I, K.Nagaraja, S/o. K.Sreenivasulu, Aged about 52 years, Occ; Business, R/o. 13-6-600/44/157, PK Layout, Tirupati, Chittoor-517501, Andhra Pradesh, having temporarily come down to Vijayawada, do hereby solemnly affirm and sincerely state as follows:

1. I and the Partner of the Petitioner Proprietorship and hence I know the facts of the case. The contents of this Affidavit and documents annexed are translated and explained to me in Telugu.

2. It is submitted that the above Writ Petition is filed by questioning the Proceedings L.Dis.No.D1/COE-14207(34)/10/2025 dated 20.03.2025 of the Respondent No.2 & 3 in differing with the E-Procurement Tender vide Tender ID No.783706 dated 02.02.2025 for providing Man-power supply on outsourcing basis to work in various sections in the Fourth Respondent Temple for a period of one (01) year from 01.03.2025 to 28.02.2026 as being illegal, arbitrarily, and violative of principles of natural justice and Articles 14, 19(1)(g), 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently, direct the Respondents to forthwith process the Tender strictly in accordance with its terms and conditions and allot the Contract to the Petitioner/Lowest Bidder (L1) and for such reliefs. The copies of the L.Dis.No.D1/COE-14207(34)/10/2025 dated 20.03.2025 and E-Tender ID No. 783706 dated 02.02.2025 and are annexed to this Writ Petition as Exs.P1 & P2.

3. It is submitted that the Respondents floated E-Procurement Tender vide Rc.No.B1/11/2025 dated 03.02.2025 to provide Man-power on outsourcing basis to work in the Respondent Temple for a period of one (01) year from 01.03.2025 to 28.02.2026. The Tender is an open tender, and the evaluation shall be done item wise. The Tender was published on 03.02.2025 and advertised on 04.02.2025

in Andhra Jyothi, Chittoor Edition. The time for submitting the tender is between 04.02.2025 to 17.02.2025. The Petitioner submitted its tender and paid the Deposit of Rs.1,00,000/- on 15.02.2025. The Respondents issued the Acknowledgement dated 15.02.2025. The technical Bid was opened on 17.03.2025 at 04.00 PM and the price Bid on the same date at 04.15 PM. The Petitioner is the only qualified Bidder as per the technical requirements. The Bids of the others were rejected by the Respondents at technical level itself. Therefore, vide Rc.No.B1/11/2025 dated 18.02.2025, the Respondent Nos.4 and 5 approved the Bid of the Petitioner and sent for approval to the Respondent Nos.2 and 3. The Respondent Nos.2 and 3 without application of mind and any power and authority passed the impugned order. Copies of the Rc.No.B1/11/2025 dated 18.02.2025, Tender was published on 03.02.2025 and advertised on 04.02.2025 in Andhra Jyothi, Chittoor Edition are annexed to this Writ Petition as Ex.P3 to P5.

4. It is submitted that the Petitioner quoted 4.90% towards commission. There is no dispute that the Petitioner did not file the technical and financial Bid within the time. As stated, Respondent Nos.4 and 5 accepted the Petitioner's Tender and sent the same for formal approval to the Respondent Nos.2 and 3 though there is no requirement. However, for extraneous reasons and to continue the existing agency, the Respondent Nos.2 and 3 unilaterally differed with the tender process alleging that the Respondents will call for centralized tenders for all Joint Commissioner and Deputy Commissioner cadre Temples. It is most respectfully submitted that the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987 does not provide for classification of any Temples based on the cadre of the Commissioners appointed who manage such Temples. Even otherwise, the action of the Respondents in this regard is not fair and acted with bias with a sole intention to call for a fresh tender on the alleged ground of centralised tenders to accommodate the existing firm. The Tender cannot unilaterally be differed by the Respondent Nos.2 and 3. For extraneous reasons,

the Respondents have differed with the Tender instead of allotting the work to the Petitioner. The action of Respondents in this regard is wholly illegal, arbitrary, biased and irrational. The Respondents acted in total derogation to the mandatory terms of the Tender. They cannot act arbitrarily and support the cause of others who did not file the Tender or disqualified. The Acknowledgment dated 15.02.2025 is annexed to this Writ Petition as Ex.P6.

