I, M. Ramesh, S/o. M. Satyanarayana, Junior Assistant,
Endowment Department, Sri Durga Laxmaneswara Swamy

A.P., now having temporarily come down to Amaravati, do hereby
solemnly and sincerely affirm and state as follows:

1. I submit that I am the Petitioner herein and as such I
am well acquainted with the facts of the case.

2. I submit that I was appointed as Junior Assistant on
01-4-1998 vide proceedings dt.4-7-1998 by the the Chairman, Sri

Ramalingeswara Swamy temple, Kaikavaram (V), Unguturu (M), W.G. Dist., as per the existing rules. From the date of my appointment as Jr. Asst., I am discharging my duties upto the satisfaction of the temple authorities as well the Endowments Department.

3. It is pertinent to submit that as per the PRC-1993, I was given regular pay-scale to the post of Junior Assistant as per the proceedings dt.21-9-2007 by the Asst. Commissioner of Endowments Department. I submit that in fact my service was regularized from the date of PRC-1993 issued and as such, my seniority has to be counted from the date of regularization which is from the date of PRC-1993 as can be seen in the proceedings dt. 21-9-2007 of the Asst. Commissioner of Endowments Department, Eluru..

4. I submit that I was transferred to Saladi Vaari Choultry, PALAKOLLU and later I was transferred on 25-10-2023 to the present temple Sri Durga Laxmaneswara Swamy vaaru and from then onwards I am being continued in the present temple as Junior Assistant.

5. I submit that a seniority list was communicated and I raised my objections to the seniority list dt. 25-2-2015 fixing me in 2014 without taking into consideration of my seniority from the date of my regularization but taken from the date of passing Degree and my objections dt.6-5-2015 was rejected by the Deputy Commissioner, Endowments Department, Kakinada regarding the fixation of my seniority in the cadre of Jr Asst with effect from the date of sanction of time scale i.e., from the date of regularization. It is alleged from the proceedings dt.4-8-2015 in the remarks column, I did not acquire the requisite qualification of

7. I submit that though objections regarding my seniority are pending with the Respondent No.2 since, 2017 which was communicated by the Asst. Commissioner, Endowments Department, Eluru in his proceedings dt.16-8-2007,

in the meanwhile, there are many persons who are being promoted after 2023 who are my juniors M. I submit that basing on which, the 2nd Respondent has implemented in his proceedings dt.27-06-2019 promoting the Managers/junior Assistants who are/were working in Temples on temporary basis as per the said Memo dt.07-03-2019 in so far as East Godavari District is concerned. In the proceedings of the 2nd Respondent dt.05/05/2024, filled up the posts including Executive Officer Gr.III in existing vacancies. In West Godavari and Prakasam Districts, the promotions were effected in the proceedings of the 2nd Respondent dt.27/06/2023 & 28/06/2023, which is on record. I submit that in the neighbor districts, the 2nd respondent who is the competent authority had issued promotion orders to the post of Executive Officer Gr-III on 07.06.2023 to the similarly situated persons on the same lines.

10. I submit that in the letter of the 2nd Respondent clearly show that he has complied the orders of this Hon'ble Court in WP 21556 of 2021 after filing contempt case i.e., CC No.5322/2023, which is on record, in respect of the Nellore District is concerned. I submit that the 1st Respondent issued Memo dt.06/02/2024 accorded the permission to the 2nd Respondent to fill up the vacancies in the cadres of Deputy Commissioner, Asst Commissioner, Executive Officer Grade-I, Executive Officer Gr.II and Executive Officer Gr.III with eligible candidates duly following Rule-10 of A.P. State and Subordinate Service Rules.

12. I submit that the 1st Respondent amended the Rules of Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Subordinate Service Rules, 2002 by issuing

G.O.Ms.No.38, dt.30-01-2024. Even according to it also I am fully eligible to be promoted to the post of Executive Officer Gr.III.

13. The Act 2/1994 is not implemented in temples and as such Government issued G.O.Rt.No.1997, Revenue (Endowments-I) Department dt.18-10-2005 *prohibiting further recruitment of all administrative staff in Hindu Religious and Endowments Institutions until further orders.*

14. It is submitted that in the alleged G.O.Rt.No.1997, Revenue (Endowments-I) Department dt.18-10-2005, it is very clear that it is only imposed from the date of issuing the said G.O.Ms.No.1997 *prohibiting further recruitment of all administrative staff in Hindu Religious and Endowments Institutions until further orders and not otherwise.*

15. I submit that the Act 2 of 1994 relates appointment of the posts as stated therein and not related to the promotions and even it would not apply to my case. I submit that during the alleged ban period, some appointments were taken place which is not followed by the Endowments department and as such denying my case for promotion is not all correct and is highly objectionable and it amounts to denial of my legitimate.

