailed enquiry and declared the 2nd respondent as Member of the Family of the founder by his order in Rc.No.A2/10564 dt.26.1.1999.

7. That the Andhra Jatiya Vidya Parishad, Machilipatnam, was founded on 17-11-1907 by Sri Kopalle Hanumantha Rao, which was initially registered under the Societies Registration Act 61 of 1860 on 19.6.1921.

8. That the above said institution was published under Section 6(b) of the A.P.C.&H.R.T and Endowments Act 17/1966 and was registered under Section 38 (5) of the Act 17/1966 in R.Dis.No.10756/70 dt.10.5.1978 by the Asstt.Commissioner, Machilipatnam. Sri Kopalle Hanumantha Rao, Panthulu Garu was the founder and was also the 1st Principal from 1907 to 1922.

9. The Commissioner, Endowments Department, Hyderabad in
Re.No.G4/45363/80-8, dt.10.9.1980 appointed a Executive Officer. Aggrieved
by the above said orders the then Secretary filed W.P.No.4534/80, which was
dismissed. A W.A.No.427/81 was filed which was also dismissed on 1.12.1986.
Successive Executive Officers from then onwards continued to hold office.

10. Heard the arguments of both the Counsels. The main averments of the
Revisions Petition is that the Self Style Founder Trustee Shri K.Hanumantha Rao,
is mis- managing the affairs of the Andhra Jatiya Kalashala, Machilipatnam and
thereby causing much damage to the institution being the former student of this
college. I am interested in the welfare of the institution and ultimately requested
to set aside the orders of the Asstt.Commissioner issued in Re.No.A2/10564/98
dt.26.1.1999. During the course of arguments it is brought to my notice by the
learned counsel for the petitioner about the para (4) of Page No.2 of the property
register tax wherein it is clearly mentioned that there are no hereditary rights
vested in any body and late sri Kopalle Hanumantha Rao Panthulu, is shown as
Honorary member and institution shall be maintained as per the rules
incorporated in memorandum and articles of association. The said Kopalle
Hanumantha Rao died issueless. The Assistant Commissioner, Endowments
Department, Vijayawada, had recognised son of 7th brother (i.e., Kopalle
Hanumantha Rao) as member of the Founder's family. When there is express
provision at column No.4 of the property register that there are no hereditary rights
and institution shall be maintained as per rules in articles of association and feel

judgment, as to what transpired in Court. We cannot allow the statement of the Judges to be contradicted by statements at the Bar or by affidavit and other evidence. If the Judges say in their judgment that something was done, said or admitted before them, that has to be the last word on the subject. The principle is well-settled that statements of fact as to what transpired at the hearing, recorded in the judgment of the court, are conclusive of the facts so stated and no one can contradict such statements by affidavit or other evidence. If a party thinks that the happenings in court have been wrongly recorded in a judgment, it is incumbent upon the party, while the matter is still fresh in the minds of the Judges, to call the attention of the very Judges who have made the record to the fact that the statement made with regard to his conduct was a statement that had been made in error [(per Lord Buckmaster in *Madhusudan v. Chandrabati* (AIR 1917 PC 30))]. That is the only way to have the record corrected. If no such step is taken, the matter must necessarily end there. Of course a party may resile and an Appellate Court may permit him in rare and appropriate cases to resile from a concession on the ground that the concession was made on a wrong appreciation of the law and had led to gross injustice; but he may not call in question the very fact of making the concession as recorded in the judgment."

In the order impugned in the writ appeal, the learned single Judge has stated that the learned counsel who argued the case on behalf of the petitioner has made only one contention that the Commissioner has no jurisdiction to entertain the revision against the order passed by the Assistant Commissioner recognizing the petitioner as member of the founder's family. That argument was met by the learned Judge and the same was rejected for the reasons set out by the learned single Judge in W.P. No.3540 of 2000. If the petitioner's counsel had, in fact, urged certain other grounds as claimed by him

now and the learned Judge has not considered the same, the only course open to the appellant/petitioner is to go before the same learned Judge and seek consideration of the other contentions by way of Review. In that view of the matter, we dismiss the writ appeal, however, reserving liberty to the appellant/ petitioner to seek review of the order of the learned single Judge. No costs.