5. It is submitted that the Respondent Nos.2 and 3 does not have the power or authority to differ with the tender process which is already floated. Unless provided under the Tender conditions the Respondent Nos.2 and 3 cannot unilaterally cancel the tender or differ with the same. As already stated, the Respondents have resorted to this illegality to accommodate the persons of their choice. The Petitioner was neither put on notice nor heard by the Respondents before the impugned proceedings. The Petitioner has already made arrangements for procuring the manpower and by not allotting the work to the Petitioners the Respondents have deprived the Petitioner of continuing the occupation/trade/business in providing the manpower. The Respondents having induced the Petitioner into the tender process and made the Petitioner to deposit Rs.1,00,000/- towards security deposit cannot differ with the tender process, but for valid reasons. The decision-making process cannot be arbitrary and without power or authority. Therefore, the Petitioner has got prima facie case and balance of convenience for grant of interim order and will suffer serious loss if the interim order as prayed for is not granted by this Hon'ble Court.

6. It is submitted that there is no effective alternative remedy available to the Petitioner except to invoke the extraordinary jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. The Petitioner did not file any other writ or application before this Hon'ble Court or any other Court seeking the relief sought for in this Writ Petition.

7. It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue a writ or order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of MANDAMUS declaring the Proceedings L.Dis.No.D1/COE-14207(34)/10/2025 dated 20.03.2025 of the Respondent No.2 & 3 in differing with the E-Procurement Tender vide Tender ID No.783706 dated 02.02.2025 for providing Man-power supply on outsourcing basis to work in various sections in the Fourth Respondent Temple for a period of one (01) year from 01.03.2025 to 28.02.2026 as being illegal, arbitrarily, and violative of principles of natural justice and Articles 14, 19(1)(g), 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently, direct the Respondents to forthwith allot the Contract to the Petitioner/Lowest Bidder (L1) and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may be deemed fit and proper in the circumstances of the case and in the interest of justice.



11. Eligibility Requirements:

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The bidder shall furnish the following particulars in the formats enclosed, supported by documentary evidence as specified in the formats.

- a) The bidder shall have provided at least 100 service personnel in providing services of manpower on Outsourcing basis to any Government organizations / Government undertaking for the period from 2019-20 to 2023-24.
- b) The bidder shall attach the copies of contracts (each not less than 50 personnel in any Government organization) executed by them in the last five years indicating the services of manpower on outsourcing in numbers deliverables and scope of service being provided with the authorization of the concerned client. The detailed address of the client, phone number, e-mails ID etc to be mentioned by the bidder.
- c) The bidder shall have an annual turnover of not less than Rs.2.00 crores (Rupees Two Crores only) during in any one Financial Year from 2019-20 to 2023-24 in providing the services of manpower on Outsourcing basis and shall be supported by audited financial statements signed by the Chartered Accountant. (as per clause 4.3 part II (a) & (b) of Instruction to bidders).
- d) The bidder shall furnish Experience Certificates for the years 2019-20 to 2023-24 signed by their clients and furnish the abstract as mentioned in Section – IV Part –II (a) & (b).
- e) Copies of documents relating to Partnership deed in case of firms & Article of Association in case of companies.
- f) The bidder shall furnish Firm Registration of Andhra Pradesh for supplying of Manpower.
- g) The bidder shall furnish valid EPF registration along with necessary certificate and payment proofs.
- h) The bidder shall furnish valid ESI registration along with necessary certificate and payment proofs
- i) The bidder shall furnish copy of permanent account number (PAN) , GST Registration certificate and latest income tax returns submitted along with proof of receipt.
- j) The bidder shall furnish employment exchange registration certificate approved by District collector.
- k) Non refundable Processing fee of Rs.11,800/-(including GST)is to be paid in favour of Executive Officer, Sri Boyakonda Gangamma Devasthanam, Diguwapalle(V), Chowdepalle(M), Chittoor(Dt)...
- l) EMD in the shape of Bank Guarantee in the standard format. The Bank Guarantee shall be valid from the contract period to last date of tender period (i.e., 1 year) and will be returned after the completion of their tender period if and only if they submit the clearance certificate from ESI and EPF.
- m) The bidder should submit signed "Declaration of the bidder" on-line (as per section IV of Bid formats, clause-4.3)