16. I submit that once the rules permit the appointment as Junior Assistant with intermediate or equivalent qualification and when I was being appointed on the said rules with effect from 01-4-1998 and regularized my service with effect from 01-9-2007, I cannot be denied my promotion to the post of Executive Officer Grade-III and further though I passed degree i.e., B.A., (Bachelor of Arts) in near 2014 my seniority cannot be fixed on wrong notion ignoring the Service Rule-2000 i.e., GO Ms. No.888 which is in

force. Interestingly, the Respondent No.1 has ratified by issuing GO RT No. 1813 Revenue (Endowments-I) Dept, dt. 26-12-2009

"as the appointments were already made by the Chairman & Managing Trustee in the available cadre strength of the temple for administrative convenience and they are already working in the temple, the government hereby ratify the action of the Chairman & Managing Trustee of Venugopala Swamy temple, Moolapeta, Nellore in having appointed (2 Record Assts) i.e., Shri V. Girikrishna and Shri V. Rangaraju as a Special case in relaxation of ban on appointments imposed in GO Ms No. 1997 Revenue (Endowments-1) Dept., Dt. 18-10-2005 and also the relevant rules issued in the GO Ms No.888, Revenue (Endowments-I) Dept. dt. 08-12-2000."

17. *It is pertinent to submit that, my appointment govern under the Rules-2000 and by virtue of regularization with effect from 01-9-2007 I cannot be denied my legitimate promotion as Executive Officer Grade-III in the existing vacancies".*

18. It is pertinent to submit that, the Respondent No.1 issued ban orders vide GO RT No. 1997 dt. 18-10-2005 in which it is stated that as on the date of issue of GO, there shall not be any irregular appointments without sanction of the post in the cadre strength of the respective institutions and without examining the actual necessity of such posts and without following the rules & regulations and therefore the Respondent No.2 is directed to take necessary action as the government prohibited further recruitment of administrative staff in Hindu Religious & Endowments institutions till further orders by directing the Respondent No.2 to take necessary action.

(i) It is pertinent to submit that I am being appointed as on 01-4-1998 and continued as a Junior Assistant within the available cadre strength appointed by the then Chairman & Trustee of the temple as per requirement and available post and

subsequently the budget was sanctioned and as such I am being regularized w.e.f., 01-9-2007 by the proceedings of the Asst. Commissioner, Endowments Department, Eluru. Therefore the ban period as per the said GO dt. 18-10-2005 issued by the Respondent No.1, does not Ipso Facto would applicable to my case and further the question of passing Degree as alleged by the Dy Commissioner of Endowments Department, Kakinada on my objections in all respects in the proceedings dt.04-8-2015 is not in consonance with the Rules-2000 when I was appointed and further the ban period or the question of passing of Decree as alleged does arise.

(ii) In fact, I have completed my departmental tests as required for the post of Executive Officer Grade-III, and therefore my case has to be considered for promotion to the post of Executive Officer Grade-III, in the existing available 5 posts, in the interest of justice.

19. I submit that the promotions were being effected without considering my case in true spirit taking into consideration of my seniority with effect from 01-9-2007 under the guise of ban period in the said GO dt.18-10-2005 and the ban period issued further in RC No. B2/39054/2007 dt.01-01-2008 by the Respondent No.2 do not effect in so as my case is concerned. Therefore I am fully eligible and qualified for the promotion to the post of Executive Officer Grade-III and still there are 5 more vacancies that are available.

20. I submit that I have submitted my representation along with 4 others dt.05-11-2022 to the Respondent No.2 which was received and kept pending with an endorsement to examine the representation.

21. In the circumstances stated above, the petitioner has no efficacious alternative remedy, except to seek the redressal before this Hon'ble Court seeking the indulgence of this Hon'ble Court to exercise the extraordinary original jurisdiction vested in this Hon'ble Court by virtue of Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

22. The petitioner has not filed any writ petition, suit or other proceedings for the relief or relieves sought herein.

It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue a writ or order or directions more particularly in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the inaction of the Respondents more particularly the Respondent No.2 herein in not considering the case of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Executive Officer Grade-III in the existing available vacancies by not following the Memo No.EndowMis/23/Endts.1(2)/2018, dt.07-3-2019 as illegal, contrary to law, highly objectionable, discriminate in nature, official biased, ultra-wires, unconstitutional, as well as violation of article-14, 16 & 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently directing the Respondent No.2 to promote the petitioner in the existing vacancies with all consequential monetary benefits with effect from the date of his Juniors if any promoted, in the interest of justice and to pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deems fit just and proper in the circumstances of the case.

It is also just and necessary that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Executive Officer Grade-III under the existing vacancies taking into consideration of the seniority of the petitioner with effect from 01-9-2007, by disposing

Currently, we have passed the exams in all the departments related to the Endowment Department. At that time, the income of the temples and inns was very low. Later, we worked hard and improved the financial condition of the temples and inns with our hard work. Those who recognized our CVs at that time gave us PRC in the next period, i.e. in the year 2006 and 2007. Since then, we have been working in various temples through general transfers and deputations in the year 2008 and in the year 2022. We have passed all the departmental tests. Even today, we have various PRC scale DAs and are performing our duties regularly with discipline and devotion.

But in their office, they say that we have taken PRC after G.O.R.T. No. 1997 dated 18.10.2005, and that we should not be promoted as Grade 3 Executive Officer. We are informing them that we were all created before the ban period, i.e. from 1992 to 1999, as indicated above.

