AFFIDAVIT

I, **Boya Venakateshwaramma**, W/o: B.Venkata Ramudu, Aged 55 Yrs, Caste: Boya, Occ: Poojari, R/o: 3-12, Ulchala Village, Kurnool District, Andhra Pradesh – 518 468, do hereby solemnly affirm and sincerely state as follows:-

1. I am the Petitioner herein, as such; I am well acquainted with the facts of the Case.

2. I respectfully submit that this Writ Petition has been filed challenging the action of the Respondents No.2 to 5 with the collusion of Respondent Nos.6 to 9 in trying to evict/dispossess the Petitioner and interfering in the affairs of the Temple and from attempting to evict the Petitioner from the Peddamma Temple, situated at Trimurthula Develayam (Moodugopurula Devalayam), Ulchala Village Kurnool Mandal and District, Andhra Pradesh, which is illegal, arbitrary which is illegal, arbitrary and also against the Principal of Natural Justice and also Articles 25 and 26 of the Constitution of India.

3. It is submitted that in the year 1979, the Petitioner's Husband Mr.Venkataramudu, who is a law-abiding citizen of India, and has been actively engaged in religious service, with great devotion and dedication. The Petitioner and her Husband constructed the Peddamma Temple with their own funds and also by collecting the donations from the local devotees and well-wishers and constructed a Peddamma Temple, situated at Trimurthula Develayam

(Moodugopurula Devalayam), Ulchala Village Kurnool Mandal and District, Andhra Pradesh.

It is submitted that while things stood thus, on 28/01/2025 at about 11.30 am, the employees of the Respondent No.3 with the help of the Respondent Nos.4 and 5 have attempted to interfere with administration and pooja of the temple and are unlawfully tried to evict the Petitioner from the temple premises i.e., Peddamma Temple, situated at Trimurthula Devalayam (Moodugopurula Devalayam), Ulchala Village Kurnool Mandal and District, Andhra Pradesh. The Respondent No.3 to 5 have colluded with the Unofficial Respondent Nos.6 to 9 and tried to evict the Petitioner from the Temple. The Petitioner has restrained the action of the Respondent Nos.3 to 5. The Staff of the Respondent No.4 warned the Petitioner to leave their Temple and tried to dispossess her. With the great difficulty, the Petitioner has prevented them with the help of neighbours and well-wishers. The Respondent Nos.3 to 5 have trying

to evict the petitioner and handed over the temple to the Unofficial Respondent Nos.6 to 9.

7. It is submitted that the Respondent Authorities after giving a gap of five days, have come to the Petitioner's Temple again on 03/02/2025 at about 11.00 am. The Staff of Respondent Nos.3 to 5 with the collusion of the Respondent No.6 to 9 have come to the Petitioner's temple have pushed and tried to throw away the Petitioner from their Temple, while she was conducting Pooja in the Temple. The Staff of Respondent Nos.3 to 5 and their henchmen have warned the Petitioner that they would definitely evict the Petitioner from their temple. The Petitioner has restrained the action of the Respondents. With the great difficulty, the Petitioner has prevented them with the help of neighbours and well-wishers.

8. It is submitted the actions of the Respondent authorities are illegal, arbitrary and against the fundamental rights of the Petitioner under Articles 25 and 26 of the Constitution of India, which is guaranteed the right to freely profess, practice, and propagate the religion and manage religious affairs.

9. It is submitted that the Petitioner has been in continuous possession and management of the temple for decades, and any attempt to dispossess them is a gross violation of the principles of natural justice and due process of law.
10. It is submitted that the Petitioner's Temple i.e. Peddamma Temple is not registered under the Endowment Department. It is a very small temple with no Revenue. The petitioner is maintaining the temple with great difficulty by collecting the donations from the devotees. Without having any jurisdiction, the Responcent No.5 is trying to evict the Petitioner from the Temple, which is illegal, arbitrary and against violation of the Provisions of Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious, Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987.
11. It is pertinent to mention that the Respondent Authorities have clearly violated the principle of Audi alteram partem which clearly enumerates that :

"Listen to the other side"
or
"let the other side be heard as well".