- i. The bidder is subjected to be blacklisted and the EMD will be forfeited if he is found to have misled or furnished false information in the forms / statements / certificates submitted in proof of qualification requirements or record of performance such as abandoning of work, not properly completed in earlier contracts, inordinate delays in completion of the works, deploying of person(s) who has not qualified even SSC, litigation history and / or financial failures.

12. PROCEDURE FOR TENDER SUBMISSION.

- i. The Bidders who are desirous of participating in e-procurement shall submit their Technical bids, price bids etc., in the Standard formats prescribed in the Tender documents, displayed at e-market place. The bidders should upload the scanned copies in support of their Technical bids. The documents are to be uploaded in ZIP format only.
- ii. Sri Boyakonda Gangamma Devasthanam, Diguvalle(V), Chowdepalle(M), Chittoor(Dt). will not hold any risk and responsibility for the loss in transit during uploading of the scanned document, for the invisibility of the scanned document online, and any other problem(s) encountered by the bidders while submitting his bids online.
- iii. The bidders shall authenticate the bid with his digital certificate for submitting the bid ~~electronically on e-Procurement platform and the bids not authenticated by digital~~ certificate of the bidder will not be accepted on the e-Procurement platform.

13. Last date / time for Submission of the Tenders.

- i. Tenders must be submitted online not later than the date and time specified in the Tender Notice / Tender Document.
- ii. The Executive Officer or scheduled authorized officer may extend the date for receipt of Tenders by issuing an amendment in which case all rights and obligations of the Executive Officer and the bidders will remain same as previously.

14. General Terms & Conditions

Person inviting tenders: Executive Officer, Sri Boyakonda Gangamma Devasthanam, Diguvalle(v), Chowdepall(M), Chittoor(Dt) herein after called as SBGD

1. Tenders are invited on the e-procurement platform for supplying of man power on outsourcing basis.
2. Even while execution of the contract, if found that the bidder had produced false /fake certificates of experience, he will be black listed and the contract will be terminated and his EMD will be forfeited.
3. The contractors are requested to upload the information in Zip format preferably.
4. The bidder should clearly understand that the decision of the Executive Officer, SBGD or any officer authorized by him shall be final and binding.