Therefore, we are informing the authorities that some of us have only served for five or six years. We have become a burden to support our families by performing our duties with a meager life. Our children are also in a state where they are not able to get proper education. We request the authorities to kindly look into the above matters and consider our Junior Assistants for Executive Officer Grade 3 posts through Transfer of Service in the future and give them Executive Officer Grade 3 posts through Transfer of Service.



In the reference 2nd cited, the provisional seniority list of the Junior Assistants working in the religious and charitable institutions in West Godavari District has been prepared with reference to the entries made in their service registers, guidelines issued by the Commissioner, Endowments Department, Hyderabad in the U.O. Note 1st cited and in accordance with the rules framed under G.O.Ms.No.1478 & G.O.Ms.No.888 and the same was communicated to all concerned inviting objections within 15 days from the date of receipt of the Provisional List.

In the reference 3rd cited, Sri M.Ramesh, Junior Assistant has submitted his objection stating that his seniority in Junior Assistant Cadre was considered w.e.f 1-6-2014 i.e from the date of acquiring of degree qualification whereas services of Junior Assistant who stood at Sl.No.34 in provisional seniority is taken into consideration w.e.f the date of sanction of time scale although he doesnot hold requisite qualification to hold the post of Junior Assistant and requested to treat his case as similar to that case and to refix his seniority w.e.f the date of sanction of time scale.

The objections of the individual is examined. His objection with regard to re fixation of his seniority in Junior Assistant cadre w.e.f the date of sanction of time scale is hereby rejected as it is against the rules. Also it is clearly mentioned in the remarks columns noted against the person stood at Sl.no.34 that he did not possess requisite qualification to hold the post of Junior Assistant i.e., they are non-eligible candidates.

ORDER:-

Whereas, in the G.O. third read above, Government have issued preliminary notification duly notifying the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments (Transfer of office holders and servants) Rules, 2019;

And whereas, certain objections/suggestions have been received from various individuals/Associations for consideration. On the said objections/suggestions, the Special Commissioner of Endowments has furnished detailed remarks in the reference fourth read above.

Now, therefore, the Government after careful examination, have decided to issue final notification in the matter.

Accordingly, the following Notification will be published in the Extraordinary issue of the Andhra Pradesh Gazette, dated.12-10-2020.

FINAL NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub- section (1) of section 153 read with section 39 and sub-section (1) of section 29 of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act,1987 (Act No. 30 of 1987) and in supersession of rules made if any on the subject matter earlier, the Government hereby make the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments (Transfer of office holders and servants) Rules, 2020, as the same has been previously published in part-I Extraordinary No.533 of the Andhra Pradesh Gazette, dated 2nd August, 2019 as required under sub-section (1) of section 153 of the said Act vide G.O.Ms.No.346, Revenue (Endts.I) Department, Dated.30-07-2019.

RULES

1. Short title: These Rules may be called the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments (Transfer of office holders and servants) Rules, 2020.

2. Application: These rules shall be applied only to the administrative and technical staff working in 6(a) (b)(c) and (d) institutions under the purview of the Endowments Department in the State of Andhra Pradesh.

(P.T.O)

3. Unit of Transfer: The units for the purpose of transfer of office holders and servants attached to the Charitable or Religious Institutions or Endowments shall be as follows:

(a) For the purpose of transfer of employees working in the temples being administered by the Executive Officer's in the cadre of Regional Joint Commissioner's & Deputy Commissioner's.

(i) For transfer of Executive Engineers entire State shall be considered as a single unit.

(ii) In case of transfer of Assistant Executive Officer's, Deputy Executive Engineer's,-

Unit-I: The Temples being administered by Executive Officers in the cadre of Regional Joint Commissioner's & Deputy Commissioner's in Visakhapatnam Zone (Zone-I) & Kakinada Zone (Zone-II).

Unit-II: The Temples being administered by Executive Officers in the cadre of Regional Joint Commissioner's & Deputy Commissioner's in Guntur Zone (Zone-III) & Kurnool Zone (Zone-IV).

(iii) In case of employees in the cadre of Assistant Engineer's, Superintendent's, Senior Assistant's, Junior Assistant's, Draftsman, Work Inspector and Sanitary Inspector,-

Unit-I: The Temples being administered by Executive Officers in the cadre of Regional Joint Commissioner's & Deputy Commissioner's in Visakhapatnam Zone (Zone-I) (Srikakulam, Vizianagaram & Visakhapatnam).

Unit-II: The Temples being administered by Executive Officers in the cadre of Regional Joint Commissioner's & Deputy Commissioner's in Kakinada Zone (Zone-II) (East Godavari, West Godavari & Krishna).

Unit-III: The Temples being administered by Executive Officers in the cadre of Regional Joint Commissioner's & Deputy Commissioner's in Guntur Zone (Zone-III) (Guntur, Prakasam & Nellore).

Unit-IV: The Temples being administered by Executive Officers in the cadre of Regional Joint Commissioner's & Deputy Commissioner's in Kurnool Zone (Zone-IV) (Kurnool, Kadapa, Anantapur & Chittoor).