It is fundamental legal principle in which each party is entitled to a fair hearing and given the opportunity to respond against them. In the present scenario, the Petitioner has already incurred the loss of liberty and property for an offence by respondent authorities without providing the Petitioner an opportunity of being heard. It is clearly evident that the action of the Respondent Authorities is not within the limits of their powers as the Respondent Authorities have exceeded their power by forcefully trying to dispossess the Petitioner from their Temple without Show Cause Notice to the Petitioner and not giving the Petitioner an opportunity of being heard.

12. It is submitted that the Petitioner has made several representations to the Concerned Authorities seeking protection and intervention, but no action has been taken. The actions of the Respondent Authorities are malafides and intended to usurp control over the temple for political and personal gains, thereby disrupting the religious harmony and peace of the locality. If the Hon'ble Court intervenes, the Petitioner will be forcibly removed from the temple,

which causing irreparable harm and injury to their religious rights and the sanctity of the temple.

13. It is submitted the Petitioner has been serving as the Poojari and has been conducting all religious rituals and ceremonies in accordance with the traditions and customs. Without any reason, trying to dispossess/evict the Petitioner from their Peddamma Temple is nothing but violation of the Petitioner's right to life and property, which is guaranteed under Article 21 & 300-A of the Constitution of India and also violation of the principle of Audi Alteram Partem. The Respondent Authorities cannot dispossess the Petitioners from their Peddamma Temple without following the due process of law. Therefore, dispossession of the Petitioner from their Peddamma Temple, is illegal and arbitrary and also against the Principles of the Natural Justice.

14. It is submitted that the action of the Respondents is clearly shows that they may further take coercive steps against the Petitioner and dispossess/evict her from their Peddamma Temple. There is every possibility that the Respondent Authorities may come

tomorrow at any time to the Petitioner's temple and trying to dispossess the Petitioner from their Peddamma Temple, if this Hon'ble Court will not grant Protection Order, the Petitioner would put to great hardship and irreparable loss. Therefore, this Hon'ble Court interference and Interlocutory Order for Restraining the Respondents in taking the coercive steps is warranted. If this Hon'ble Court will not grant the Interim Order to restrain the Respondent Authorities illegal action, the Petitioner would put to great hardship and irreparable loss.

15. It is also submitted that I have no other alternative remedy except to approach this Hon'ble Court by filing this writ petition. We have not moved other petition before this Hon'ble Court earlier regarding the same proceedings. This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue a writ or order or direction more particularly in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents No.2 to 5 with the collusion of Respondent Nos.6 to 9 in trying to evict/dispossess the Petitioner and

interfering in the affairs of the Temple and from attempting to evict the Petitioner from the Peddamma Temple, situated at Trimurthula Develayam (Moodugopurula Devalayam), Ulchala Village Kurnool Mandal and District, Andhra Pradesh, which is illegal, arbitrary which is illegal, arbitrary and also against the Principal of Natural Justice and also Articles 25 and 26 of the Constitution of India and consequently, to direct the Respondent Authorities not to interfere with the affairs of the Peddamma Temple managing and Pooja conducting by the Petitioner and pass such order such other relief or relief's as the Hon'ble Court deemed fit in the circumstances of the Case and in the interest of justice.

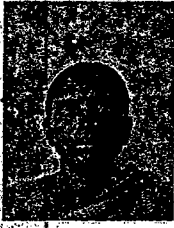

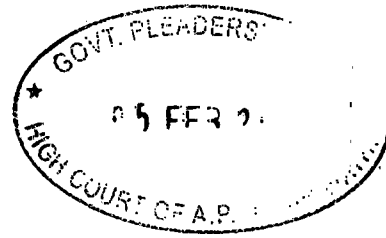