5. The Executive Officer has power to relax any of the conditions with regarding to this e-procurement tender.
6. The Executive Officer, SBGD reserves the right to reject the bids or to accept the bids without assigning any reason.
7. The bidder shall furnish the unconditional acknowledgement on receipt of Letter of Acceptance of tender (LoA) within in seven days of receipt of the LoA failing which the LoA is deemed to have been cancelled.
8. No claims shall be allowed against SBGD in respect of interest on Earnest Money Deposit or late payments.
9. If the successful bidder fails furnish the required EMD and to execute the agreement within 14 days of receipt of the Letter of Acceptance of tender or withdraws his bid after submitting acknowledgement of LoA or for other reasons is unable to undertake the contract, his contract will be cancelled and the EMD shall stand forfeited to SBGD and he will also be liable for all damages suffered by SBGD
10. In the event of failure to adhere to the agreement conditions as per the standards prescribed, contract would be terminated and the firm may be black listed for three years, besides its liability for damages.
11. No suit, prosecution or any legal proceedings shall lie against SBGD or any person for anything, which is done in good faith or intended to be done in pursuance of bid.
12. Supply of manpower on outsourcing should be supplied to the SBGD as per the requirement needed for the day regardless of time, public holiday(s) which lies.
13. Even after completion of the tender period, the Executive Officer, SBGD has power to extend the time period which should be agreed by the bidder and continue the service without interruption.
14. In case of any unfortunate incident/ accident / catastrophe occurred / caused to any person(s) from bidder side, the responsibility lies within agency and the insurance will be purely claimed from your management/agency.
15. The insurance is a must to staff and this can be availed individually or in a group for the entire tender period i.e., 1 year from a registered company. The registration papers should be submitted to this SBGD within a month.
16. If the agency fails to supply the manpower as required by SBGD and if the SBGD seeks help from any other alternative source and complete the work as usually then the agency should bear the loss and may result in blacklisting.
17. All the workers/staff that will be entered to through the agency must and should have 2-3 years experience earlier in this field and should submit experience certificate immediately.
18. All the workers/staff who are entering into the SBGD's establishment must be a hindu religion person and should get affidavit individually, must acquire medical fitness certificate from Asst. Civil surgeon, Govt. Hospital.
19. The payment for monthly bill date cycle to the agency may differ from month to month.

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SECTION -II

INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

A. INTRODUCTION

1. SCOPE OF THE BID:

The EXECUTIVE OFFICER, SRI BOYAKONDA GANGAMMA DEVASTHANAM, DIGUVAPALLE(V), CHOWDEPALLE(M), CHITTOOR(Dt) herein after called TENDER INVITING AUTHORITY (TIA) intends to invite tender for Providing Out-Sourcing Services at Sri Boyakonda Gangamma Devasthanam, Diguwapalli(V), Chowdepalle (M), chittoor(Dt) for the period from 01-03-2025 to 28-02-2026

2. Eligibility to Bid for Services of Manpower on Outsourcing.

2.1 The bidder must be a Company registered under the Indian Company Act, 1956 or any proprietary, partnership firm or any other entities registered under the respective law and produce the registration certificate accordingly.

2.1.1 In case of Partnership Firm:

- a. A copy of Deed of Partnership or in case of a Company, a copy of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) and Articles of Association should be enclosed.
- b. A copy of list of partners with names and addresses or in case of company, list of directors with addresses should be enclosed.

2.1.2 Firms Ineligible to Tender:

- i) A retired officer of the Govt. of AP or Govt. of India, or any officer with related to Endowments Department or any of the employees in any endowments institution from tendering for a period of two years from the date of retirement without the prior permission of the Government.
- ii) The contractor himself or any of his employees is found to be Gazetted Officer who retired from Government Service and had not obtained permission from the Government for accepting the contractor's employment within a period of 2 years from the date of his retirement.
- iii) The Contractor or any of his employees is found at any time after award of contract, to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the Contractor's service.

- v) Contractor shall not be eligible to tender for works in the division / circle where any of his near relatives. The Contractor shall intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed. He shall also furnish a list of Gazetted /Non-Gazetted, State Government, temple Employees related to him. Failure to furnish such information bidder is liable to be removed from the list of approved contractors and his contract is liable for cancellation.

Note: Near relatives include

1. Sons, step sons, daughters, and stepdaughters.
2. Son-in-law, and daughter-in-law.
3. Brother-in-law, and sister-in-law.
4. Brothers and Sisters.
5. Father and Mother.
6. Wife / Husband.
7. Father-in-law and Mother-in-law
8. Nephews, nieces, uncle and aunts
9. Cousins and
10. Any person residing with or dependent on the contractor.

B. THE BIDDING DOCUMENTS.

2.2. Bidding Document:

- 2.2.1** The services required, bidding procedures and contract terms are prescribed in the Bidding documents. In addition to the Invitation of Bids, the Bidding Documents include:

- a. Instruction to Bidders (ITB);
- b. Conditions of Contract;
- c. Bid formats, Annexure and checklist
- d. Price bid

- 2.2.2** The Bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the Bidding Documents. Failure to furnish information required in the Bidding Documents or submission of a bid not substantially responsive to the Bidding Documents in every respect will be at the Bidder's risk and may result in rejection of its bid.