(b) In 6(a) institutions other than the institutions being administered by the Executive Officer's of Regional Joint Commissioner's & Deputy Commissioner's.

(i) In case of Superintendent and Senior Assistant

Zone-IV: Chittoor, Cuddapah, Ananthapur and Kurnool Districts.

4. Competent authority:- The competent authority to transfer the employees of Endowments institutions shall be-

- (i) The Commissioner in case of employees of 6(a) & 6(d) institutions.
- (ii) The Deputy Commissioner's in case of 6(b) institutions.
- (iii) There shall not be any transfer or deputation of employees from or to any 6(c) institutions.

5. Period of Transfer: No office holder or servant attached to a Charitable and Religious Institutions or Endowment shall ordinarily be transferred within a period of three years from the date of joining duty in such institutions or Endowments, unless such transfer is necessary in the interest of the institution or Endowment concerned for the reason to be recorded in writing.

No transfer shall be made from one institution to another institution exceeding the cadre strength accorded by the competent authority to the particular institution. Excess posts if any in existence exceeding the cadre strength shall be repatriated to their parent institution keeping in view of the financial burden on such temples.

Only the employees who were appointed in the sanctioned posts or approved cadre strength posts by the competent authority as per the rules framed earlier in G.O.Ms.No.888 Dated.08.12.2000, are entitled for transfer from one institution to another.

6. Norms for transfer:

- (a) Lien of services from Endowments department in all cadres shall be restricted keeping in view of cadre strength fixed to the particular institution / temple by the competent authority as per work load.
- (b) No transfers shall be made during the ban period imposed by the Government from time to time.
- (c) While effecting transfer of employees, Spouse cases, medical grounds, left over service for superannuation and mutual transfer applications can be taken into consideration for the purpose of priority.

7. Joining time and TTA: Every office holder or servant attached to a Charitable and Religious Institution or Endowment shall on transfer be eligible to joining time and transfer travelling allowances as admissible in case of Government servants of the corresponding cadre under the Andhra Pradesh manual of special pay and allowances. The pay for the period of transition and transfer travelling allowances shall be paid from the funds of the institution or Endowment from which the office holder or servant is transferred.

8. Pay and allowances: An office holder or servant on transfer to another institution or Endowment, shall continue to draw the same pay and allowances which are having been drawn by him in his parent institution.

(Contd..)

9. Authority to Grant increment and leave: The Executive Officer of the institution or Endowment where the office holder or servant is working on transfer shall be the authority competent to grant increment and leave in accordance with the rules in force.

10. Payment of leave salary: The leave at the credit of the office holder or servant shall not lapse on account of transfer and accumulated to his credit at the office holder or servant shall be eligible to draw leave salary from the institution or Endowment at which he is working while going on leave whether or not that the said leave was earned in the said institution, or not and shall be accorded permission for encashment of earned leave.

11. Lien : Every office holder or servant shall continue to hold his lien in his parent institution or Endowment for all purposes notwithstanding his transfer to other institution.

12. Seniority: The seniority of the office holder or servant in the class or category existing at the time of transfer in his parent institution shall not be affected and his claim for promotion shall be taken into consideration by the executive authority of his parent institution or endowment while making any promotion to a higher cadre, treating as if he is continuing in his parent institution only.

If any promotion is given to an office holder who is working at other institution on transfer such promotion shall be given effect at his / her transferred place without any discretion. If no such post is available in the cadre strength of such institution he / she shall be repatriated to his parent institution without any further delay.

The vacancy on the cause of transfer of an employee to other institution shall not be filled either by recruitment in the particular temple or by promotion with the existing staff.

If it is so, necessary for that particular post of the same cadre employee of another institution of the same cadre temple shall be transferred into that post.

13. Counting of Service: The service of an office holder or servant rendered in the place of transfer shall be always counted for the purpose of probation, leave, seniority, promotion, gratuity, pension etc., in his parent institution.

14. Privileges or Concessions:

(i) Promotions and implementation of pay revision from time to time, shall be effected in parent institution.

(ii) Pay and allowances, periodical increments, LTC and TA bills, Special grade and special promotion scales, Transfer TA claim, etc., shall be effected in working (Transferred) institution.

15. Disciplinary control: The Executive authority of the institution or endowment to which an office holder or servant is transferred shall exercise disciplinary control over such transferee. But the power of executive authority in respect of transferee is regulated to the extent of initiating disciplinary proceedings and inflicting punishment up to issuance of memo and calling for explanation and the further proceedings of the disciplinary action shall be under the control of the Executive officer of his parent institution only.

SUB: PUBLIC SERVICES - Six Point Formula - Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organisation of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order, 1975 - Further instructions on the implementation of Presidential Order, 1975 and G.O. Ms. No. 610, G.A. (SPF.A) Dept., Dated 30-12-1985-Issued.