2.2.3 Clarification of Bidding Documents:

A prospective Bidder requiring any clarification of the bid documents may notify the Tender Inviting Authority (TIA) in writing at their mailing address indicated in the Invitation of Bids. The TIA will respond in writing to any request for clarification of the Bidding Documents which it receives not later than 7 days prior to the deadline for submission of bids

prescribed by the Tender Inviting Authority (TIA). Written copies of the Tender Inviting Authorities response (including an explanation of the query but without identifying the source of inquiry) will be sent to all prospective Bidders who have received the bidding documents.

2.3 Amendment of Bidding Documents:

2.3.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, the Tender Inviting Authority (TIA) may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective bidder, modify the Bidding Documents by an amendment.

2.3.2 In order to allow prospective bidders reasonable time in which to take the amendment into account in preparing their bid, the TIA may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of bids and inform the extended deadline.

C. PREPARATION OF BIDS

2.4 All documents relating to the tender shall be in English language only

2.4.1 The Bid prepared by the bidder and all correspondence and documents relating to the bid exchanged by the Bidder and the Tender Inviting Authority (TIA), shall be written in the English language. Supporting documents and printed literature furnished by the Bidder may be written in another language provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in the English language in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the Bid, the English translation shall govern.

2.5 Technical Bid:

2.5.1 The Bidder shall complete the Technical Bid in the formats furnished in the bidding documents, indicating for all the Services to be provided a brief description of the Service, quantity, methods and techniques proposed to be used, personnel to be deployed and the standards that will be followed.

2.5.2 The Bidder must obtain for himself on his own responsibility and at his own expense all the information which may be necessary for the purpose of making the Bid document and for entering into a contract through visit to site and inspection of the premises.

2.6 Price bid/ Financial Quote:

2.6.1 The Bidder shall submit separate bid for Technical and price bid / financial bid. The Bidder has to quote the commission uniformly on basic pay shown in e-platform document (including Matching Grant of EPF & ESI

& others are as applicable) for all the cadres. Otherwise the bid will be rejected.

- 2.6.2 Unsuccessful bidder's bid security will be returned not later than 30 days after the expiration of the period of bid validity.
- 2.6.3 The successful bidder's bid security will be discharged upon the bidder signing the contract along with requisite performance security.
- 2.6.4 The bid security may be forfeited :
 - (a) If a bidder withdraws its bid before the expiry of due date
 - (or)
 - (b) In case of a successful bidder, if fails:
 - (i) to sign the contract within the prescribed time or;
 - (ii) to furnish the specified performance security.
 - (iii) to submit unconditional acknowledgement of LOA within prescribed time.

Bid validity

- 2.6.5 Bids shall remain valid for 90 days from the date of bid opening. A bid valid for a shorter period will be rejected by the Tender Inviting Authority (TIA).
- 2.6.6 In exceptional circumstances, the tender inviting authority may solicit the bidders' consent to an extension of the period of validity of the bid. The bid security shall be suitably extended. A bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting its bid security. A bidder granting the request is not permitted to modify its bid.

D. BID OPENING AND EVALUATION

2.7 Opening of Bids by tender inviting authority

- a. The tender inviting authority or his authorized representative will download technical bids on the date stipulated in the tender document.
- b. The bids received only through e-procurement will be evaluated.

- 2.8 The Executive Officer, Sri Boyakonda Gangamma Devasthanam, Diguwapalle(V), Chowdepalle(M), Chittoor(Dt) can reject any bid without assigning any reasons.
- 2.9 Tender inviting authority has every right to accept any Bid and to reject any or all Bids.
- 2.9.1 The TIA reserves the right to accept or reject any bid and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of contract, without there by incurring any liabilities to the affected Bidder or Bidders or any

obligation to inform the affected Bidder or Bidders of the grounds for the Tender Inviting Authority (TIA) action. The evaluation committee during the process of evaluation bids shall take in to account the past performance of the bidder under earlier policy of this organization and its performance with other public policy along with other parameters before selecting the successful bidder.