The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organisation of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order, 1975 (Presidential Order) was re-published vide G.O. 1st cited and came into force from 18-10-1975. For effective implementation of the Presidential Order, orders and instructions were issued from time to time clarifying the course of action to be taken. Government noticed certain deficiencies in the implementation of the Presidential Order and consequently the Government have constituted a One Man Commission (SPF) i.e. OMC(SPF) vide G.O. 5th cited, to "make study of the injustice done in the implementation of G.O.Ms.No.610, General Administration (SPF-A) Department, dated 30-12-1985 and to sort out the anomalies and also to suggest further follow up action for the rectification of defects, anomalies and irregularities, if any, and to arrive at estimates of deviations and anomalies in implementing the Presidential Order and also suggest remedial actions, which would include a mechanism to ensure implementation and monitoring of Six Point Formula".

2. The One Man Commission (SPF) submitted its Report and after detailed consideration, the following further instructions are issued in this matter:-

- A-1) Appointments to various categories of posts in the under mentioned offices are made either on Deputation, on Tenure, on Other Duty and also under Rule 10 (a) (i) of the Andhra Pradesh State and Subordinate Service Rules. Para 9 (B) (1) of G.O. P No. 728, G.A. (SPF.A) Dept., Dt. 1-11-1975 specifies that all such appointments in the Departments of Secretariat, Offices of Heads of Departments, Special Offices or Establishments, State Level Offices or Institutions and Major Development Projects are to be on the basis of a "Fair

Share Principle". This principle would require that such appointments are to be made from local cadres in proportion to the basic strength of such local cadres. In this light, the offices are directed to:

- i) identify the local cadres from which the current appointees are presently in office, and
- ii) to make adjustments by way of repatriation and demotion as required in order to ensure that the fair share principle is maintained.

- A-2) All employees who have been posted on Other Duty to any office and later on absorbed in the post and thereafter promoted, should be identified. In all such cases, the orders of absorption/promotion shall be reviewed so as to ensure conformity with reference to the Fair Share principle. In the event some promotions have been ordered in excess of such principle, the concerned should be demoted and then repatriated to their respective local cadres. The consequential vacancies may be filled with personnel who are qualified in accordance with the Rules.
- B) The Cadre strength in each office of the Head of the Department shall be fixed according to the number of persons involved in Administrative Work alone and not based on line functions. In case of personnel discharging administrative as well as line functions, the function which is predominant shall be taken into account while determining whether it is an administrative or a line function.
- C) The Departments concerned shall immediately identify "Major Development Projects" which are not included under G.S.R. 525 (E) and communicate the same to General Administration Department. Thereafter, the General Administration Department shall update the list of GSR 525 (E) by obtaining the concurrence of Government of India.
- D) The Departments concerned shall immediately identify the non functional offices listed in the GSR 526 (E), GSR 527 (E) and GSR 529 (E) for deletion and also identify the new eligible offices for inclusion. Necessary proposals shall be sent by all the concerned Departments to the General Administration (MC) Department for obtaining concurrence of the Government of India.
- E) From 1-11-1975, members of the Work-charged Establishment in various projects would have been regularized from time to time in accordance with the orders and instructions as issued at that time. With regard to such

regularized work charged establishment, the following instructions are issued:-

- i) the local status of each Member must be identified as per instructions mentioned in G.O. P. No.729, G.A. (SPF.A) Dept., Dt. 1-11-1975.
- ii) Non-locals in excess of the prescribed strength at any point of time, must be repatriated to their local zone on the basis of "last in and first out" to similar vacancies as and when they arise in their local cadres.
- iii) For members of the work charged establishment who have not been so far regularized, their local status must first be ascertained as per the existing instructions in G.O. P. No.729, G.A. (SPF.A) Dept., Dt. 1-11-1975.
- iv) Hereafter, as and when regularization is permitted by the extant rules of the Departments concerned, no non-local candidates shall be absorbed till all local candidates are absorbed.
- v) After absorbing all the local candidates, the non-local candidates can be absorbed within the permissible ratio.

F) The Municipal Administration and Urban Development Department are directed to take immediate necessary action to bring all Urban Development Authorities from the date of their creation under the purview of Presidential Order, 1975, in order to organize the local cadre. The M.A & U.D. Department shall send proposals to G.A. (MC) Dept., within three months.

G) The "Unit of Appointment" as defined in paragraph 6 of the Presidential Order, 1975 shall be strictly applied. With regard to the different categories of employment, the Unit of Appointment is as follows:-

- i) For all categories equivalent to Junior Assistants and below, the Unit of Appointment shall be the District.
- ii) For all non-gazetted categories of posts above the level of Junior Assistant, the Unit of Appointment is the Zone as defined in the Presidential Order.
- iii) For all the gazetted categories, the State is the Unit of Appointment except for the "Specified Categories" for which the Unit of Appointment shall be the Zone. All Departments shall review

this existing structures to ensure that the Unit of Appointment for all categories are as set out above. Further, the seniority list for each category of posts within such Unit of Appointment shall be published within 6 months.

H) The "Inter Local Cadre Transfers" of Employees shall be permitted within the terms as set out in para 5 (2) of the Presidential Order, 1975. Such transfers shall be subject to the following :-

- i) for cadres for which the District is the Unit of Appointment, non-locals shall not exceed 15% of the cadre strength at any point of time.
- ii) For cadres for which the Zone is the Unit of Appointment, non-locals shall not exceed 25% of the cadre strength at any point of time.
- iii) All Departments shall immediately review the existing cadre strength, and regularly thereafter, in the month of April every year, to ensure that the percentages above are adhered to.

I) Appointments on "Compassionate Grounds" to the dependents of deceased Government employees, shall only be in accordance with the definitions given to the Local Area / Local Candidate in the Presidential Order, 1975, except, in the case of Offices to which the Presidential Order is not applicable.

J-1) The First Schedule under para 2 (1) (a) of the Presidential Order, 1975 has defined the "City of Hyderabad" as a Unit which comprises specified urban rural areas and Panchayats. As Panchayat areas have ceased to exist due to the creation of Municipal Bodies, in order to ensure that the City of Hyderabad is defined within the terms of the First Schedule, it is ordered that the Panchayat area should be read to mean the Revenue Villages which constituted these Panchayats as on 18-10-1975.

J-2) The Revenue Department shall furnish the details of the Revenue villages which comprised the erstwhile Panchayats as listed in the First Schedule, so as to amend the Presidential Order to that extent. The geographical limits of this (City of Hyderabad), having been defined in the Presidential Order, shall remain immutable for all the times to come.

- J-3) Further, in order to remove misconceptions and mis-definitions, it is clarified that the Presidential Order has no where defined any "Free Zone" or Hyderabad City Zone. The only specified area in the Presidential Order is the Unit called the City of Hyderabad which is constituted by the areas as set out above. The Presidential Order requires that appointments to certain categories of posts and to the extent mentioned in G.S.R. 528 (E), shall only be from the local candidates from the City of Hyderabad. The term local candidate will be as set out in the Presidential Order itself.
- K) The local status of the selected candidates shall be determined as per the established procedure.
- L) All the appointing authorities are directed to make necessary entries in the Service Registers of the every employee of his/her Local Status, in accordance with Para 7 of the Presidential Order, 1975.

3. All Departments of Secretariat are directed to take action as per above orders. The Departments should also review the progress of implementation of the above and send a monthly status report to G.A. (MC) Department which will monitor the progress of implementation of these orders.



It is against the rules. In the past, it has been explained many times through circulars that such appointments should not be made without permission. However, such practice still continues. This is the saddest thing. There are many legal problems faced by the executive officers who continue to appoint staff without permission and send proposals to confirm their further action. Thus, the status of the temples is deteriorating.

Therefore, as mentioned many times in the past regarding the appointment of these staff, this circular instructs the executive officers not to make any appointments without the prior approval of the Commissioner. This is to warn that strict disciplinary action will be taken against those who violate the instructions.

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ORDER:-

The Commissioner, Endowments Department, Hyderabad in his letter read above, has stated that Sri Venugopala Swamy Temple, Moolapet, Nellore Town is being maintained by the Anam Family since several years. The cadre strength of this temple was approved by the Commissioner, Endowments Department vide D.Dis.No.C3/3820/2002, dated 4.2.2002. Among the posts approved in the cadre strength, 3 posts of Record Assistant cadre were also included. Two Record Assistants namely Sri B. Dharma Rao and Sri P. Venku Reddy were working against two Record Assistant vacancies and the 3rd Record Assistant post was vacant. Sri P. Venku Reddy was promoted from Record Assistant to Junior Assistant cadre in the vacancy of Junior Assistant. Thus, the Record Assistant post held by him and the existing Record Assistant vacancy put together have become (2) vacancies. The Managing Trustee of the subject temple considered the applications of Sri V. Giri Krishna and Sri V. Ranga Raju for appointment in the existing (2) Record Assistant vacancies and issued appointment orders through his proceedings dated 20.9.2006, appointing them as Record Assistants in the existing vacancies, in violation of ban imposed by Government vide G.O.Rt.No.1997, dated 18.10.2005 on recruitment in the institutions of Endowments Department and without following prescribed rules in force requested to ratify his action in having appointed them as Record Assistants against the existing vacancies.

2. The Commissioner, Endowments Department, Hyderabad has further stated that assessable income for the last 4 years of the subject temple already crossed Rs.60,00,000/- lakhs and the expenditure on Establishment charges already crossed statutory limitation of 30% specified under Section 57 of A.P.H.R.C. and Endowments Act. The income of the subject temple is consistently above Rs.10 lakhs from the year 2005-2006 and the Chairman and Managing Trustee is not competent to appoint anybody without obtaining prior permission of the competent authority even if the posts are vacant in approved cadre strength as per Section 35 of the Act. The request of the Chairman and Managing Trustee was once rejected by the Commissioner, Endowments Department vide his order dated 9.2.2009 and refused to ratify the action of the Chairman and Managing Trustee and also directed the Managing Trustee to terminate the services of both Record Assistants who are illegally and irregularly appointed during the ban period. The Chairman and Managing Trustee is not competent to make any appointments without obtaining prior permission of the competent authority i.e. the Commissioner, Endowments Department and in violation of G.O.Ms.No.888, Revenue [Endts.] Department, dated 8.12.2000 for making appointments. The Commissioner, Endowments Department has therefore requested the Government to pass necessary orders in the matter.