2.9.2 Savings Clause: Any dispute will be arises during the course of the contract period, the matter shall be referred to an arbitrator appointed by the Commissioner. The decision of the arbitrator is final. No suit, or any legal proceedings shall lie against the decision of the arbitrator. Any suit or any legal proceedings filed by the agency against SBGD, the agency shall not entitled to apply for contract.

2.9.3 At the specified date and time, the price bids of all the technically qualified bidders will be opened online by the Executive Officer or scheduled authorized officer and the result will be displayed on the e-market place which can be seen by all the bidders who participated in the Tenders.

2.9.4 The Price Bid of the Unqualified Bidders will not be opened.

2.9.5. Tenders shall be scrutinized in accordance with the conditions stipulated in the Tender document. In case of any discrepancy of non-adherence to conditions, the Tender accepting authority shall communicate the same which will be binding both on the tender Opening authority and the Bidder. In case of any ambiguity or dispute, the decision taken by the Tender Accepting Authority on tenders shall be final.

2.10. Evaluation and Comparison of Price Bids

2.10.1. The Executive Officer or scheduled authorized officer will evaluate and compare the price bids of all the qualified Bidders.

2.10.2. Negotiations at any level are strictly prohibited. However, good gesture rebate, if offered by the lowest bidder prior to finalization of tenders may be accepted by the tender accepting authority.

2.11. Process to be Confidential.

2.11.1 Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of Tenders and recommendations for the award of a contract shall not be disclosed to Bidders or any other persons not officially concerned with such process until the award to the successful Bidder has been announced by the tender accepting authority. Any effort by a Bidder to influence the processing of Tenders or award decisions may result in the rejection of his Tender.

- 2.11.2 No Bidder shall contact the Executive Officer or any authority concerned with finalization of tenders on any matter relating to its Tender from the time of the Tender opening to the time the Contract is awarded. If the Bidder wishes to bring additional information to the notice of the Executive Officer, he should do so in writing.
- 2.11.3 Before recommending / accepting the tender, the tender recommending / accepting authority shall verify the correctness of certificates submitted to meet the eligibility criteria and specifically experience. The authenticated agreements of previous works executed by the lowest bidder shall be called for.

SECTION - III

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

3. Definitions

In this contract the following terms shall be interpreted as indicated:

- i) "Agency" means the individual or firm selected by the Tender Inviting Authority(TIA) for providing or supplying the Services under the Contract.
- ii) "Contract" means the agreement entered into between the TIA and the Agency as recorded in the Contract Form signed by the parties, including all the attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein.
- iii) "Implementing authority" means the Executive Officer, Sri Boyakonda Gangamma Devasthanam(v), Chowdepalle(M), Chittoor(Dt).
- iv) "Payment Authority" is Executive Officer, Sri Boyakonda Gangamma Devasthanam(v), Chowdepalle(M), Chittoor(Dt).
- v) "Tender inviting authority" means Executive Officer, Sri Boyakonda Gangamma Devasthanam(v), Chowdepalle(M), Chittoor(Dt).or his authorized representative.
- vi) The contract service agreement with the successful bidder will be signed by the Implementing Authority.
- vii) "Services" means Supply of Manpower on Outsourcing basis to Office of, Sri DMS Devasthanam, Boyakonda(v), Chowdepalle(M), Chittoor(Dt) and other obligations of the Agency covered under the contract and specified in relevant Annexure.
- viii) Sri Boyakonda Gangamma Devasthanam, Diguwapalle(v), chowdepalle(M), Chittoor(Dt) is herein after called as SBGD for convenience.