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3. As the appointments were already made by the Chairman and the Managing Trustee in the available cadre strength of the temple for administrative convenience and they are already working in the temple, Government hereby ratify the action of the Chairman and Managing Trustee of Venugopala Swamy Temple, Moolapet, Nellore in having appointed two (2) Record Assistants i.e. Sri V. Giri Krishna and Sri V. Ranga Raju, as a special case in relaxation of ban on appointments imposed in G.O.Ms.No.1997, Revenue [Endowments-I] Department dated 18.10.2005 and also the relevant rules issued in the G.O.Ms.No.888, Rev. [Endts.I] Deptt. 8.12.2000.

4. This order should not be treated as a precedent in further.

5. The Commissioner, Endowments Department, Hyderabad shall take further necessary action accordingly in the matter.

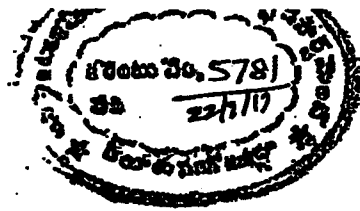

Therefore, I am in 103. But I could have been in 50 r 54 if I had been put in one nine in 2007. Due to that my promotion has been affected. They have put my colleagues in the 2007 scale sanctioned for them. For example, what we have been told is that the employee number 34 in the seniority list, Shri Addalu, who had passed only SSC at the time of sanctioning the scale of Junior Assistant, has been registered from 01.07.2021 from the date of sanction. And my subordinate has a Diploma in Industrial Electronics, but he got the scale in 2007. He was also given the scale sanctioned in 2007 itself.

Therefore, I request you to register my name in the seniority list from 01.09.2007.

HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE TARLADA RAJASEKHAR RAO**WRIT PETITION No. 21556 of 2021****ORDER:**

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Government Pleader for Endowments appearing for the respondents.

This writ petition is filed to declare the action of the respondents in not effecting the promotions of the petitioners by way of transfer to the post of Executive Officer Grade-III against the available vacancies, as illegal and arbitrary.

The petitioners, who are working as Junior Assistants, are seeking to appoint them as Executive Officer Grade-III by effecting promotions by way of transfer. They also submitted a representation dated 16.03.2021 to consider their case for promotion as Executive Officer Grade-III by way of transfer. As the said representation is not considered, the present writ petition is filed seeking a direction to the respondent authorities to effect the promotions of the petitioners by way of transfer to the post of Executive Officer Grade-III against the available vacancies.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that one Sri K. Maheswara Rao, filed W.P.No.9442 of 2019 aggrieved by the proceedings in R.C.No.E2/34561/2019-3, dated 27.06.2019 for according permission to fill up the vacancies by the 2nd respondent

herein. And also filed another Writ Petition No.8076 of 2019 aggrieved by the orders in proceedings *vide* Memo No. ENDOWOMISC/23/Endts.I(2)/2018, dated 07.03.2019 according permission to make temporary appointments to the post of Executive Officer Grade-III of Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Subordinate Services Non-Gazette Rules, 2002. Learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that these two Writ Petitions were withdrawn by the petitioners and no proceedings are pending.

In view of the withdrawal of the above Writ Petitions there is no impediment to dispose of the present writ petition basing upon the memo issued by the Government.

Learned counsel for the respondents would submit that the 2nd respondent has filed a counter stating that the Government in Memo No. ENDOWOMISC/23/Endts.I(2)/2018, dated 07.03.2019 and the Government in Memo No. ENDOWOMISC/23/Endts.I(2)/2018, dated 16.10.2019, having considered the circumstances explained by the office, was pleased to accord permission to fill-up 118 vacancies by way of promotion/appointment by way of transfer, subject to specific conditions.

It is admitted in the counter that the respondents are ready to consider the case of the petitioners as per the conditions

mentioned in the memo dated 07.03.2019 *vide* Memo No. ENDWOMISC/23/Endts.I(2)/2018.

The memo dated 07.03.2019 *vide* Memo No. ENDWOMISC/23/Endts.1(2)/2018, reads as under:

2. The temporary promotions/appointment by transfer of service shall be subject to the following conditions:

- i) Appointment shall be based on seniority fixed in the category of Junior Assistants duly following the ratio as per Rule 3 of Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Subordinate Service (Non-Gazetted) Rules.
- ii) The persons so appointed against the vacancies (quota) of Executive Officer Grade-III meant for direct recruitment shall give way to the direct recruits unconditionally as and when they join duty.
- iii) In such case, they shall not claim any pensionary benefits or any other benefit, consequent to their appointment by transfer as Executive Officers Grade-III.
- iv) The vacancies of Grade-III Executive Officers shall be filled up with qualified Junior Assistants who are working as Junior Assistants as on 29.02.2016 only by way of transfer of service.
- v) The Rule of Reservation in promotions shall be followed scrupulously.
- vi) The appointment of Junior Assistants as Grade-III Executive Officer post will be purely on transfer of service only.
- vii) The probation of the Executive Officer Grade-III so appointed on promotion to the post earmarked for direct recruitment, shall not be commenced from the date of his appointment into the slot earmarked

for Direct Recruitment but, shall be reached only from the date on which he would have occupied the vacancy meant for them.