- 3.1. Within 14 days after the Agency's receipt of notification of award of the Contract, the Agency shall furnish Earnest Money Deposit of Rs.2.5 Lakhs (Rupees Two Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) to be paid by way of unconditional and irrevocable Bank Guarantee issued by any Nationalized Bank /scheduled bank in the standard format as shown in the Tender Schedule in favour of Executive Officer, Sri Boyakonda Gangamma Devasthanam, Diguwapalle(V), Chowdepalle(M), Chittoor(Dt). This Earnest Money Deposit will not carry any interest and will be with the SBGD during the Agreement period.
- 3.2. Compensation for any loss resulting from the Agency's default in discharge of its obligations under the Contract, specified in terms of the contract, shall be recovered from the performance security.
- 3.2.1. The performance security will be discharged by the tender inviting authority and returned to the Agency not later than 30 days following the date of completion of the Agency's performance obligations under the contract.
- 3.3. Contract Amendments**
No variation in or modification of the terms of the Contract shall be made except by written amendment signed by the parties.
- 3.4. **Assignment:** The Agency shall not Sub-Contract or assign in whole or in part to any other party its obligations to perform under the contract
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- 3.5 This Agreement shall be in force for a period of 12 months from the date of the Agreement and likely to be extended for one more year based on the performance of the Manpower Supply Agency and requirement of the SBGD
- 3.6 The Agency has agreed to supply Manpower as per the requirement of the SBGD, relating to the number of candidates, remuneration payable, scope and nature of the work, educational qualifications etc.
- 3.7 The Agency has agreed to supply Manpower from time to time as per requirement of the SBGD i.e increase or decrease as per requirement.
- 3.8 If the persons deployed are found unsatisfactory by SBGD such persons have to be replaced by the Agency with suitable alternative persons within a week.
- 3.9 The Agency should provide ID card to the individual as decided by SBGD
- 3.10 The Agency must submit Resumes for each category of requirement with qualifications required and description of the work.
- 3.11 The Rule of Reservation and Presidential Orders shall be followed in the selection of Outsourcing Personnel by the Agency to ensure Social Justice.
- 3.12 The Agency shall submit Bank Statement duly attested by the Bank Authorities every month covering details of wages paid to the staff supplied to SBGD
- 3.13 The Agency must give wage slips to the persons engaged by them on or before 5th of every month along with EPF slips. ESI card should be issued to all sponsored employees.
- 3.14 The Agency should comply with all instructions issued by the Government/ SBGD from time to time for the Welfare of Outsourcing Personnel.

- 3.15 It shall be the responsibility of the Agency to comply with the various statutory requirements and labor laws in relation to payment of minimum wages, effecting statutory recoveries and filing of the statutory returns. The contractor should pay E.S.I. EPF payments regularly and submit the same to the SBGD every month before due date for payment. On production of such proof only, subsequent payments will be paid by the concerned authority.
- 3.16 The remuneration to the employees will be paid as per the instructions and orders of the labour department from time to time.
- 3.17 It shall be the responsibility of the Agency to comply with the various statutory requirements and labor laws in relation to payment of minimum wages, effecting statutory recoveries and filing of the statutory returns.
- 3.18 The work shall be carried out in all the days and if necessary on Sundays and Public holidays based on the requirement of the SBGD
- 3.19 The individual sent by the outsourcing agency are eligible 15 days casual leaves per year or proportionally and women individual are eligible for 120 days maternity leave without paying remuneration for the said period as per rules and any changes are applicable as per Government orders issued from time to time.
- 3.20 The Agency is solely responsible for the safety or accident related incidents of the persons they have engaged to SBGD
- 3.21 SBGD agrees to make payment of agreed remuneration payable to the Manpower supplies on every first of succeeding month and to be accepted % - Commission on the amount towards service charge on or before 5th of the succeeding month.
- 3.22 The Agency is solely responsible for any loss incurred by the SBGD when such loss is caused by the gross negligence of the Agent's personnel or Outsourced Personnel engaged. SBGD is entitled to recover such loss from the Agency.
- 3.23 The Agency will be responsible as employer of the Manpower to maintain Personal records such as pay rolls, attendance sheets, leave records, service records etc., which shall be readily available for scrutiny / inspection by the officials of SBGD or Government.
- 3.24 The Agency shall as employer have exclusive Right to Terminate the services of any of its staff employed and to post a substitute in place of any of such person either sumotto or on demand by SBGD
- 3.25 The Agency shall not enter into sub-contracts or appoint any other Agent to perform the obligations arising under this Agreement.
- 3.26 SBGD reserves the right to impose penalty for any irregularity committed by the person appointed by the Agency.
- 3.27 In case of any over payment or wrong payment made to the Agency, due to wrong interpretation of the provisions of this Agreement or otherwise due to over sight or calculation error etc., such payment will be deducted in the subsequent bills or failing that from the bill or bills and if any balance amount is left over, the same would be recovered from the deposit of the Agency available with SBGD.