3. *The Commissioner of Endowments, Andhra Pradesh, shall take necessary action in the matter accordingly.*

Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondents to consider the promotions of the petitioners by way of transfer to the post of Executive Officer Grade III against the available vacancies, basing on the memo dated 07.03.2019 *vide* Memo No. ENDWOMISC/23/Endts.1(2)/2018, within a period of four (04) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Consequently, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this writ petition shall stand closed.

Backward Class – D, Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes, Physically Handicapped Ex-serviceman quota.
5. **Qualifications:** No person shall be eligible for appointment to the class and categories as specified in columns (1) and (2) respectively of the Annexure to these rules by the method specified in column (3) unless he possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entry in column (4) thereof.
6. **Age:** No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by direct recruitment, if he has completed the age of 28 years on the 1st day of July of year in which the notification for selection is issued.
7. **Minimum Service :** No person shall be eligible for appointment by transfer from the cadres of institutions published under section 6(a) or (b) or (c) or (d) of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987 or by promotion unless he has put in three years of service but in no case shall it be less than two years and is an approved probationer in the category from which promotion or appointment by transfer is made.
8. **Probation:** Every person appointed to the post by direct recruitment shall from the date on which he commences probation, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years: and every person appointed to any of the categories by promotion or by transfer shall, from the date on which they commences probation, be on probation for a total period of one year on duty within a continuous period of two years.
9. **Training:-**
 - (a) Every person appointed by direct recruitment or promotion or by transfer to the post of Executive officer, Assistant Staphathi and Assistant Engineer as the case may be shall undergo immediately after appointment a course of training for such a period and according to such programme and syllabus as may be prescribed by the Commissioner of Endowments from time to time.
 - (b) Every person appointed by direct recruitment as Executive Officer, Assistant Staphathi and Assistant Engineer shall before the commencement of training execute a bond to the effect that he shall serve the Department for a period of three years after the completion of training referred to in sub-rule (a). He shall be liable to refund to the Government the pay and allowances and any other remuneration received by him in addition to the amount spent by the Government on his training.

- (i) If he fails to serve the Department for a period of three years after the completion of his training for any reason; or
 - (ii) If he discontinues the training or is discharged from training course for misconduct or any other reason; or
 - (iii) If he secures any other employment elsewhere than under the State Government.
- (c) The period of training shall count for the purposes of probation increments leave and pension.
- (d) A direct recruit shall be eligible during the period of training for the initial pay of the post with usual allowance admissible at the place of training.
10. **Tests:-** Every person appointed by direct recruitment to the posts of Executive Officer, Assistant Engineer, Draughtsman Grade-I and Draughtsman Grade-II, Assistant Sthapathi, Silpi Draughtsman and silpi Tracer shall pass the Account Test for public works Department officers and Subordinate officers Part-I and Endowments Department Test (part I and II) within the period of probation.
11. **Security:-** Every person appointed to the service shall furnish security for such sum and in such manner or in such form as may be prescribed by the Commissioner of Endowments from time to time.
12. **Unit of appointment:-** For the purpose of recruitment appointment discharge for want to vacancy, re-appointment, seniority, promotion, transfer and posting and appointment as full member to the class and category specified in column (1) and (2) respectively of the table below the unit of appointment shall be as specified in column (3) thereof.

13. **Lein:-** The lein of all the employees recruited by transfer shall case to the post in the Department or institution from which he has been recruited from the date of joining of the post by transfer.

Provided that the exemptions if any made by the Government from passing tests, including the departmental tests shall not be applicable to the persons recruited by direct recruitment by promotion or by transfer.

ORDER.

In the Memo. 1st read above instructions were issued informing the Commissioner of Endowments stating that appointments on contract basis may not be appropriate as the Act No.2 of 1994 prohibits all types of appointments on contract basis/daily wages or on consolidated pay in any public service to any post, any Class, Category or Grade without prior permission of the competent authority and without the name of the concerned candidate being sponsored by the Employer/Exchange.

2. Whereas it was brought to the notice of the Government that contrary to the above instructions and in violation of the said procedure a large number of contract appointments are being made to various categories of posts in various Institutions and Endowments without seeking permission of Government and thereby jeopardizing the interest of the Religious Institutions.

3. After obtaining the records and careful examination Government have noticed that irregular appointments were made though there were no sanctioned posts in the cadre strength of the respective Institutions and without examining the actual necessity of such posts and without following the rules and regulations and contrary to ban orders. The Commissioner of Endowments in his letter 2nd read above has stated that the indiscriminate recruitment of staff to various categories in various Institutions/Temples is being resorted to thereby causing unnecessary burden to the Endowment Institutions. He has therefore requested the Government to prohibit further recruitment of all administrative staff in Temples.

Government have carefully examined the matter and hereby prohibit further recruitment of all administrative staff in all Religious and Endowments Institutions until further orders.

5. The Commissioner of Endowments is requested to take necessary action in the matter and also issue necessary instructions to all the Executive Officers in the State.