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- 3.28 The Payment will be made to the Agency based on the attendance certificate / other certificates issued by the respective Head of the Wings/AO/HoDs for the days worked by the persons supplied by the Agency.
- 3.29 The Agency is alone responsible to meet any claims of the manpower supplied by it under any of the Labour Acts such as Workmen's Compensation Act etc.
- 3.30 It shall be the endeavor of the Agency to supply persons of proven integrity and competence to SBGD
- 3.31 It is agreed between the parties that SBGD should be free to send back any person to the Agency if the performance or conduct of such person is proved unsatisfactory.
- 3.32 If the services of the Agency are found unsatisfactory or found not required for any reasons the Agreement will be terminated by giving Advance Notice of 2 (two) months.
- 3.33 To ensure proper crediting of EPF & ESI to the departments concerned, the procedure suggested by the SBGD should be followed by the Agency.
- 3.34 The Agency has to submit the list of EPF Account numbers of all the employees engaged in SBGD
- 3.35 It is very clearly understood between the parties that the manpower supplied to SBGD shall be treated under any circumstances as employees of SBGD but continues to be under the control of Agency for all purposes except in relation to the actual work entrusted to such Manpower by SBGD.
- 3.36 It is agreed between the parties that this Agreement is renewable for such further period(s) on such Terms and Conditions as mutually agreed between them.
- 3.37 It is further agreed between the parties hereto that the Courts in Punganur, alone shall have Jurisdiction to try and or entertain any proceedings, suits, complaints or any other matter arising out of or touching or concerning this Agreement.
- 3.38 The Agency can provide the existing employees of other agencies upon consultation with SBGD
- 3.39 The Agency is responsible for payment of remuneration fixed by the SBGD and also as enhanced by the Government from time to time and the payment has to be made on or before 5th of every month invariably. Any violation in this regard will be taken seriously.
- 3.40 The Outsourcing Agency shall produce Remittance Certificate towards EPF & ESI contributions at the time of submitting the bill for the succeeding month. Any excess deductions made by Outsourcing Agency in violation of Government instructions shall result in stringent action. The agency shall furnish copy of GST paid by them of their share for every month.
- 3.41 SBGD has the right to ask the agency to discontinue any of the employees from any of the posts mentioned without assigning any reasons. The agency shall follow the instructions of the Executive officer, SBGD scrupulously without any deviation.

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3.42 SBGD has the right to ask to send the workers on certain days only in a week due to work load in the temple. The salaries shall be paid accordingly on daily basis. The agency shall send the workers accordingly without any deviation.

3.43 The percentage of Service charges quoted by the tenderer should not exceed 5% and should be more than 2%.

3.45 Applicable Law



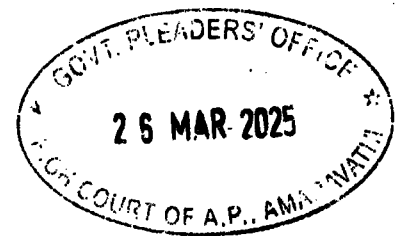
